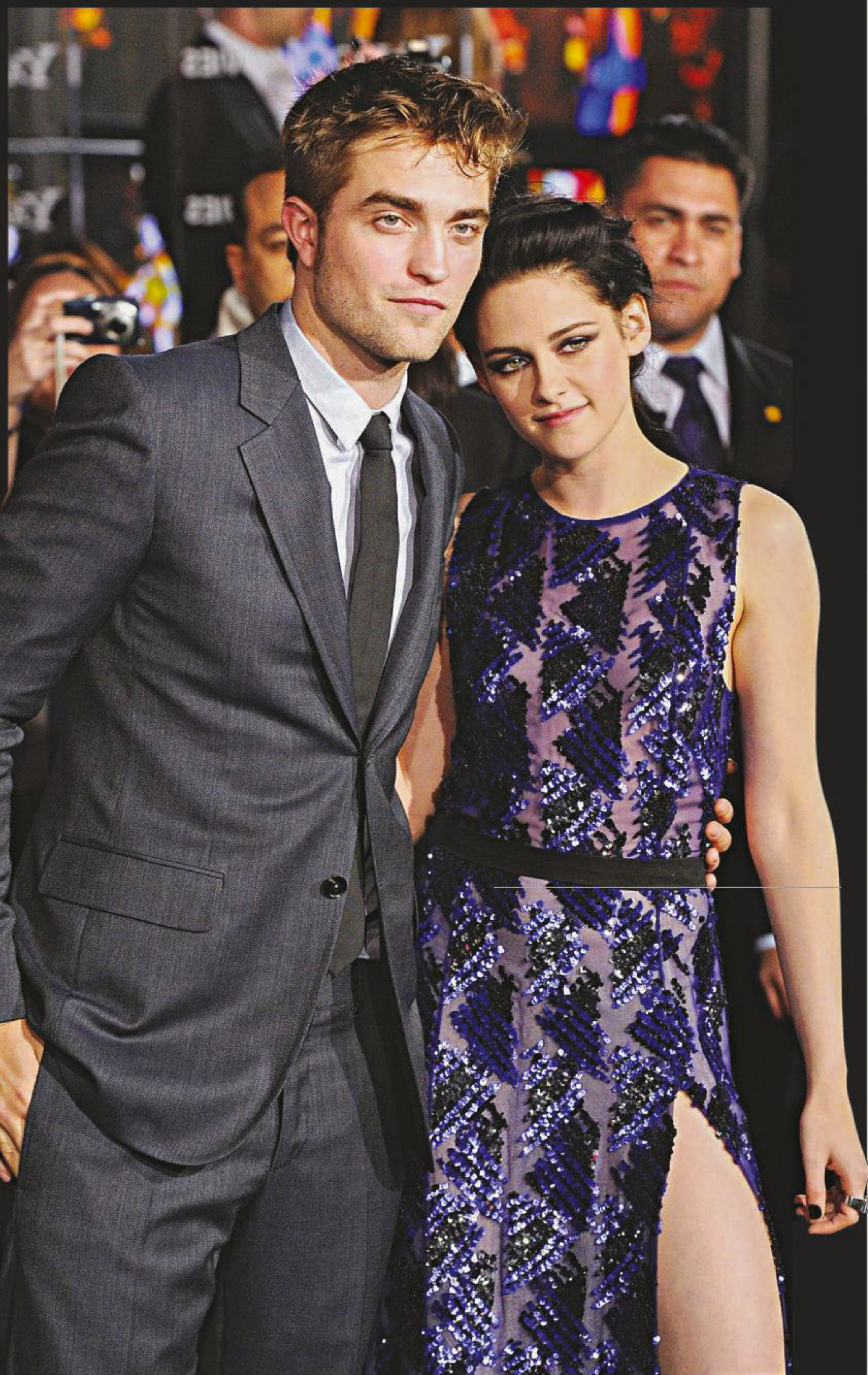


Supportive EXES
