Chelsea, Dortmund make big comebacks

Jorginho scored two penalties as Chelsea came roaring back from 4-1 down to draw 4-4 with nine-man Ajax in a Champions League classic on Tuesday, while holders Liverpool claimed a narrow victory and a stuttering Barcelona were held.

There was also a rousing comeback win for Borussia Dortmund over Inter Milan and a big success for Valencia, but the greatest drama came at Stamford Bridge.

Ajax appeared to be heading for a stunning victory when Hakim Ziyech set up Donny van de Beek to put them 4-1 ahead 10 minutes into the second half.

Before that, Jorginho quickly levelled from the spot after Tammy Abraham's own goal gave the Dutch champions a second-minute lead, but a Quincy Promes header and a Kepa Arrizabalaga own goal made it 3-1 at the break.

After conceding again, Cesar Azpilicueta poked in from close range for Chelsea to pull it back to 4-2, and then came the crazy moment midway through the second half which really gave them hope.

In one fell swoop, Italian referee Gianluca Rocchi sent off Ajax's Daley Blind and dismissed Joel Veltman for a second caution for a handball in the box seconds later. Jorginho then converted the resulting penalty.

Teenager Reece James made it 4-4, and Chelsea thought they had gone in front when Azpilicueta fired in, but that goal was disallowed for an Abraham handball.

'JOB DONE' FOR KLOPP
Liverpool won 4-1 in Genk two weeks ago and looked on course for another comfortable victory against the Belgians when Georginio Wijnaldum gave them the lead at Anfield.

However, with manager Jurgen Klopp

resting several players ahead of this weekend's clash with Manchester City, the reigning European champions were pegged back.

Tanzanian striker Mbwana Ally Samatta headed Genk level before the interval, and it took a fine strike by Alex Oxlade-Chamberlain to win the game.

"The plan was to win the game and we did that, so job done," admitted Klopp.

Liverpool are top of Group E, a point above Napoli, who could have qualified for the last 16 with a win against Salzburg but were held to a 1-1 draw.

HAALAND SCORES AGAIN
Erling Braut Haaland's early penalty -- the 19-year-old's seventh Champions League goal this season -- gave Salzburg the lead, before Hirving Lozano equalised.

In Germany, Inter looked to be heading for a second straight win against Dortmund as they raced into a 2-0 half-time lead with Lautaro Martinez and Matias Vecino scoring.

Yet Dortmund fought back in the second half to win the game as Achraf Hakimi grabbed a brace either side of a Julian Brandt goal.

It is a result that leaves Dortmund second in Group F, three points ahead of Inter and one behind Barcelona, who are still top despite a 0-0 draw at home to Slavia Prague.

MESSI DENIED
Lionel Messi almost scored one of his finest goals, hitting the woodwork at the end of an exhilarating run in the first half.

Barcelona had not failed to score in a home Champions League group game in seven years and this result followed a shock weekend defeat at Levante.

"We haven't been convincing, either on Saturday or today, and we know there is a lot of pressure now on the team. We have to respond," said coach Ernesto Valverde.

Niaz held by Fahad

Booters play warm-up match in Oman today

Head coach Jamie Day is looking forward to getting testing his charges again as the Bangladesh national team take on Muscat Club in their lone warm-up match today ahead of Thursday's World Cup qualifying fixture against hosts Oman.

The match will get underway at 6:00pm (BST).

After their fearless fight against India on October 15 in Kolkata, the players were given rest for more than two weeks even though majority of the players returned to club duty for the Sheikh Kamal International Club Cup in Chattogram last month.

Most of the players except for the Abahani players played at least three matches in that tournament, with Jamal Bhuiyan, Rahmat Mia, Yeasin Arfat, Arifur Rahman and Riyadul Hasan playing five matches.

The Bangladesh coach is now looking forward to gelling the players again through today's warm-up match against Muscat Club, who are currently in seventh position in their domestic league with three wins, two defeats and a draw.

"Most of the players played in Sheikh

Kamal International Club Cup, so it is more than just playing together again," Day told The Daily Star over phone yesterday adding that he is not concerned about the fitness of the players.

"It is not a fitness issue now. They are not going to get any fitter than they are. Abahani players needed rest which was good. The rest of the players played in the Sheikh Kamal tournament, so I am happy," said Day, who joined the team on Monday following his vacation.

The English coach will get some idea about the standard of Omani football after today's match, but he believes the match against Oman will be very tough.

"Oman match will be a tough one. They are the second-best team in this group and are expected to qualify," Day said. "It will just get the players playing again after being with club teams."

The coach will use 22 of his players, giving each player at least 45 minutes.

After reaching Oman on Monday, the team had their first training session where the focus was one keeping possession and finishing before playing a game among the ranks on Tuesday. They were scheduled to have their second training session yesterday afternoon.

Asian Women's v'ball from Saturday

Maldives and Kyrgyzstan teams landed in Dhaka yesterday to take part in the Bangamata Asian Senior Women's Central Zone International Volleyball Championship, which will get underway on November 9 at the Suhrawardi Indoor Stadium in Mirpur.

Afghanistan and Nepal are scheduled to arrive in the capital today to participate in the five-nation tournament from which Turkmenistan withdrew their entry at the last moment. The six-day tournament will be held in round-robin format from where the top two teams will play in the final while the third and the fourth-place finishers will lock horns for a place-deciding match.

Hosts Bangladesh are the fifth team of the tournament. This will be the first-ever international tournament for the omen in red and green.

Khaka stripped of captaincy

The Swiss international swore and threw the captain's armband to the floor after being booed as he was substituted against Crystal Palace 10 days ago.

Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang will take over as captain.

Baki fails to earn Olympics quota

Two-time Commonwealth Games silver medallist shooter Abdullah Hel Baki wasted his last chance to qualify for the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games as the 30-year-old failed to make it to the eight-man final round in 10m air rifle event of the ongoing 14th Asian Shooting Championships in Doha on Tuesday.

Baki finished 17th among 59 shooters after scoring 623.1 points, 2.6 points less than the eighth shooter. Baki will now rely on wild card to take part in the Olympics like last two editions.

Three shooters of the event secured

tickets to Tokyo 2020. They are: third-place finisher Deepak Kumar of India, fifth-place finisher LU Shao-Chua of Chinese Taipei and sixth-place finisher Endoh of Japan. The first, second and fourth place finishers of this event had already qualified for the 2020 Olympics.

Rabbi Hasan Munna finished 43rd in the same event with a score 614.3 points while Syeda Atkia Hasan finished 21st in women's 10m air rifle event after scoring 622.5 points, 5.4 points less than the last shooter who moved into the final round.

Baki, paring with Atkia, also failed to produce good results as they finished 11th among 36 pairs in mixed event by scoring 622.1 points.
