FROM PAGE 12 asking the authorities to explain in four weeks why their inaction to recover the money laundered from the country and deposited with foreign banks, including the ones in Switzerland should not be declared illegal.

The court asked the authorities to show causes as to why they should not be ordered to form a special investigation team to find out Bangladeshi nationals' illegal money in foreign banks.

At the same time, the HC ordered the government to explain why it should not be recommended to reform the relevant laws in order to easily recover the huge amounts laundered out of the country.

The HC bench of Justice Md Nazrul Islam Talukder and Justice Mohi Uddin Shamim came up with the order and rule after hearing a writ petition filed over the issue.

The bench fixed March 30 for the next hearing on the issue. During the hearing, one of the petitioners Abdul Qaium Khan told the court that money laundering had gone up at an alarming rate in recent years.

Names of different Bangladeshi individuals and companies have reportedly been published in the Panama Papers and Paradise Papers for depositing large amounts of money with overseas banks.

But no enquiry was made to look into the allegations, said lawyer Abdul Qaium.

The ACC, Bangladesh Financial Intelligence Unit, and other authorities concerned have failed miserably to prevent money laundering and to bring the money back to the country, the lawyer argued.

He said 426 Indian citizens and companies were named in the Panama Papers and Paradise Papers and it was subsequently reported that they faced investigations.

ACC lawyer Khurshid Alam Khan said the name of Abdul Awal Mintoo, owner of a Bangladeshi company, was mentioned in the Panama Papers and an enquiry was being conducted by the ACC.

He also said the ACC and government were working on bringing back the laundered money and were framing a work plan to this effect.

Lawyers Qaium and Subir Nandi Das filed the writ petition with the HC as a public interest litigation on February 1, seeking its directive on the authorities to take steps to bring back the money that Bangladeshi nationals and organisations laundered abroad and deposited with foreign banks, including Swiss ones.

In the petition, they prayed to the HC for an order to constitute a special investigation team to find out Bangladeshi nationals' illegal money deposited to foreign banks.

Yahya suspends national

FROM PAGE 12 on March 3, 1971, and "general situation of tension" created by India.

It may be mentioned here that Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, chief of the majority party Awami League, had suggested February 15, 1971, for the opening of the National Assembly but the Assembly was called for in the first week of March 1971 following the wishes of the minority party, Bhutto's Pakistan People's Party. Awami League conveyed messages to Yahya through East Pakistan Governor SM Ahsan that postponement of the Assembly would lead to a political explosion in the eastern wing. Ahsan confirmed that he had transmitted the message. [Kamal Hossain, Bangladesh Quest for Freedom and Justice, UPL, 2013, pp. 79]

Yahya Khan was expected to arrive in Dhaka on March 1 to hold a talk with Sheikh Mujib. Kamal Hossain shares that even on the night of February 28, 1971, there were indications that Yahya might still arrive in Dhaka on March 1 and the usual procedures of receiving the president were underway. Referring to a government official who travelled on the plane which was expected to carry the President from Karachi, Kamal Hossain informs that the departure of the plane had been delayed twice in Karachi as Yahya was expected to join the flight.

Yahya decided to stay back.

GW Choudhury provides an interesting background of the event. Yahya asked him to prepare a statement, in a conciliatory vein, on the postponement of the Assembly session. In his draft, it was mentioned that the postponement will not exceed two or three weeks [the radio statement reads: I have, therefore, decided to postpone summoning of National Assembly to later date]. Choudhury handed over the draft to Yahya at Islamabad Airport while he was leaving for Karachi. The draft was subsequently given to Lt Gen G.S.M.M. Peerzada (PSO of Yahya Khan) who in alliance with Bhutto torpedoed it, adds Choudhury. Bhutto and Peerzada were reported to have drafted the statement. [GW Choudhury, The Last Days of United Pakistan, UPL, 1998, pp. 156-158]

Commenting on the episode, Siddiq Salik who was then Public Relations Officer in the Pakistan Army at Dhaka writes in his memoir, Witness to Surrender: "When I checked up details of this important development with Major-General 'Y' who was on Yahya's personal staff he said, "The President was in Karachi then. We were all downstairs. Major-General 'H' and Major General 'O' were going

up and down. They painted such a picture to the President that he had to agree to the draft already prepared." [2017: 44]

When asked about his response Bhutto declined to make any comment. However, his party called off the pre-scheduled general strike.

Pakistan Muslim League Chief Khan Abdul Qayyum called the decision of the President "the only correct decision" and welcomed it. In opposition to this secretary-general, Khan A. Sabur resigned from the party. **DHAKA'S RESPONSE**

Upon hearing the news of the suspension of the National Assembly, Dhaka city erupted in anger and hundreds of people rushed from their shops and offices screaming and shouting in a spontaneous display of anger.

The cricket match being held in Dhaka stadium between BCCP (Board of Control for Cricket in Pakistan) and International XI was suspended.

