I definitely feel that my responsibilities towards the industry have increased, and that I should contribute more.

What is it like, now that you are also producing films? I started producing films because I was concerned with the decreasing number of productions that were being made. Also, the movie theatres are closing down, which is alarming for the film industry.

My journey as a producer began with the film EK Cup Cha. I have also produced Postmaster 71. However, I am occupied with quite a few projects at the moment. After completing the shooting of the pending projects, I have plans to produce another venture next year.

'Kathgoray Sarat Chandra' is your next movie, where you will be seen as Devdas. Can we know more about the project? I have said many times before -- I have had a weakness towards Sarat Chandra Chattopadhyay's iconic character, Devdas, ever since I was a child! I am excited about being associated with Arif Khan's directorial project, Kathgoray Sarat Chandra. My dream of playing the role of Devdas has finally come true!
