"A seven-member team has been formed to investigate allegations against GK Shamim of bribing government officials crores to get public works, misappropriating government money, and earning money through illegal casino business," reads the

#### letter.

Shamim is known to be an influential contractor of PWD and various other government organisations. His firm, GKB & Company (Pvt) Ltd, handles 15 major construction projects of the government worth around Tk 3,000 crore, including the Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) Headquarters in Ashkona and the Revenue Building in Agargaon.

ACC filed a case against Shamim and his mother on October 21 for amassing Tk 297.08 crore wealth beyond known sources of income.

On charges of extortion and tender manipulation, Rab members arrested Shamim and seven of his bodyguards on September 20 from the capital's Niketan.

formulation of the Indigenous Peoples' Rights Act is very necessary, added Prof Mesbah, also chairperson of RDC.

He said that RDC with help of other NGOs and rights organisations prepared a draft of the act and submitted it to the government.

He hoped that the government would consider their expectations.

Prof Mizanur Rahman of law department at Dhaka University said many rights issues of the indigenous communities. including right to land, will be solved if the act is approved. It will also give them a permanent recognition as citizens, he added

"I sincerely request the prime minister not to let division based on ethnicity happen anymore in the country," said Prof Mizanur, also former chairman of National

"As the existing laws failed to protect the rights of the indigenous people, we need a separate law," he said, urging the government to empathise with their situation.

Lawmaker Mustafa Lutfullah and Lutfun Nessa Khan, and RDC General Secretary Zannat-E-Ferdousi also spoke at the programme, among others.

She asked tortured female workers to submit allegations to the caucus so that it can address their sufferings before the parliament and seek remedy.

National Domestic Women Workers' Union Adviser Abul Hossain said female workers have to be united to ensure their due rights.

WARBE Chairman Syed Saiful Haque said it is not expected that the government would stop sending female workers abroad. However, it has to ensure their safety, he said.

WARBE Grievance Receiving Officer Suhrawardhy Hossain said ratifying the ILO conventions will help government stop female migrant workers' sufferings.

#### EXPAT MINISTRY'S INITIATIVE

Meanwhile, Expatriates Welfare and Overseas Employment Ministry issued a notice yesterday, citing a number of initiatives to ensure "further protection" for female migrant workers.

Of the initiatives, training for female migrant workers will be fully residential and for 30 days, said the notice, signed by the ministry's Joint Secretary Zahid Hossain.

Bureau of Manpower, Employment and Training (BMET) will update the housekeeping course curriculum and take the ministry's approval to make it effective within a month of issuing the notice.

To provide proper training, principals of technical training centres will prepare a study plan, including a 24hour work plan, for each training course.

List of successful participants will be sent to the ministry and BMET's "female workers' protection cell". BMET will conduct the evaluation of female workers' training through a third party.
