

Three war heroines get new houses

Three Birangonas (war heroine) has got new houses and new addresses after 50 years of independence in Sreemangal upazila of the district.

They are Shila Guha, 70, Monwara Begum, 68, and Maya Khatun, 65, of the upazila. The three have been abandoned by their husbands.

The trio said for 50 years, they have dreamed of a piece of land and a house in an independent country. They have visited door to door to fulfill the dream, but no one has come forward to fulfill their dream. Finally, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has fulfilled their dream.

On January 23, out of 100 homeless and landless families in Sreemangal upazila, the three war heroines got new red and green houses and land. The houses are built on the khas land.

Receiving the house, Monwara Begum said "I have been demanding a house for the last five decades. I am grateful to the prime minister for this. She has finally fulfilled my dream."

Shila Guha said her husband divorced her in 1972 when her husband came to know about her sorrowful story.

"The country, for which I endured

hardships, honoured her by providing the house," she said.

Maya Khatun said "The incumbent prime minister has set a unique example by providing houses to the homeless people. I do pray for the PM to almighty."

Liberation War researcher Bikul Chakrabarty said the three women were tortured by Pakistani occupation army during the 1971 Liberation War. The Pakistani army picked up three women, including Shila, an actor of jatrपाल, from Olipur Girls' High School in Kurigram, took them to camp and tortured them inhumanly. Shila's in-laws' house was in Kurigram then.

And Pakistani army caught Maya from Sureranj Primary School area in Sreemangal, took her to the nearby sub-camp and tortured her for five days.

Their husbands later abandoned the three women when they came to know that they were tortured by Pakistani army in the camp, said Bikul.

Sreemangal Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Nazrul Islam said "Those who sacrificed their lives for the independence of the country had no land or no house. In this Mujib year, we have been able to give three houses to the three war heroines."

On the occasion of Mujib Year, 300 homeless families will get houses on two decimals of land in Sreemangal upazila each, he said.

"We have already handed over 100 houses to the homeless families. The rest of the work is going on. Construction work of the houses will be finished soon," said the UNO.

FEAR OF EVICTION BY FOREST DEPARTMENT

Indigenous people in Madhupur stage demo

People from different indigenous community living in Madhupur upazila staged demonstration on Monday, bringing allegation that the forest department is attempting to evict them from their own land in the name of recovering forest lands.

Terming the forest department's attempt to evict them a conspiracy, hundreds of people from Garo, Koch and Barman communities brought out a procession and formed a human chain in Madhupur Bus Stand area in the morning.

Later they submitted a memorandum to the prime minister through Madhupur Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Arifa Zohura.

They also announced to hold a "grand rally" at Jalchhatra field on January 31 to press for their demand.

Speaking at the programme, Joyenshahi Adivasi Unnayan Parishad President Eugin Nokrek said, "We recently learnt from a report published in a national daily that the government has decided to recover the country's occupied forest lands. The eviction drive is supposed to start from Gazipur on January 30.

"We have also learnt that this drive will start from Gazipur first and Tangail has been kept second in the list. Local indigenous people have been passing days in fear of eviction," he said.

While talking to this correspondent over telephone, Tangail Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) Dr Jahirul Haque said they did not issue any notice to the local forest-dwellers in this regard.

"The government has decided to recover 2.78 lakh acres of forest land across the country, which were captured by grabbers. But we did not get any directive in this regard," added the forest official.

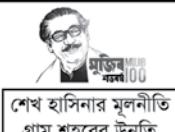

4 jailed for killing boy for ransom

A Tangail court yesterday sentenced four people for different terms imprisonment in connection with a case for killing a minor boy for ransom in 2013.

Tangail Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal Judge Khaleida Yasmin jailed Jahangir Hossain, 30, of Ghatail upazila, and Goutam Chandra, 30, of Gopalpur upazila, till their death, and two others--Hasan Ali, 17, of Ghatail upazila, and Mohammad Sohel, 17, of Bhuanpur upazila--for 10 years imprisonment, Court Inspector Tanvir Ahmed said.

Assistant Public Prosecutor Shahanshah Mintu said the convicts abducted eight-year-old Masud Rana Shoyon from Ruhuli village in Bhuanpur upazila on his way to school on September 30, 2013.

The kidnapers later demanded Tk 5 lakh ransom from Shoyon's family for his release.

Although Shoyon's family gave them Tk 2 lakh, but the criminals killed the minor boy and buried his body at a graveyard in Tengri area in Madhupur upazila.

Later, victim's grandmother Mazeda Begum filed a case with Bhuanpur Police Station against some unidentified people on October 3 the same year.

2 to die for murder

A Kishoreganj court on Monday sentenced two people to death for killing a man in 2014.

The convicts are Kazi Nazrul Islam, 41, and Sumona Begum, 35, both hailing from Brahmanbaria.

Kishoreganj Additional District and Sessions Judge Mohammad Abdur Rahim also fined them Tk 2 lakh each. According to the case statement, Nabi Hossain of Brahmanbaria married his second wife Sumona in 2012 and arranged her living at a rented house in Kishoreganj's Bhairab upazila.

While staying in Bhairab, Shila developed an affair with Nazrul.

When Nabi learnt about their relationship, Sumona called Nabi at her house on December 21 in 2014 and killed him with the help of Nazrul.

They later cut Nabi's body into six pieces and dumped it in different areas of Bhairab.
