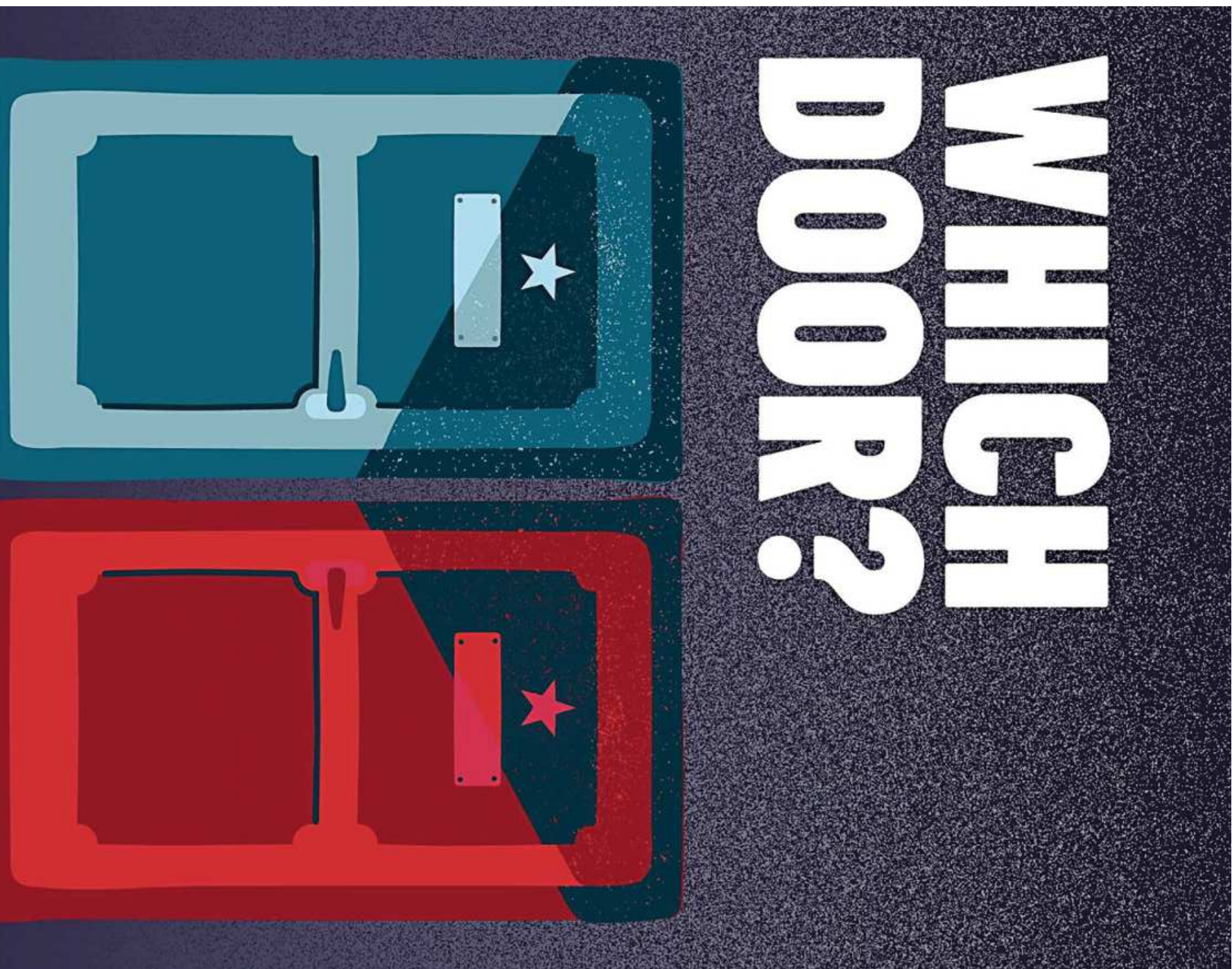

## WhatsApp's coming update will allow users to send images and videos in higher qualities

According to the reports of WABetaInfo, an update in WhatsApp is currently under development that would give the users more control over the amount of compression it applies to sent images and videos.