Immediately after the radio broadcast Bangabandhu directed all Awami League Members of Parliament to assemble at Hotel Purbani at 3:00pm. After the parliamentary party meeting, in a crowded press conference, Bangabandhu said, "Only for the sake of a minority party's disagreement the democratic process of constitution-making has been obstructed and the National Assembly session has been postponed sine die. This is most unfortunate as far as we are concerned. We are the representatives of the majority people and we cannot allow it to go unchallenged."

In reply to a question, whether he would proclaim unilateral Independence, Sheikh Mujib said "You Wait". When asked by correspondent whether he was consulted before the postponement of the National Assembly, he said, "No".

Bangabandhu announced a programme for the next 6 days which included observance of a complete

strike on March 2 in Dhaka and a country-wide strike on March 3 the date earlier fixed for the National Assembly to meet. On March 7, the final programme would be announced in a public meeting at the Race Course Maidan.

Mujib uttered a note of warning: "You will see history made if the conspirators fail to come to their senses."

Thus began the historic non-cooperation movement.

Political leaders, student leaders, and representatives of various professional groups from East Pakistan delivered individual statements expressing their opposition against the suspension of the National Assembly inaugural session.

Later in the evening, Mujib discussed with various political leaders including Ataur Rahman Khan, Mozaffar Ahmed, Maulana Shah Noorani about the changed political situation. Awami League representatives were sent to Santosh to apprise Maulana Bhashani of the situation and to invite him for a meeting with Bangabandhu. **DIPLOMATIC RESPONSE**

The US Embassy in Islamabad welcomed Yahya's announcement as possibly providing a "needed cooling-off period". But the US Consulate in Dhaka had a quite different reaction. The then Consul General of Dhaka Archer K Blood sent a telegram to the Embassy ending with the words: "I believe I have just witnessed the beginning of the end of a unified Pakistan." GOVERNOR AHSAN REMOVED

Later that night, Governor of East Pakistan Admiral Ahsan, who was known as a Bengali sympathizer, was removed by Yahya Khan, and Lt General Shahibzada Yakub Khan took over the charge of the province.

Irregularities widespread

FROM PAGE 12 Witnesses said they clashed over establishing supremacy near the polling centre around noon.

At one point, followers of councillor candidates -- Madedur Rahman and Akhtar Hossain -- attacked Chhoton. He fell to the ground and was taken to Saidpur 100-bed Hospital where he was declared dead on arrival.

Omidul Hasan, resident medical officer of the hospital, said, "Further details [about his death] could be known after performing autopsy."

Abul Hasnat Khan, officer-in-charge of Saidpur Police Station, said the clash took near the polling centre and police brought the situation under control quickly. Five others were also injured during the clash.

Earlier, Jatiya Party mayoral candidate Siddiqui Alam boycotted the polls, alleging irregularities and attack on his supporters.

In Brahmanbaria municipality polls, AL, Jubo League and Chhatra League men took control of voting booths in many polling stations and voted for AL mayoral nominee Nayar Kabir, alleged voters.

While visiting several polling centres, our district correspondent also found that a group of young men wearing badges of "boat symbol" around their necks took position next to the voting booths in most of the centres.

At Brahmanbaria Government Mohila College centre, the EVM machines for mayoral polls were set up outside the voting booths, while the machines for election in general councillor posts and those for the reserved seats for women were kept inside the voting booths.

Asked why the EVM machines for mayoral polls were kept outside the voting booth, polling official Abdul Baset of booth-1 said, "It [EVM machine] was moved by the wind."

Saty Das, a voter who came to the polling station, said, "I wanted to vote for the candidate of my choice, but they [AL men] forced me to vote for the boat symbol. I protested. In the end, I was forced to vote in front of them."

Many candidates alleged that law enforcement agencies did not prevent the youths wearing badges of "boat symbol" from entering the voting booths.

Mahmudul Haque Bhuiyan, an independent mayoral contender, said his agents were driven out from 23 centres after 10:00am. "Since then, all those who came to cast votes have been forced to cast votes for the boat symbol."

Returning Officer Zillur Rahman said nobody made any complaints about taking control of voting booths. "I visited many centres and did not see such things."

In Laxmipuri Raipur municipality election, ruling party activists took position inside the voting booths and voted for AL mayoral candidate after the voters confirmed their identities, alleged many voters at Madhupur Government Primary School centre.

Talking to reporters, Presiding Officer Sharif Hossain claimed that no voter made such complaints. "Voting is going on properly."

BNP mayoral candidate Shah Mohammad said he would not take part in Jamalpur municipality polls, alleging that ruling party men took control of polling centres and did not allow his agents to enter most of the centres.

Shamsul Haque, BNP mayoral nominee in Joypurhat municipality election, demanded a re-election, bringing allegation of irregularities during the polls.

EC'S REACTION

Election Commission Secretary Humayun Kabir Khandaker yesterday evening said the hourly reports sent by returning officers and the Monitoring Cell showed that the polls were held in a festive atmosphere.

About a man's death in Saidpur of Nilphamari, Humayun told reporters at the EC secretariat in the capital's Agargaon, "No death is desired. That is why we are all sorry."

