# Communication snapped as bridge approach collapses in Mirzapur

Receding floodwater also damaged important local road in the upazila

The approach road on one side of Roail Bridge in Mirzapur upazila of Tangail collapsed on Thursday, snapping direct road communication in southern areas of the upazila.

The Roads and Highways Department (RHD) completed construction of Mirzapur-Warshi-Balia road and the bridge on a canal in 2017.

Besides serving internal communication in the upazila, the road is used by long-route heavy vehicles as an alternative way to Dhaka and Manikganj districts when there is traffic congestion on Dhaka-Tangail highway.

"Floodwater was receding for the last few days, creating huge current in the canal. Soil from the south side approach of the bridge started moving away on Thursday morning and a large portion collapsed in the afternoon," said Shamsul Islam of Roail village.

Months after inauguration of the road, locals

raised allegation of low-quality work, including the road and the bridge. use of poor construction materials, and a parliamentary probe body inspecting the road on March 20 in 2018 found the allegation true.

During the recent prolonged flood, a large portion of the road was submerged and it got badly damaged at several places including Postkamuri, Rajnagar, Ghugi and Roail due to strong current of floodwater.

The damage and finally the collapse of the approach road snapped movement of vehicles on the road, causing problem for several thousand people, said SM Shamsul Alam Shahid, a resident of Postkamuri village in Mirzapur.

He urged the authorities to repair the road and the bridge approach as soon as possible.

Several hired motorcycle drivers including Muktar Hossain, Mozibor Rahman and Rubel Miah said their earning from carrying passengers on the road stopped after damage of

A team of RHD officials comprising Md Mainul Hossain, additional chief engineer of Mymensingh region of RHD, superintending engineer (maintenance) Abul Kalam Azad, Md Moniruzzaman, executive engineer of RHD in Tangail, and Enamul Kabir, sub-assistant engineer of RHD in Mirzapur, visited the damaged spots on Friday.

Later, the repair work of the collapsed approach road of the bridge started on Saturday morning by dumping sandbags.

"We started temporary repair of the approach of the bridge and the damaged portions of the road for continuation of vehicular movement through the road. Permanent repair work will be done after making assessment of the damage when the flood ends," Md Moniruzzaman, executive engineer of RHD in Tangail, told The

Locals in need of urgent medical care risk their lives while using this dilapidated road to reach hospitals in upazila or district towns, said Minoti Rani Shil, headteacher of Kalsindur Government Primary School.

Local farmers, who rely on this road for transporting their produce to markets, are also suffering as they cannot ensure timely supply of the produce while those are fresh, she also said.

Gamaritola Union Parishad Chairman Anwar Hossain Khan said repair work of a 6-kilometre section of the vital road was approved in 2017-2018 fiscal year, but the years as it was not fit for constant movement vork never started. of hundreds of heavy vehicles transporting

In the enquiry, it was found that Ramzan amassed around Tk 2.70 crore legally.

"Meanwhile, he amassed Tk 2.43 crore through bribes and corrupt practices, reads the FIR.

On the other hand, his wife has amassed Tk 2.48 crore from September 24, 2007 to June 30, 2019.

Of these, about Tk 1.85 crore was amassed beyond the known source of income, said the first information report.

# AI helps Japanese recall war days

student who gave Hamai the colorized photo as a present three years ago.

Niwata, 18, said she hopes it will bring attention to her project with a Tokyo University professor to painstakingly colorize photos using artificial intelligence and their own research to spark lost memories for the rapidly aging generation who experienced the war.

"Seeing Niwata share the colorized pictures with Hamai, and then watching him recall his old memories one after another, made it feel like the ice around his frozen memories was melting away," said Hidenori Watanave, the professor who taught Niwata how to colorize monochrome pictures using AI.

Niwata and Watanave call their photo colorization project "Rebooting Memories," and they published a book last month of the colorized versions of about 350 monochrome pictures taken before, during and after the war.

and tourists would also come home around 4:00pm

Tuesday, she said by phone. Officials concerned at the foreign and expatriates' welfare ministries said the Bangladeshis had been stranded there for weeks and were desperate to return home.

"For now, the government is paying their airfare. The recruiting agencies that sent the jobseekers to Vietnam will reimburse the money later," an official at the expatriates' welfare and overseas employment ministry told The Daily Star.

Several groups of Bangladeshis travelled from Ho Chi Min City to Vietnam's capital Hanoi since early July and protested the exploitation against their Vietnamese employers and Bangladeshi brokers. They demanded immediate repatriation.

However, as international flights have been suspended due to the coronavirus pandemic, there was no way to repatriate them immediately, officials said.

Bangladesh embassy in Hanoi in cooperation with Vietnam police accommodated nearly 100 of them in several hotels. Later, on August 4, the embassy issued a circular that other Bangladeshis who went to Vietnam for jobs, had cards issued by the Bureau of Manpower Employment and Training (BMET) and were willing to return home could register.

Following that, some 50 other Bangladeshis registered with the Bangladesh embassy for returning home. Eventually, the embassy charted the US-Bangla flight for sending them home.

Shital Chandra Sarker, one of the defrauded Bangladeshis in Vietnam, said they were grateful to the Bangladesh embassy in Hanoi for arranging their repatriation.

"We had to pay Tk 4 to 5 lakh to come here, but the agents exploited us. They did not provide us with proper jobs or salaries. We were extremely vulnerable in that situation," he told The Daily Star by phone yesterday. "It's a great relief for us that we can finally return home,"


