Teacher, 2-yr-old daughter die in road accident

In another day of tragedy on the road, five people were killed and at least 24 injured in separate accidents across the country yesterday, report our district correspondents.

In Noakhali's Begumganj, school teacher Poly Rani Majumdar (37) and her two-year-old daughter Mittika Dey Midi died after a pick-up van collided head-on with a CNG-run auto-rickshaw carrying them.

Deceased Poly Rani was an assistant teacher of Alipur Government Primary School. Two school students were also injured in the incident. Their identities could not be confirmed as of filing this report.

The accident occurred in Majumdarhat area around 9am, locals said.

Chowmuhani Highway Police's SI Ripon said police have seized the pick-up and the CNG auto-rickshaw.

Meanwhile in Dinajpur, seven people of an upazila chairperson's entourage were injured after the microbus carrying them fell into a roadside ditch at Ambari area in Parbatipur upazila in the morning.

The injured are Minfuzur Rahman, chairman of Kalai upazila; Talukdar Belal, former mayor of Kalai municipality; Ali Akbar, chairman of Ahmedabad Union under Kalai upazila; Ziaur Rahman, chairman of Zindapur UP; Saiful Islam, joint convener of Kalai upazila BCL; Nayan Chowdhury, GS of Udoypur AL; and driver Saifur Rahman.

They were taken to M Abdur Rahim Medical College Hospital for treatment.

Police said they were coming to Dinajpur from Joypurhat with JS Whip

Abu Sayeed Al Mahmood Swapon, also lawmaker of Joypurhat-2 and organisational secretary of AL, who was travelling in another vehicle.

In Faridpur, a bus driver was killed and 15 others were injured after a Dhaka-bound bus collided with a truck at Maligram Kolatola under Bhanga upazila.

Deceased Masud Mia (50) hailed from Patuakhali and worked as a driver for Mallik Paribahan.

Md Anish, SI of Bhanga Highway Police Station, said, "The accident occurred on the Dhaka-Khulna Highway around noon. The collision killed Masud on the spot. The injured were taken to Faridpur Medical College Hospital. Police seized the bus."

In Brahmanbaria, an on-duty police constable was killed after being run over by a speeding truck at Khariala bus stand under Ashuganj upazila in the afternoon.

The deceased is Syed Hossain (58) of Ashuganj Police Station.

Jabed Mahmud, OC of the station, said a team of police, including constable Hossain, were carrying out their night duty in the area from Ashuganj Toll-plaza to Bogoir bus stand. Around 4am, a speeding truck hit the victim and killed him on the spot.

In Jamalpur, Habibur Rahman Habu (70) was killed after being run over by a truck at Beltia Jangalpara area. The accident occurred as he was crossing a road around 1pm. Suddenly, a sand-laden truck hit him, leaving him dead on the spot, said Tariq Ahmed, SI of Sadar Police Station.

Police seized the truck but the driver managed to flee, said the SI.

Dreams unfulfilled

2 Bangladeshis killed in KSA

Md Zaker from Kulaura upazila of Moulvibazar grew up in a family with never-ending financial crisis. Around six months ago, the 20-year-old made the journey to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The dream was to work so hard that his family's troubles end once and for all. With this in mind, he recently finished his driving training and was in line to receive a licence.

Abdul Mukit (40), a resident of Chharaogaon village in the same district, had been living in KSA for the last 10 years. His visa had recently expired. On Tuesday, he met up with Zaker and friend Shawan (19) and decided to visit offices of the authorities concerned to get documents for their visa extension and driving licence.

However, all plans the duo had come to a screeching halt after they were killed in a road crash.

On the Jeddah highway, the rented car carrying them turned over after one of its wheels came off. This killed Zaker and Mukit on the spot and injured Shawan.

The suddenness of this accident is a big blow for both of the Bangladeshi men's families. Zaker's father Nasim Uddin said, "He was the oldest of my six children. I had to sell my land and take loan from relatives to get him there."

"On the night before the accident, he called me and said he will start work after he gets his driving licence. He said he wants to start sending money home as soon as possible," he said, clearly in pain.

On the phone call, Zaker told his father, "We will finally be relieved of all our woes."

But there's no way that dream can come true now, Nasim despaired.

Mukit had left home around ten years ago. His home in Chharaogaon was kept alive by his wife, son, and two daughters. Mukit's cousin Abdus Sukkur last talked to him on Saturday afternoon.

"The family is fully dependent on Mukit's money," Sukkur lamented.

Ever since the news arrived, Mukit's heartbroken parents are spending their time sitting in the backyard

BNP seeks deferral of CCC polls

Party mayor candidate submits 5-point demand to EC

BNP's mayoral candidate Shahadat Hossain demanded that the Election Commission change the date of Chattogram City Corporation (CCC) elections as many people may leave the city getting a three-day weekend before the polls day.

He said the election should be held on March 31 instead of March 29.

He also demanded that army should be deployed for safeguarding electronic voting machines (EVM) in every booth and preventing vote rigging. Also, presiding officers' power of casting vote should be reduced to 1 percent from existing 5; no one should be allowed on the premises of polling centres without NIDs and a summary of the polls has to be provided to the candidates by 5:30pm on the polls day.

Shahadat called on Mohammad Hasanuzzaman, returning officer (RO) of CCC polls, at his office yesterday and made the demands.

Contacted, Shahadat said he argued for changing the polls date as he thinks voter turnout will be very poor if the date is not changed.

"March 26 is a national holiday and the following two days are Friday and Saturday," he told The Daily Star, adding, "Many people may go outside the city to their village homes on this three-day weekend. If the Election Commission wants to increase voter turnout, it should change the date."

About his other demands, Shahadat said, "Army will be

Twenty-five tokay geckos, which were rescued from Sylhet's Zakiganj upazila in December last year, were released at the district's Khadimnagar National Park yesterday afternoon.

Following a court order, the geckos were released in the forest said Islam Uddin, forest ranger in Sylhet.

On December 1 last year, law enforcers rescued 28 tokay geckos from a house at the upazila's Mobinpur area and arrested one Bilal Ahmed who was keeping them with him, said Paritosh Paul, sub-inspector of Zakiganj Police Station.

Trading and selling wild geckos is a punishable crime, he added.

Reopen RMG factory

Workers demand

Workers of a closed readymade garment factory in Ashulia demonstrated yesterday, demanding resumption of the plant and increase in their pay.

Under the banner of National Garments Workers Federation, around 200 workers of Ducati Apparels Ltd at Kathgora brought out a protest possession on Nabinagar-Chandra highway around 10am from Baipail area.

Later, they staged a rally and sit-in in front of Ashulia Press Club for one-and-a-half hours.

The authorities shut down the factory on February 24 without any prior notice, rendering the workers unemployed.

"After losing our jobs we went to the Department of Inspections for Factories and Establishments (DIFE) on February 26 to file our demands, but to no avail," said a worker.

Foridul Islam, president of National Garments Worker Federation (Ashulia unit), said Ducati Apparels manufactures sweaters and its owners pay workers in piece rates.

Under the deal, the workers were supposed to be paid Tk 22 each for per product. However, they got just Tk 16, claimed Foridul.

"If the workers' logical demands are not met within 24 hours, we will surround the factory owner's house on March 6," said Foridul Islam.

The Daily Star tried to contact factory Manager (Admin) Kazi Hassan over phone, but he did not response to the calls.

He only sent an SMS that read, "I will talk later."