The two features that are currently in development for the Android app are "Auto," "Best quality," or "Data saver." Currently, avoiding WhatsApp's compression involves changing a file's extension to send it as a document rather than an image or video.

Once this update is introduced, it would let the users force media to be more compressed or lower the amount of compression to ensure images or videos are sent in their highest possible quality.

However, the time of the official release of the two features has not been disclosed yet.

At WitcherCon, Netflix also announced that the second season of the show will debut on December 17th and that an animated prequel, Nightmare of the Wolf, will hit the streaming service on August 23rd.

## Nintendo unveils new Switch game console

Nintendo on Tuesday announced its updated Switch hand-held game console would be available in October, after a pandemic year in which gaming activity surged.

The new Switch OLED model will feature a larger, seven-inch screen and launch at a suggested price of \$350 on October 8, the Japanese firm said in a statement.

The device will feature upgraded graphics and memory and include an adjustable stand to allow for play in "tabletop mode" with multiple players.

The new console "is a great option for players who want to experience the new



vibrant screen when playing in handheld and tabletop mode," said Nintendo of America president Doug Bowser.

"With the addition of this new model to the Nintendo Switch family of systems, people have an additional choice of a system that best fits the gaming experience they desire.

"The Switch, a wildly popular handheld game console, was first released in early 2017 and offers game franchises such as Mario, Donkey Kong, The Legend of Zelda, Animal Crossing and more.

The Switch was the top-selling US console in 2020, a year that saw record sales of video games, consoles and accessories, according to NPD group, a market research firm.

Nintendo reported its highest ever annual profit in 2020 after virus lockdowns caused sales of its blockbuster Switch console to soar.

# How students can make the most out of LinkedIn

Building skills and networks from early on gives one a head start in fast-paced environments. Most professionals and experts recommend being on LinkedIn early on for better professional navigation for students.



LinkedIn exposes students to networking or guidance opportunities, relevant knowledge about their fields, resources, and career options for the future. Here's how students can get the most out of the social platform:

## Building your professional network

It is good to start building a network with people both in and out of your career path. Students can start by connecting with their classmates and seniors from their university. The seniors become prospectus business referrals when they graduate. Those who have not started working or don't have colleagues can connect with university professors.

Get professors to write recommendations for you on LinkedIn. This way, you build up a growth mindset being driven to improve by the feedback you receive. Connecting with university faculty members also allows you to stay connected and learn from them, even after you have graduated.

Freshman students often join various student clubs to enhance their extracurricular activities. These clubs host webinars with industry experts, business competitions and knowledge sharing events where they invite professionals/experts to be a part of it.

Samuel Mursalin, Lecturer, Department of Management at North South University, shares an instance from his experience as a faculty advisor of the NSU Young Entrepreneurship Society (YES) club. "When young club members reach out to corporate professionals for different events, professionals expect these interactions to be done professionally and through

the right channels. LinkedIn is the ideal platform for carrying out the process of reaching out to them effectively."

He also believes that students learn the basics of professional etiquette and can build their skills around it on LinkedIn. "Students understand how professionals set up their profiles on LinkedIn, and take inspiration for highlighting the right skills and experiences. Moreover, LinkedIn products like LinkedIn Sales Navigator, Recruiter, LinkedIn Learning, etc. provide resources for them to work on their professional and personal growth. LinkedIn Blogs are also a good addition for students to read from experts and write more thoughtfully," he added.

## Joining resource/knowledge sharing groups

LinkedIn shows its users some groups they might be interested in joining. Industry experts and professionals share knowledge on specific industries and share insights here. Joining these groups and following their posts helps students gather knowledge about the fields they are interested in.

They can also discover people/experts they can potentially connect with for guidance/advice they require for their professional growth.

One other activity that makes students' experience more educational is posting thoughtful comments or questions on posts by experts. This initiates a tendency to network with experts and have a productive relationship with them.

