Rohingya couple held with yaba pills, Tk 1.17cr

Rab arrested a Rohingya couple, and seized 5,300 yaba pills and Tk 1.17 crore cash, on Sunday night at a flat in Chandgaon residential area of Chattogram city.

The arrestees are Shawkat Islam, 32, and his wife Morjina, 28.

A Rab-7 team also recovered four fake Bangladeshi national identity (NID) cards, a fake National Birth Registration certificate and six Bangladeshi Mobile SIM cards from the couple.

Rab officials said the couple used the fake NID cards to rent the flat.

Flight Lt Ali Ashraf Tushar, company commander of Rab-7, Chandgaon camp, told The Daily Star that "the couple used to sell yaba pills, smuggled from Cox's Bazar, at their rented flat.

In Mymensingh, a court yesterday sent a manto jail on charge of raping a woman in Nandail upazila.

The accused is Muqbul Hossain, 60, a resident of Duttapur village in the upazila. The 35-year-old victim from Bagerhat works at a garment factory in Dhaka.

Police said the woman, a mother of two, has been separated from her husband for around three years. She heard that Muqbul had "spiritual powers" to reunite such couples so she went to his house in Mymensingh on Thursday, seeking help to get her

husband back, said police. Later, the accused allegedly raped

On Sunday evening, the victim fled from the house and filed a case with Nandail police station against the man. Police later arrested him and produced him before the court, which sent him to jail yesterday, said Md Mizanur Rahman, OC of the police station.

Sunday's election was seen as referendum on the fledgling democratic government led by Suu Kyi and the NLD, which remains hugely popular at home but has seen its reputation collapse overseas amid allegations of genocide against the Rohingya minority.

Despite the expected emphatic win, the new Suu Kyi-led government is expected to face a myriad of challenges. In contrast to the wave of optimism that greeted the NLD's landslide win in 2015, Myanmar went into this election under a cloud of a surging Covid-19 outbreak, economic hardship and escalating ethnic conflicts.

Foreign Minister Dr AK Abdul Momen yesterday said Bangladesh would welcome the new government in Myanmar and expressed optimism over the resumption of talks on Rohingya repatriation using tripartite mechanism.

Bangladesh, Myanmar and China are planning to hold foreign ministerlevel talks, likely in Beijing, to begin the process without any delay. Despite repeated pledges from Myanmar, not a single Rohingya returned to Rakhine over the last three years.

According to UNB, Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi has recently assured Dhaka on Rohingya repatriation, saying Myanmar has pledged to take them back.

The military, which ruled Myanmar for nearly 50 years until it began withdrawing from civilian politics in 2011, controls a quarter of seats in both houses of parliament, under a constitution it drew up and which Suu Kyi and her allies want to amend.

Despite a high turnout, more than a million people across the country were unable to vote after polls were cancelled due to insurgencies, including hundreds of thousands of Rohingvas. The election commission has said the polls in areas affected by conflict had to be cancelled for safety reasons and that only citizens were entitled to vote.

Asked about the relocation plan, Minister Ahmad said the UK is absolutely clear that the relocation of Rohingya refugees to Bhasan Char must be "safe, voluntary and dignified".

Biman Kolkata Chennai

Biman was forced to cancel the scheduled flight yesterday, sources at the Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport told The thrice a week Dhaka-Chennai-Dhaka flights from

November 15 was also suspended until further notice. An official of the national airliner said a lack of passengers fewer visas issued to intended passengers by the Indian High Commission, various rules and regulations set by the Indian

authorities for air travellers, are among the reasons for suspension of Biman flights to Kolkata and Chennai. The airlines, however, will continue its flights to Delhi. Tahera Khondoker said initially three flights a week were operated to Delhi but it has now been reduced to two a week.

After a seven-month hiatus due to the coronavirus

pandemic, Biman announced three flights a week to Delhi,

Kolkata and Chennai under an air bubble deal with India. Officials of Novoair, a private carrier, told The Daily Star that they have also postponed their plan to resume flights on the Dhaka-Kolkata route due to lack of passengers.

US-Bangla Airlines, the leading private carrier, however, continued operating its flights on the Dhaka-Kolkata and Dhaka-Chennai routes, said Kamrul Islam, spokesperson of the airline.

The carrier is operating 13 flights every week to India six flights to Kolkata and seven to Chennai. A top official of the airlines said they are continuing

services as they do not want to open their market to Indian According to the air bubble agreement between Bangladesh and India, three Bangladeshi airlines were

scheduled to operate 28 flights a week to different destinations in India while five Indian Airlines were scheduled to operate the same number of flights to Bangladesh.
