### SHARIATPUR PUBLIC PROSECUTOR MURDER IN 2001

# Six sentenced to death

Police's investigation report of the case filed over the killing of Public Prosecutor Habibur Rahman and his brother in Shariatpur showed law enforcement's negligence and lack of professionalism, a judge said yesterday while delivering verdict in the case.

Judge Md Showkat Hossain of the Additional District and Sessions Judge's Court in Shariatpur made the observations while handing death sentence to six accused and life-term imprisonment to another four.

The investigation report was frustrating, the judge said, adding that investigation officers did not find the truth, allowing many culprits to skip the case. He said the double murder happened following a political riot on October 5-6, 2001, triggered by rumours.

The death-row convicts are Shahid Talukdar, Shahin Kotwal, Shahid Kotwal, Shafi Kotwal, Solaman Sardar and Mojibar Rahman Talukdar. They were also fined Tk 10,000 each. The court also sentenced Sarowar Hossain, Babul Talukdar, Babul

Khan, Dablu Talukdar and Tokai Rashid to life-term imprisonment and fined them Tk 10,000 each, in default of which they will be sentenced to six months more in jail.

Three other accused -- Montu Talukdar, Aslam Sardar and Jakir Hossain Mojnu were sentenced to two-year imprisonment.

The court acquitted 39 other accused. It also issued conviction and arrest warrants against five absconding accused.

Meanwhile, Shariatpur municipality mayor Parvej Rahman John, also son of victim Habibur Rahman, told The Daily Star they would challenge the judgement at the higher court.

Masudur Rahman, a defence lawyer, also said that they were dissatisfied with the verdict and would go to the High Court.

Shariatpur district court's Public Prosecutor Habibur Rahman, also joint general secretary of district unit Awami League, and his brother Monir Hossain were brutally shot to death at their house in Sadar upazila while campaigning for the 8th JS polls on October 5, 2001.

To facilitate proper prison administration, every prisoner has to wear the prescribed attire as per prison rules, read the letter. It also asked all officials to take appropriate steps in this regard.

If the directives are not followed properly then stern legal action will be taken against everyone responsible, the letter further warned

Asked about it, Brig Gen Mominur Rahman Mamun, inspector general of prisons, told The Daily Star yesterday that he has found irregularities during his visit to different jails in the country.

They have sent the letter to remind all the officials concerned about the rules. "Prison authorities need to make sure that inmates wear prescribed inmate attires," he said.

"Convicted prisoners have specific and selected attires to wear but inmates whose cases are still in trail phase have no such outfits. These clothes are given to separate the two. Everyone has to follow this in a disciplined manner," said the prison chief.

"We are collecting information of all the irregularities and improving the situation in phases," he added.

Talking to the correspondents, a jailer of a central jail said they are not getting proper supply of clothes for inmates. Due to the shortage, it gets difficult to ensure attires for all of them, said the official. "We at times asked for 50-set prison clothes but only got 10 sets," he said.

He further said if a convicted prisoner moved around in regular dress, it often creates obstacle in ensuring tougher surveillance. For this reason, inmates got a chance to escape, the official added.

Contacted, Amzad Hossain Don, jailer of Rangpur prison, said they have received the letter and already taken necessary steps. They have around 300 convicted inmates in the jail and all of them are wearing the assigned uniforms, he added.

According to prison sources, there are around 15,000 convicted inmates in the country's 68 jails now and some 68,000 inmates are waiting for their trials to end.

A man then stepped out of the SUV and verbally abused them and left the spot. When the vehicle stopped at a traffic light, officer Wasif knocked on its window and introduced himself. At that, the occupants of the vehicle stepped out and started hurling abuse and assaulting him, the complaint said.

When his wife tried to save him, they also assaulted her and left.

Video of the incident caught by bystanders went viral on social media.

Erfan and his bodyguard Zahidul were sentenced to one year in prison the next day for illegally possessing walkie-talkies and foreign liquor, after Rab officials led by an executive magistrate raided Haji Salim's building in the capital's Chawkbazar.

Erfan was granted adinterim bail in the cases in which he was sentenced.

On January 5, police submitted final reports in the arms and drugs cases to court, which said police did not find evidence to support allegations against Erfan in the two cases.Erfan's bodyguard Md Zahidul Mollah was charged with possession of an illegal firearm and narcotics.

Meanwhile, two courts discharged Erfan from the arms and narcotics cases.

The HC on March 18 granted Erfan bail in the assault case.

# Sultana Sarawatara Zaman's 1st death anniversary today

Today is the first death anniversary of Professor Emeritus Sultana Sarawatara Zaman, a freedom fighter and social worker, said a press release. She passed away on this day in 2020, at age 87.

To mark the occasion, Bangladesh Protibondhi Foundation, which she founded in 1984, has published a commemorative album, "A Vision Accomplished".

Prof Zaman taught developmental psychology at Dhaka University and established the first Shishu Bikash Clinic at Psychiatry Department of Dhaka Medical College Hospital. In 1984, she was awarded a doctoral degree from Emory University, Atlanta, US.

Prof Zaman received Rokeya Padak in 2008. She established an orphanage (Khela Ghar) for abandoned children found in the refugee camps in Kalyani, West Bengal, India near Jashore border. She went on to establish an advanced dressing station

for injured freedom fighters and civilians at Sona Masjid, Chapainawabganj, a subsector within sector-7, which was commanded by her husband Lt Col Quazi Nooruzzaman Bir Uttam.

Prof Zaman has left behind two daughters -- Prof Naila Khan and Lubna Marium -- and son Quazi Nadeem Omar, a freedom fighter.
