

Son of martyred freedom fighter awaits allowance in despair

"My father Bocharam Das is a martyred freedom fighter, recognised by the government. But we are not getting any facilities given to the martyred freedom fighter's family by the government," said Monaram Das, 51, son of the martyred freedom fighter.

"For the last 11 years, I have been appealing to the ministry concerned and local administration but got no response due to some unknown reason," he said.

"We only get invitation letter on Victory Day and Independence Day and except for the invitation letter, we have not been entitled to any facilities," he added.

"My father Bocharam Das along with ten other freedom fighters was martyred while fighting against the Pakistani occupation forces in Gaibandha's Trimohini Ghat area during the country's liberation war," said Monaram Das, adding they didn't get his father body.

Monaram runs his family catching fish but nowadays he is almost unemployed due to scarcity of fish in local water bodies.

Monaram Das was one and half years old when his father Bocharam Das joined the country's Liberation War in 1971. Bocharam Das could not return to his little baby as he was martyred during the Liberation War.

After some years of independence, Monaram became an orphan as his mother Suniti Bala Das

died without getting a treatment. Since then, poverty has become his lifetime companion.

Martyred freedom fighter Bocharam Das's co-fighter Noor Ali said, "Martyred freedom fighter Bocharam Das is recognised only in papers but not in reality as his only son Monaram Das isn't getting any government facilities."

"We are working to get government facilities for him and his family members," he said adding they do not know why Monaram is not getting government facilities entitled to freedom fighter's ward. "Bocharam Das was a frontline fighter in the battle field during the liberation war in 1971," he added.

Monaram Das said taking help of his father's co-fighters he appealed to the ministry concerned for getting government facilities and he has been assured that he will start enjoying government facilities by this current year 2021. "But I don't know when I will get result," he said adding he got such promises earlier as well.

Hatibandha Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Samiul Amin said martyred freedom fighter Bocharam Das had all kinds of documents and was enlisted in both the Indian list and Bangladesh list.

"Our recommendation was sent to the ministry concerned for providing all kinds of government facilities to Monaram Das, the lone son of martyred freedom fighter Bocharam Das six months ago," the UNO said adding that he is also communicating to the ministry in this regard.

Bangabandhu's youngest daughter and the prime minister's younger sister Sheikh Rehana was also present.

At the ceremony, video messages of Pope Francis and Indian National Congress President Sonia Gandhi were screened.

The theme of the celebrations is "The Eternal Mujib", but a separate theme for each day has been selected with yesterday's one being "Bangabandhu: Pioneer of Peace, Freedom and Humanity".

Foreign Minister AK Abdul Momen delivered the welcome address while eminent

political scientist Rounaq Jahan made the keynote presentation on yesterday's theme.

A video presentation by former foreign minister AH Mahmood Ali, MP, on yesterday's theme was also played.

Acute gas crisis continues to hit parts

Like them, thousands of people in different areas of the capital, including Mohammadpur, Adabor, Lalmatia, Dhanmondi, Eskaton, Indira Road, Razabazar, Green Road and Jigatola continued to face hardships for the second straight day yesterday due to a gas crisis.

Titas Gas Transmission and Distribution Company Ltd officials said the problem began after one of their feeder lines was damaged around 9:00pm on Monday while construction work was underway at Salehpur bridge over the Turag river in Amin Bazar, on the outskirts of the city.

Titas officials blamed the Roads and Highways Department (RHD), saying the pipeline was damaged by a RHD constructor.

RHD officials, on the other hand, claimed that they were unaware of the connection on RHD land since the pipeline was built without permission.

Titas officials, however, claimed they did take permission during the installation of the line.

"We are working and trying to repair the pipeline by today," Titas Director (Operations) Shafiqul Islam Khan told The Daily Star yesterday.

Unable to get gas at home, most of the affected people flocked to restaurants in their areas. Others used electric cookers.

Under the circumstances, restaurants in those

areas, which mainly use gas cylinders, were making good profits.

Md Abu Taher, manager of Café Modina and Kabab Ghar at Zakir Hossain Road, said their sales had almost doubled.

Similar was the situation at many other restaurants visited by this correspondent yesterday.

Many of the affected people expressed dissatisfaction at the delay in fixing the problem.

Meanwhile, Titas issued a press statement, expressing regret for the situation. It also said the gas pressure would remain low till noon today.

GAS SHORTAGE

Titas Director Shafiqul said the gas crisis yesterday did not result from the damage caused to the pipeline on Monday. He said they were supplying gas through another connection in Amin Bazar, but the overall supply in the Titas network was low, making it difficult for them to get gas to residential areas.

"We are now getting less gas from Gas Transmission Company Limited [GTCL] and trying to keep the gas supply at normal level," he said.

He said there were two supply lines at Amin Bazar. "A 16-inch pipeline was not damaged, we are providing the gas through that," he said.

"Repairing the damaged gas line is taking some time as the connection goes under the river. We hope to repair it by today," he added.

Contacted, Titas Director (public relations) Mirza Mahub Hossain said they need at least 1,900 million standard cubic feet per day (mmcf) of gas from GTCL to meet consumers' demand. Titas, however, was getting 1,600mmcf to 1,650mmcf gas yesterday, he said.

Titas supplies gas in areas including Dhaka, Gazipur, Savar, Narayanganj, Narsingdi, Sherpur, Kishoreganj, Netrokona, Jamalpur, Munshiganj and Mymensingh. It has approximately 28.55 lakh household connections, said its officials.

Contacted, Managing Director Md Atiquzzaman of GTCL told The Daily Star that their supply of Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) yesterday was 300 to 350 mmcf less than that of Tuesday.

"Normally, GTCL gets up to 890mmcf LNG, but we are getting 565mmcf to 570mmcf LNG today," he said yesterday.

He said operations of Summit LNG, which used to supply 500mmcf, got halted following a technical glitch. The crisis may continue for two to three days, he added.

"We lower our gas supply in different sectors proportionately during the winter, but the irrigation season is going now. Because of this, residential areas are facing the crisis for the time being," he added.

The GTCL MD also said they usually get over 3350mmcf and supply 1900mmcf to Titas.

Burnt woman fighting for life

A housewife, severely burnt allegedly by her husband and in laws over family issues in Gaibandha Sadar upazila on Tuesday, in fighting for life a Rangpur Medical College.

Quitting the 22-year-old victim, Inspector of Gaibandha Sadar Police Station Mujibur Rahman said during an altercation over different family issues the husband and mother-in-law of Sharmin Akhtar set her afire around 1:00pm on Tuesday.

Hearing the news after nearly eight hours of the incident, Sharmin's parents rushed to her in-laws' house around 9:00pm, rescued her with 70 burn injuries and took her to Gaibandha General Hospital. She was later shifted to Rangpur Medical College Hospital the same night as her condition deteriorated.

Meanwhile, following a case filed by Sharmin's father Shafiqul Islam with Gaibandha Sadar Police Station, police detained victim's husband Korban Ali, 25, and mother-in-law Kulsum Begum from their house yesterday evening.
