Modi tells Suu Kyi on Rohingya repatriation

A speedy, safe and sustainable return of the Rohingya refugees sheltered in Bangladesh is in the interest of the region, Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi yesterday said when he met Myanmar State Counsellor Aung San Suu Kyi.

Meanwhile, the UN chief yesterday urged Myanmar to ensure the safe return of the refugees driven out by army operations -- a plea made in front of Aung San Suu Kyi more than two years since her country cracked down on the Muslim minority, reports AED

Child dies in building collapse

A 10-year old boy was killed and five others were injured when a three-storey building collapsed in Narayanganj city's Baburail area yesterday afternoon.

The dead was identified as Md Soyahor Hossain, a sixth-grader of Sunrise Model School in the district.

The injured are Runa Begum, 35, wife of the building owner Babu Miah; their relatives Yusuf, 25; Anik Mirza, 23; Shwapna, 10; and tenant Sonia Akhter,

Fire service officials said the building might have collapsed due to faulty underground piling as it was built occupying a part of a canal.

A woman was brutally beaten up by her husband and in-laws allegedly for damaging their cabbage field in Shibganj upazila of Bogura on Friday.

The 40-year-old victim Shilpi Begum's brother Mamun Hossain filed a case against her husband Rafi and six to seven unnamed people under the Women and Children Repression Prevention Act with Shibganj Police Station yesterday.

Mamun told The Daily Star that Rafi and his family members tied Shilpi to a bamboo around 7:30am on Friday and beaten her up publically.
