Fourth edition of Vaseline Healing Project kicks off

Develop grassland in southern region JS body to govt

The parliamentary Committee on Public Undertakings yesterday recommended the government to take measures to develop grasslands for cattle in the country’s southern region.

It also suggested engagement of ICT Division in developing a software for Milk Vita, a state brand milk-producing company.

The recommendations came from the seventh meeting of the committee, held at Milk Vita Rest House in Shahjapur of Sirajganj, according to a parliament secretariat handout.

The meeting asked the authorities concerned to take divisional action if any staff member of Milk Vita is engaged in corruption.

The parliamentary watchdog recommended bringing dynamism in activities of Bangladesh Milk Producers’ Cooperative Union Limited (Milk Vita).

Presided over by chairman of the committee ASM Feroz, the meeting was attended by its members Ismat Ara Sadique and Mohibur Rahman Manik.

The rural development and cooperatives division secretary, director general of the cooperatives department, Milk Vita chairman and its managing director were also present at the meeting.
