underlying causes, and diagnosing and treating children who become ill are the key to fight pneumonia.
"Increasing the rate of exclusive [starting within one hour of birth and continuing for six months] breast feeding for nutrition, and vaccination are among the ways to tackle the situation," Dr Sabina also said.
The rate of exclusive breast feeding in Bangladesh is 62 percent this year while the vaccination rate is 97 percent for vaccine coverage related to pneumonia among one-year-olds in 2018.

Sudipto, 28, the assistant general secretary of BCL's Chattogram city unit, was beaten dead in port city's South Nalapara on October 6, 2017.
His father filed the murder case accusing unidentified persons.
Police suspected intra-party feud behind the murder, while friends of Sudipto blamed followers of Masum.
So far, three accused gave confessional statements before magistrates, said police.
Following a home ministry order on July 31, Masum surrendered two of his licensed firearms at Khulshi Police Station on August 3, said OC Pranab Chowdhury.
Masum was heavily criticised after a photo published in the media showed him opening fire on a gathering of Hefajat-e-Islam in the city's Lalkhan Bazar area on April 7, 2013.

Claiming that Ranga was a leader of Jubo Dal in the past, Feroz Rashid said, "How does he have the audacity to talk against Bangabandhu? He spoke against the prime minister. We must give a fitting reply to his audacity."
Another JP lawmaker Mujibul Haque said Ranga will have to take responsibility for what he has said about Noor Hossain.
AL senior parliamentarian Tofail Ahmed, in his point of order, said Ranga has hurt the sentiment of the country's people with his insulting remarks.
"Ranga will have to apologise before the nation... You could not become a member of parliament if you did not forge alliance with Awami League," he said.
Another senior parliamentarian from AL, Amir Hossain Amu, said Ranga made the remarks to hide misdeeds of HM Ershad.
"Action should be taken against him [for his remark]. He must apologise," added the veteran politician.
Awami League lawmaker Sheikh Fazlul Karim Selim, meanwhile, demanded that Jatiya Party suspend Ranga.