## Extending the resume

Many companies require a one-pager CV -- which isn't a lot of room to fit in every

skill and experience. LinkedIn makes it possible to include more in-depth information about experiences where students may highlight the challenges they could overcome or the skills they acquired in the process. Putting one's LinkedIn profile URL on a resume is a great idea in job applications. This allows recruiters to have a look at your profile and figure out further information about you.

Apart from adding experiences on LinkedIn, students require some etiquette to pursue connections here too.

"As a lecturer, I have come across students from multiple academic disciplines who think being on LinkedIn isn't necessary at their age or for their major. Students from Pharmacy departments or students in their 1st or 2nd semester would even argue on this. Something they need to understand is that LinkedIn isn't a place where only job/resource seekers gather. It is a platform where people nurture professional relationships and hone their networking skills," says Mohammed Abdul Mumin Evan, Lecturer, Department of Marketing and Int'l Business, North South University.

"Sending a note along with a connection request to someone unfamiliar, not posting irrelevant photos on your LinkedIn profile, and not writing informal comments on formal posts are some crucial manners students can learn from being on the platform," he adds.

## Sharing updates with others

LinkedIn has a feature of sharing your professional updates with your network. If you have joined a new university club

or received a certification from an online course, LinkedIn notifies your connections about your update. This helps students enter the pipeline of talent hunters/potential recruiters. This also makes your network aware of the skills you are building, areas of your interests and continuous progress.

## Check out the career path

Students who want to land a job in their preferred position can find people on LinkedIn who are already employed in that role. Going over their LinkedIn profiles can help students get an idea about what skills and experiences are required of them, or how they climbed up the ladder. Incorporating something from their career path to yours is one step forward towards your dream job.

This is also applicable for students who want to get lucrative scholarships in their post-grad degrees. Finding alumni from your desired university and taking inspiration from them about documenting their journey from Undergrad to Post-grad can work as a lead for you to craft your application.

## Landing internships/jobs while in university

Companies usually post job/internship updates on LinkedIn and some even accept applications through LinkedIn as well. If you come across job/internship opportunities where you see yourself fitting in, you can start applying and build a portfolio with experiences from early on. More importantly, if you are into exploring, LinkedIn can help you to discover.

## Comparing the Mazda Miata MX5 and Abarth 124

If the quest is seeking for a roadster easy on the pocket and fun to drive, the thought of a MX5 nibbles through every car enthusiast's mind but, after the introduction of the ND Miata chassis in 2016, along the line, a new competitor has joined the market.



### Verdict

If the Abarth 124 had the features that the MX5 has, it just could be considered a turbo MX5 with a different badge, feature-wise. Although the turbo engine from the 124 sounds a lot more dramatic than the NA Mazda engine, the smoother revving nature and the higher displacement makes the cut. With the price being lower on the Mazda and having more features in the vehicle, no wonder the Mazda is the more popular option within the two. Thus, the saying "Miata is always the answer" holds its value.

The Abarth 124 (centoventiquattro) is the new topless Scorpion badged car from Italy, offering quite a package on similar cash. But the question is, which one is the better car and gives you more value for your money? Keep reading to find out.

### Keeping up with hairdressers and scorpions

The Miata has always been the answer to a lot of enthusiasts when it comes to a fun sports car while having the option to go topless. The ND chassis is no surprise. Keeping up with the smiling front-ends known from Mazda, the headlights contribute to give a meaner look too, making it look even cuter, sort of like when a baby gets angry. On the Fiat side

of things, the car gives off an angrier vibe as the larger grille and bumper contribute to the sportier look. The lines on the car are not overly dramatic as you would expect from an Italian manufacturer but it has enough design cues to let you know it had its fair share of pasta sauce. Step inside in either of the cars, and you will immediately notice that there is not much difference other than some trim bits here and there between both the cars. Both cars provide leather and Alcantara Recaro seats and an Alcantara dash. The reason that both of these cars are so similar is that; both come from the same plant. Yes, Mazda lent a hand to Fiat to manufacture the 124. Both the cars sport the same chassis but the main differences start to

spawn when we go under the bonnet. Overall, the MX5 is simpler looking and rounder in the front than the 124 due to more puffed up fenders but either way, both cars go straight to one point. Being a fun sports car where you can open the top, perhaps on a fun, sunny evening.

