As part of celebrating Bangladesh Peace and Harmony Week 2019, a roundtable titled "Policy Café" was held on Friday to promote interfaith harmony and cooperation in achieving sustainable development goals (SDG).

The roundtable was organised by Gen Lab, a social innovation and skills development organisation, at The Daily Star Centre in Dhaka where lawmakers, social innovators, media personalities, young leaders, academicians and religious leaders participated, says a press release.

Rosalee Laplante, political counsellor of the Canadian High Commission; Audrey Hsieh, political officer of US Embassy in Dhaka; lawmaker Syed Nazibul Bashar Maizvandari; Porf Kazi Nurul Islam, founding chairperson of World Religion and Culture department at Dhaka University; and Rana Dasgupta, general secretary of Bangladesh Hindu-Buddhist-Christian Oikya Parishad, among others, spoke at the programme.

Nazibul Maizvandari said, "To develop interfaith harmony, it is important to hold more open dialogues... and strengthen our curriculums and social organisations."

One killed, 15 injured as bus crashes into road divider

Two killed, six injured in other road accidents

Aspeeding bus of Star Line crashed into a road divider on Dhaka-Chattogram highway, killing one and injuring at least 15 passengers in Narayanshah area of Cumilla's Burichang upazila around 9am yesterday.

The deceased, Ziauddin, died while being treated at Cumilla Medical College Hospital.

Mahbubur Rahman, sub-inspector of Nazira Bazar police outpost, said, "The accident occurred after the driver lost control over the bus while trying to evade a bicycle-rider. It then crushed into the divider and overturned."

An army team helped police rescue the passengers. The injured were taken to hospitals in Cumilla for preliminary treatment.

Meanwhile, at least two people were killed and six were injured in two districts during the last two days, report our correspondents and a news agency.

In Faridpur, Abul Kashem Sheik (55) was killed and four were injured after an unidentified vehicle hit the cow-laden truck carrying them in Nowpara Mor area on Dhaka-Kulna highway of Madhukhali upazila on Saturday night.

Quoting locals, police said after the collision, Abul and four others,

including the truck driver, were injured.

Locals took them to the upazila health complex. Abul was referred to Faridpur Medical College Hospital as his condition worsened. He died on the way there around 8pm the same night.

EXECUTIVE MBA PROGRAM

The written test will be held on **Friday, 10 January 2020 at 3:30 pm** at IBA, University of Dhaka. The total duration of the written test is one hour. The test has two parts: i) Analytical Ability ii) English Language and Communication. An applicant must obtain a minimum qualifying score in each of the above two parts to pass the written test and appear before an interview board.

An applicant with a foreign degree(s) having a GMAT score of minimum 75 percentile may be exempted from taking the written test. However, s/he is required to appear before the interview board.

For all foreign certificates/degrees (excluding O and A Levels), equivalence will be determined by the Equivalence Committee of IBA. Without such equivalence, the applicants are not eligible to sit for the admission test.