"There were no signs of injuries on his body. We can know the cause of his death when autopsy report is available," he added.

FROM PAGE 12 The incident occurred when the ship carrying imported coal of Eastern Private Limited from Harbaria area of Mongla port was on its way to Nawapara in Jashore district, he said.

According to the port authorities, there was no disruption in movement on the route following the incident.

The operation to rescue the sunken cargo will begin in the morning today, Sheikh Fakhar added.

"We have contacted the cargo authorities. They are trying to take necessary steps to recover the coal. Rescue work could begin on Monday morning. If they want any cooperation from port authorities, we will cooperate," said Fakhar Uddin.

Iqbal Bahar Chowdhury, officer-in-charge (OC) of Mongla Police Station, said the cargo master lodged a general diary with the Mongla Police Station. In his diary, he said the ship capsized due to thick fog and strong currents.

Entire phase-1 of MRT-6

FROM PAGE 12 Uttara to Agargaon -- of metro rail is likely to be operational in December this year.

Asked whether they would start operation of the first phase in December, MAN Siddique said they would be able to inform about the plan after the metro rail reaches Bangladesh, expectedly in April.

He, however, said they were running behind their schedule to bring metro trains from Japan due to the Covid-19 situation.

The original implementation period of the project was 2012-2024.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina later directed that metro services from Uttara to Agargaon be made operational by 2019, and from Agargaon to Motijheel by 2020.

Failing to meet the deadline, the authorities in May 2019 said the project would be launched on December 16, 2021, when the country would be celebrating the golden jubilee of its independence.

PROGRESS OF THE FIRST PHASE

The first phase of the project saw 81.38 percent progress as of February 25, MAN Siddique said. The rail line has been installed at 8.72 km, out of the 11.73 section, he said.

Besides, 16.20km, out of 19km rail lines, inside the depot at Diabari, has already been installed and installation of a mast for the overhead catenary system has been done inside the depot and to Kazipara station, he added.

Full installation of rail line in the first phase is expected to be completed within May, he added.

Nine, out of 52 structures to be built inside the depo, have been completed, he said hopping to complete all civil works within five to six months.

Works for building concourse roof for first three stations -- Uttara north, central and south -- have already done while same work for five others station is now going on, he said.

MAN Siddique, on February 4, told

reporters that they might start a trial run of the first metro rail service in July, as the first train is expected to arrive in April. The trial run might continue for as long as six months, he added.

The first train was supposed to leave the Port of Kobe on February 20 for Bangladesh and could reach a depot in the capital's Diabari on April 23 via the Mongla port. But, the train could not be sent on February 20 due to incline weather and now they are expected to be shifted on March 1, MAN Siddique said.

The second train is likely to reach the depot on June 16, and the third one on August 13.

As they had to complete inspection of the trains engaging third party due to Covid restriction, the authority would check 19 major elements after the trains reach Bangladesh and then they would carry out an integrated test before going for a trial run, he said.

Launch a judicial probe

FROM PAGE 12 Mushtaq was imprisoned unjustifiably and forced to death as a consequence of gradual mental torture.

Mushtaq, who was arrested under the Digital Security Act (DSA), died in Kashimpur High-Security Jail-3 in Gazipur on Thursday.

The noted citizens also demanded the immediate release of and withdrawal of case against seven students nabbed by police on Friday during a rally protesting Mushtaq's death in the capital's Shahbagh.

Besides, they demanded release of and withdrawal of case against labour leader Ruhul Amin of Khulna who was nabbed by detectives and shown arrested under the DSA on Saturday, allegedly for uploading a post on social media supporting the protest against Mushtaq's death.

The citizens further demanded medical compensation for the injured from the "barbaric" police attack during Friday's incident in Shahbagh and punishment of the culprits.

They said both of the cases filed against the seven students under the Penal Code-1860 and against Ruhul Amin under DSA are "unjust, indiscreet, and repressive", adding that they, as commoners, are angered by the case-filings and police attack on peaceful protesters.

They further demanded the abolishment of the "repressive" DSA and the withdrawal of all cases against people filed under the act.

The citizens demanded release of ailing cartoonist Ahmed Kabir Kishore, also arrested under the DSA, on bail for better treatment, citing the cartoonist was allegedly tortured in custody. They also demanded trial of the torturers.

The signatories include Prof Anu Muhammad of Jahangirnagar University; author Rahnuma Ahmed; Zafrullah Chowdhury, founder of Gonoshasthaya Kendra; international relations expert Prof CR Abrar; human rights activist Shaheen Anam; Syeda Rizwana Hasan, chief executive officer of Bangladesh Environmental Lawyers' Association; rights activist Khushi Kabir; woman rights activist Farida Aktar, researcher Shaban Adnan; Azfar Hussain, vice-president of Global Center for Advanced Studies in New York, USA; Prof Asif Nazrul of Dhaka University; rights activist Nur Khan, and rights activist Shireen Huq.