### Things take a turn.

When the MX5 and 124 came out in 2016, there was only one engine option. A 1.5L naturally aspirated engine was good enough and it was a direct competitor to the 1.4L turbocharged Abarth engine. The Abarth had an upper hand sporting about 168 bhp and the MX5 had 129 bhp which was very less compared to the Italian car. Although things do take a turn after two years, in 2018, a 2L



version was introduced with 181 bhp under its belt. The Abarth also is missing Apple CarPlay/Android Auto and few key features such as forward and reverse autonomous emergency braking, traffic-sign recognition and reach-adjustable steering wheel. The 124 does, however, have sportier Bilstein suspension and Brembo brakes.

# Factors to consider when you have multiple job offers

You have studied hard, filled out the hour-long applications, taken weird assessments that often made no sense, attended interviews—all so you can get that one piece of good news: you have received a job offer. Now if you are one of the lucky few who happened to receive multiple ones, we are here to guide you on how to choose the right one.

People have different priorities and motivations, while some might be attracted to a higher salary, others will put career progression as their top aim. Unfortunately, there is no one-size-fits-all answer here. All the pros and cons must be weighed to find the perfect job for you. As our jobs take a major portion of our days, it is important to choose correctly.

Amreen Hassan, a Business Analyst at an IT company, explains, "I cannot help but think of jobs from the perspective of what would motivate me to get out of bed every day. No job is easy. There are good times and there are bad times. In terms of the motivator - I like jobs where I am appreciated, I can showcase my skills and can take ownership for the work that I do."

Money is important but money isn't everything. It can be tempting to go with the offer that pays better, especially if you are just starting, but there are a multitude of other factors you are skipping over. It is not always true that the best jobs pay the most. For an early-career position, the opportunity to learn and brand value

often takes precedence.

Having the name of a well-known company or brand in your resume can do wonders for your career. It helps when recruiters and hiring managers see a name they can recognise. It adds more value to the resume. To explain it more plainly, company X who manufactures a well-known brand and pays entry-level executives BDT 40,000 per month will rank higher compared to company Y that does not have a well-known brand but pays BDT 50,000 per month for the same position.

Early career professionals should emphasise skill development. University is there to teach you 'how to learn'. Now that you have mastered it, your practical education begins at the workplace. Shaila Azam, Talent Acquisition Manager at Foodpanda, shares, "What factors to consider depends on the age, freshers should focus on progression plan and learning opportunity. First 3-4 years should be treated as a learning period."

According to Shaila, job seekers should not focus on salary or brand value until they have spent a few years gaining experience. This is best done in growth-stage companies where there are more opportunities to work outside of your designated job function and hence more avenues to innovate and showcase creativity.

Skill development is important for career progression, and this is

best guaranteed through Graduate or Management Trainee (MT) programs. MT programs in Bangladesh are a quick way to climb up the ladder for ambitious and extraordinary students of our country.

Depending on the company, MTs can become managers in 16 to 24 months whereas normally it takes a few more years. "Given that culture, and brand value are about the same, I would choose MT programs because of better career progression," states Subah Shaheen, a Graduate Trainee at a telecommunication firm.

Not everyone can handle the pressure of an MT program and that is something to keep in mind. Our hyper capitalistic society tells us that having a job that pays well and progresses your career is more important than our mental health. However, this can quickly lead to burnout, demotivation, and depression.

Shaila mentions, "Mental health is very important, assess yourself, talk to people who work at the company, research culture and practice, and see if it aligns with your work ethic." It is better to take a low-pressure job where you will slowly rise up the ranks instead of taking a high-pressure one which you will leave in a few months due to burnout.

When it comes to career progression versus career interests, it is better to choose the area of interest. This is because in a few years it might be difficult to switch over to the department of your choice. The

honeymoon period of better brand value or dream organisation will soon fade, and it will be harder to stay on track.

Company culture is a factor that is often ignored. Not all companies work the same way - many do not follow a 9 - 5 model, some companies follow an open office plan with no designated seats. While not as important as career progression or salary, this is something to consider as well.

