wrote on Facebook: "Most people, if not all, didn't even notice it."

"We had to share the information of registered users with DIFF [organisers of the event] strictly for security purposes, as DIFF would require this information to identify users at the entrance to the festival," said Malika.

"As a responsible company, we do not share any information about our valuable users with any party unless it is a necessity regarding security, and the users are well aware of this," she also said.

Supreme Court lawyer and founder of Bangladesh Cyber and Legal Center

Saimum Reza Piash said though there was a disclaimer in the registration process, it was not highlighted, and that is why it remains attendees' concern that their data will be shared.

"Currently, there is no data security law in the country. Companies are misusing customers' personal data and taking advantage of this situation," said Piash.

Dmone, on the other hand, expressed deep regrets over the incident and issued a clarification.

"This message is to clarify and confirm that Dmone account has not been created for anyone," Dmone said in a Facebook post yesterday morning.

Around an hour and a half later, the miscreants left the house with some documents, two mobile phones owned by Ghiasuddin and Sona Mia and the two medals.

They broke wardrobes and scattered documents all over the floor.

Sona Mia said after they left, he managed to untie himself and called the caretaker of the house Bina Beni Shangma and Ghiasuddin's personal staff Motilal Chakma, who were at their homes nearby.

Both Bina and Motilal said they found a machete, one wrench and two crowbars, and several small bags of torn cloth scattered all around when they reached the house in the morning.

A sub-inspector of Savar Police Station visited the house around 7am that day after Bina informed the police.

Later, on October 22, police registered a general diary lodged by Sona Mia.

Kazi Ghiasuddin alleged that Savar police were discouraging him to file a case in connection with the incident.

AFM Sayeed, Officer-in-Charge of Savar Model Police Station said he advised that either Ghiasuddin or the security guard should be the complainant, but both of them were unwilling.

The police officer also said they were trying to detain the persons responsible for the incident and recover the looted goods. The two stolen cell phones are switched off, and if one of them is turned on, police would be able to track it, he added.

The OC also said the artist has applied for police protection at his house, and will be provided due support.

Kazi Ghiasuddin suspected that a local person hired the criminals to harm him, as he used to protest against their unfair activities.

The artist had earlier lodged a complaint against a neighbour with Savar Municipality, as the latter reconstructed a boundary wall on top of the existing one beyond the legally permissible height.

Following the complaint, the executive engineer of Savar Municipality issued several notices asking the house owner to clear the wall.

Sharif Uddin Ahmed Choudhury, chief executive officer of Savar municipality, said, "Parts of the wall built beyond the permissible level have been removed." Meanwhile, Kazi Ghiasuddin left for Japan yesterday.

the European Union to Bangladesh, said the climate change impacts are causing a rise in poverty and displacement.

The ever-increasing urban population and climate migrants are going to mount added demands on available environmental assets and civic amenities, he said.

The German development partner GIZ Bangladesh organised the seminar to share findings of "Urban Management of Internal Migration due to Climate Change" (UMIMCC) project at Bangabandhu International Conference Centre.

GIZ Bangladesh is implementing a five-year project -- worth 15 million euros -- funded by the German government and European Union to improve living conditions of climate migrants and urban poor in five selected cities of Rajshahi, Barishal, Khulna, Sirajganj and Satkhira.

Citing survey findings, Guntram Glasbrenner, acting team leader of the UMIMCC and Urban Management of Migration and Livelihood projects, in

a presentation said over 56 percent of random respondents in the targeted areas were climate migrants.

Of the total 17,070 households targeted in the five-year project, 6,000 will receive skills development training for employment.

While Bangladesh has made remarkable progress in development indicators, migrants coming to urban areas toil for a livelihood source with skills that do not match the urban setting, said the speakers.

Satkhira municipality Mayor Tazkin Ahmed said in view of climate change disaster, measures must be taken to safeguard the Sundarbans that "as a true friend" has always protected the coastal community.

Shibani Bhattacharjee, additional secretary of the social welfare ministry; Careen Blume, deputy head of development cooperation at the German embassy in Dhaka; and Dr Angelika Fledermann, country director of GIZ Bangladesh, among others, spoke at the event.
