

Bangladesh Premier League (BBPL) and try to integrate them into the national team during the T20 World Cup, scheduled for October next year. "This BBPL is very crucial to us.

The T20 World Cup is knocking on the door. Also, we have a lot of T20 matches coming. Our performance there will be vital. We are working in the areas where we have deficiencies, chief selector Minhajul Abedin told reporters vesterday. Bangladesh are yet to find a batsman

who can consistently score quick runs in the lower order. Moreover, the BCB has already implemented a few guidelines that they believe will help them overcome their deficiencies ahead of the World Cup. The BCB has made it mandatory for BPL teams to employ at least one wrist spinner and a fast bowler capable of bowling over 140kmph.

And with the BBPL being organised solely by the board, the event is being touted as the perfect platform for youngsters to prove their mettle and

Minhajul shared those sentiments. "We all want to see good performances from the players in have to be involved in the game in
