Jubo Dal leader Tuku laid to rest

Jubo Dal leader Kazi Raihan Uddin Tuku, also a prominent figure of the anti-autocracy movement in the nineties, was buried at his village graveyard at Sewta in Manikganj town yesterday.

His janaza took place on Government Devendra College premises in the town after Zohr prayers on the same day.

He died from cardiac arrest at Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) on Sunday evening. He was 50. He left behind his wife and daughter to mourn his death.

On Sunday, he went to the High Court in the morning to get get bail in a case filed with Saturia Police Station against

him and other BNP leaders under the explosives act. After staying there for several hours, he suddenly became ill. He was immediately taken to DMCH where he

was pronounced dead around 7pm, family sources said. Tuku was president of Jatiyatabadi Jubo Dal's Manikganj district unit and member of the convening committee of the district's BNP unit.

He previously served as the president and general secretary (GS) of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal's Manikganj district unit. He was also elected GS of Government Devendra College's student parliament.

HC grants anticipatory bail to 3 JCD leaders

The High Court yesterday granted fourweek anticipatory bail to three leaders of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal, the pro-BNP student body, including its president and general secretary in a case filed on charge of attacking the police.

The court also asked the accused JCD leaders to surrender to the trial court concerned at the end of the bail period.

The HC bench of Justice Muhammad Abdul Hafiz and Justice Kazi Md Ejarul Haque Akondo came up with the order following a petition recently filed by JCD leaders seeking bail in the case.

The leaders are, JCD President Fazlur Rahman Khokon, General Secretary Iqbal Hossain Shyamol and its Executive Member Md Akramul Hasan Mintu. They appeared before the HC bench for bail in the case against them.

Police filed the case with Paltan Police Station on October 12 against them on charge of attacking police before holding a

meeting in protest of Abrar Fahad's killing. Barrister Kayser Kamal appeared for the accused petitioners.

Shawkat Aziz Russel granted anticipatory

Meanwhile yesterday, another HC bench granted anticipatory bail to Partex Group Chairman MA Hashem's son Shawkat Aziz Russel in a case filed on charge of possessing a large number of bullets and narcotics in his car.

The HC bench of Justice Obaidul Hassan and Justice AKM Zahirul Huq granted the anticipatory bail till submission of the police report in the case filed with Siddhirganj Police Station in Narayanganj on November 1, Deputy Attorney General Sarwar Hossain Bappi told The Daily Star.

The bench passed the order after hearing a bail petition filed by the accused.

on May 13, 2010. In spite of getting repeated orders from the textiles and jute ministry to pay rent for the land, Jahanara applied to the ministry to purchase the land on November 13,

The then textiles and jute minister Latif Siddique, without floating any formal tender, sold the land to Jahanara at Tk 23.94 lakh although its market price was Tk 64.63 lakh.

Following the incident, the ACC filed the case against Latif and Jahanara under the Penal Code and section 5(2) of the Anti-Corruption Commission Act 1947.

On June 20 this year, a Bogura court sent Latif Siddique to jail in the case, rejecting his bail petition.

Contacted, Nur Azizur Rahman, chief executive engineer of Sylhet City Corporation, said, "There are rules on felling trees for development purpose and we didn't send any letters or inform the committee about felling any trees. As far as we know, these trees were felled by the Eidgah management committee by their own decision."

This correspondent could not contact the Eidgah Management Committee's caretaker Jahir Bakhth as he is abroad.

Mostak Ahmed, a member of the committee, said, "The committee did not collectively decide to fell the trees, and usually this type of work is carried out through auction. This might have been someone's personal decision to sell the trees to contractors.

However, the committee yesterday evening issued a notice saying that the felled trees will be put up for auction

Abdul Karim Kim, general secretary of Bangladesh Paribesh Andolon (Bapa) in Sylhet, said, "It is unfortunate that people no longer care about trees. Whenever they want they are felling trees. This cannot continue."

SM Sajjad Hossain, deputy conservator of Forests and Divisional Forest Officer of Sylhet, said, "There are strict rules that require informing and taking permission from the forest department before felling trees for any purpose, but no one took permission for felling trees at Shahi Eidgah. We will take legal action when they try to transport these felled trees without proper permission.

Afroza Begum, deputy managing director of Creative Group, and her domestic help Bithi, were found dead in a flat on the fourth floor of a building on Road 28 in Dhanmondi on Friday.

Morgue sources said, there were multiple stab marks on Afroza's belly, chest and back while Bithi had stab marks on her chest.
