 "This proves that the government doesn't prioritise the interests of underprivileged people anymore; they think that listening to these people isn't necessary," she added.
 According to the report, at least 41 incidents of human rights violation -- including eight rapes, two murders, two abductions and eight land-grabbing -- occurred against Dalits and ethnic minority groups so far this year.
 In most incidents, cases were filed at police stations but majority of the accused are yet to be brought to book, said the report based on news published in national dailies.
 The report also said the number of violent incidents are almost twice than that of last year.
 Nijera Kori Coordinator Khushi Kabir and Bangladesh Adivasi Forum General Secretary Sanjeeb Drong, among others, also spoke at the press conference.

 nor the CSOs have exact knowledge on their reintegration process," he said.
 Referring to different studies, he said some 34 percent of the migrant workers failed to meet their expectations: "Bangladesh is a country with highest migration cost and the lowest migrant-labour income," he added. Currently, more than one crore Bangladeshis are living abroad as migrant workers, but there is no database on the return of these workers, he mentioned.
 In addition to strengthening supervision at home, there is a need for taking care of migrant workers abroad to solve their problems, he recommended.
 He recommended for a policy from the government in this regard.
 At the programme, representatives from different CSOs recommended sending skilled workers, punishing errant agencies, and soft loans to financially support returnees. Speaking as chief guest, Gazi

Mohammad Julhash, director general of the Wage Earners Welfare Board [WEWB] said, "We [the government] can provide economic support. But we need cooperation from the CSOs for implementation, as we have shortage of human resources."
 He informed that WEWB is going to set up offices in all divisional headquarters as if migrant workers can easily get support.
 "We [WEWB] have recommended to adopt migrant workers' issues at programmes of all ministries," he said. "Once it is implemented, migrant workers and their families will get more protection."
 He also assured that WEWB would work on soft loans for returnee migrant workers.
 Each year, more than 20 lakh people are entering the labour market in Bangladesh, different studies show. Due to massive unemployment and other reasons, some 82 percent of the youth intend to leave country, according to World Economic Forum.

 Burn and Plastic Surgery Institute.
 The patients on life support are still in critical condition, said Dr Samanta Lal Sen, coordinator of the institute.
 Nineteen employees of a factory, who were severely burnt in a fire in Keraniganj on December 11, have died at DMCH so far.
 DMCH Director Brig Gen AKM Nasir Uddin said the patients who are undergoing treatment at the HDU, have suffered 20 to 40 percent burn injuries.
 All the patients who were brought to the hospital with inhalation and deep burn injuries are improving, he said.
 "We are providing all necessary medicines

to the victims free of cost to continue their treatment properly," said Nasir.
 Dr Sen said the five patients on life support have sustained 40 to 60 percent burn injuries.
 Rahmat Ali, brother-in-law of Firoz Uddin Firoz (39) who suffered over 50 percent burns, said Firoz -- who had remained unconscious since the incident -- regained consciousness yesterday.
 "Firoz was asking about his three-and-half-year-old daughter Fatema, when his wife met him in the hospital," said Rahmat.
 Dr Sen, however, said although some of the critically-injured patients are able to talk, they are still under high risk.

 They will be awarded at a ceremony marking International Migrants Day today at Bangabandhu International Conference Centre. Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina is expected to grace the occasion as chief guest, he said.

 Besides, the Expatriates Welfare and Overseas Employment Ministry will formally launch a mandatory insurance facility known as "Probashi Kormi Bima" for migrant workers at the programme, he added.

 The amended rules say a citizen can lodge a graft allegation with a police station, but police cannot record the allegation as a case.
 The petitioners said the police station will accept the allegation as a general diary (GD) and will send it to ACC, and

then ACC will record the GD as a case and conduct inquiry into the case, which is against relevant sections of the constitution and Criminal Procedure Code (CrPC).
