Some BB officials feed off scams

HC blasts central bank for failure to stop irregularities at NBFIs, say ACC, SEC too didn't play their role

The High Court yesterday came down heavily on a section of Bangladesh Bank officials over their alleged links with financial scams involving People's Leasing and Financial Services Ltd (PLFSL), a nonbank financial institution.

The court also said since the central bank started the process of liquidating the ailing NBFI in June 2019, it has hardly done anything to recover depositors' money from those who defaulted on loans from PLFSL.

The liquidation process began after the board of PLFSL informed BB in April 2019 about its inability to pay back the depositors' money despite the maturity of the deposits.

The HC also said Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) and Securities Exchange Commission (SEC) have not taken appropriate action against the wrongdoers in most cases as well.

The HC bench of Justice Muhammad Khurshid Alam Sarkar made the observations during the hearing on a petition filed by the central bank in 2019 seeking permission to liquidate PLFSL.

It said a section of BB officials, from general manager to deputy governor, who

served the departments responsible for monitoring NBFIs, gained undue benefits from scammers between 2002 and 2019.

Taking the benefits, the officials remained silent regarding different irregularities in the NBFIs, it said.

At least 10 of 36 NBFIs operating in the country have been in dire straits in recent years as they reel from various financial scams.

While holding hearing on the petition, the HC bench also termed SK Sur Chowdhury, a former deputy governor of BB, and Shah Alam, a sitting executive director, "thieves and robbers" over their alleged links with the fraudsters.

SK Sur and Shah Alam, who played roles in monitoring the NBFI sector at different times, neglected their responsibility of protecting the NBFIs from the irregularities, the HC bench said.

The Daily Star tried to contact the two for their comments on the issue, but they did not pick up calls last night.

The names of the two came to the fore after Rashedul Haque, a former managing director of International Leasing and Financial Services (ILFS), an NBFI, and Uzzal Kumar Nandi, chairman of PLFSL, SEE PAGE 2 COL 3

Japanese firm keen to take charge

High-level meeting on PPP to discuss the proposal today

Two new project proposals, including one on the operation and maintenance of Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport (HSIA), will be placed at a high-level meeting between representatives of Bangladesh and Japan today and there will be discussion whether those can be implemented under public private partnership (PPP)

The Bangladesh side will place a project proposal on upgrading Nabinagar-Paturia road to an expressway while the Japanese authorities will put forward a proposal on operation and maintenance of the country's prime airport, sources said.

Mitsubishi Corporation, which is involved in construction of the third terminal of HSIA, has already sent their proposal to the Bangladesh authorities. On the other hand, Roads and Highways Department (RHD) is already

in talks with Japanese JFE Engineering Corporation over implementing the expressway project, the sources added. The Fourth Bangladesh Japan Joint PPP Platform meeting will be held

virtually today. Public Private Partnership Authority (PPPA) will lead the Bangladesh

Hours after the prime minister's directive, Education Minister Dipu Moni said that in-person classes at universities will resume on May 24 after the Eid-ul-Fitr.

Huji man who threw grenades arrested

Rab yesterday arrested a fugitive convict in the August 21 grenade attack case who hurled bombs at the Awami League rally on Bangabandhu Avenue in 2004.

The elite force arrested the fugitive, Iqbal Hossain alias Jahangir alias Selim, from the capital's Diabari area around 3:00am, Rab Director General Chowdhury Abdullah al Mamun told a press briefing hours after the arrest.

Iqbal, who is a member of banned militant outfit Harkatul Jihad al Islami, Bangladesh (Huji-B), was sentenced to life imprisonment by a Dhaka Speedy Trial Tribunal on October 10, 2018.

The Rab chief said Igbal fled to Malaysia in 2008. When he was identified as an illegal immigrant late last year, the Malaysian government deported him in December last He was arrested in a joint

effort by the National Security Intelligence (NSI) and the Rapid Action Battalion, the Rab chief


Asked how Iqbal, who was sentenced to life imprisonment, left the country, the Rab DG said when Iqbal left the country, handwritten passports were in use. He also

A cruel end to a mother's frantic search for her son

Dead for a month, he was buried unclaimed

It was their daily routine to try to reach him over the phone, after Sadman Sakib Rafi
