# Irregularities widespread

Men in booths cast vote instead of voters; 'wind moves EVM outside booth' in B'baria; EC claims polls festive


Municipal polls in many places were marked by widespread allegations of voter fraud, flouting of laws and violence that left one man dead and

Many voters alleged that they had confirmed their identities by showing their ID cards to election officials for casting their votes through electronic voting machines (EVMs) but someone in the voting booths pressed the button on the ruling Awami League symbol "boat" for the mayoral post.

Political parties are nominating mayor candidates, but not councillor ones. Several BNP mayoral nominees and independent contenders boycotted the polls, alleging blatant violation of rules by AL activists.

Elections were held in 29 municipalities in 20 districts yesterday. In Nilphamari's Saidpur municipality polls, Chhoton Adhikari, 54, a supporter of councillor candidate Nazrul Islam Royal, was killed in a clash with supporters of rival candidates at Mohila College centre in ward-5.

## Give their details by March 30

The High Court yesterday wanted to know the names, addresses and current status of Bangladeshis who deposited laundered money to overseas banks and enquired what steps had been taken against them.

#### Entire phase-1 of MRT-6 now visible

Final viaduct placed yesterday

first phase Bangladesh's first metro rail project is now visible as the last viaduct of this part was installed yesterday.

The last viaduct was installed in between pier numbers 375 and 376, connecting Uttara with Agargaon by the 11.73km elevated structure.

"This is a very pleasant day for us," MAN Siddique, managing director of Dhaka Mass Transit Company Limited (DMTCL), the implementing agency of the project, told reporters.

Mass Rapid Transit Line-6, also known as MRT-6 is being implemented to build the 20.10km elevated metro rail from Uttara third phase to Motijheel at the cost of Tk 22,000 crore.

Authorities have a plan for early commissioning of the total line in December this year.