The people who you will be working with will have a major influence on how you view your work, and no one is more important here than the person you will be working under. It can be quite difficult to know your line manager or their work ethic and style until you have spent a few weeks with them.

The location of your job is another important factor. Many might prefer to be close to their friends and family. As Amreen explains, "I chose my current company over other offers because I got to stay in Dhaka - without any travel over the country or outside it. It paid reasonably well. And the culture and environment are respectable and one where I could be myself."

Deciding which offer to pick can be as nerve-wracking as the recruiting process itself. Try to take as much time as possible to think through it. Seek advice from parents, friends, seniors, and mentors. Remember this is not the end of the world, it is only the beginning.

## Hp 15s-eq1170au

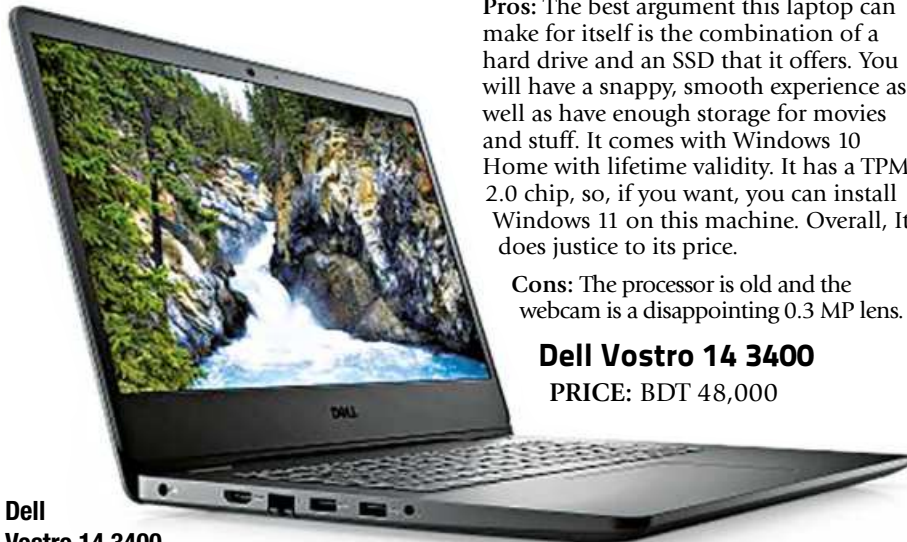
PRICE: BDT 44,500

# Online platforms to buy sacrificial animals for Eid-ul-Azha

Every year the cattle market gets the spotlight during Eid-ul-Azha, the holy festival of sacrifice. However, the situation for such a market is quite different due to the Covid-19 pandemic since last year, as conventional makeshift markets for selling animals for Qurbani can be hazardous for people. But thanks to different online and e-commerce platforms which have availed opportunities online to sell sacrificial animals to meet the purposes of both buyers and sellers. Here is a list of such platforms to check out.

## Bengal Meat

Bengal Meat, an abattoir platform in Bangladesh, is offering full Qurbani service amid this pandemic after getting a great response last year. The price of sacrificial animals in this platform can range from BDT 60,000 to BDT 335,000.

After you are done with selecting the animal, they'll complete the slaughtering procedure, the meat processing and packaging in their own farm, and deliver the meat through their chiller van at your doorstep if you live anywhere in Dhaka, Chattogram and Sylhet.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, they are not delivering live cattle at this moment. Slaughtered meat will be delivered from the 2nd day of Eid in Dhaka and the 5th day of Eid in Chattogram and Sylhet. The last date of placing an order will depend on the availability of cattle and

slaughtering slots.

Customers can pay through a card payment system, online payment system or cash. The displayed sacrificial animals have all necessary details such as age, breed, feed, weight, etc. for your convenience. Check out their website to have a detailed idea about slaughtering and delivery charges that depend on various factors.

## Haat Bazaar

Haat Bazaar, an online-based shop, is providing an opportunity to buy sacrificial animals for Eid-ul-Azha. Their service is limited to Dhaka only. The live weight of cattle can differ from 160kg to 190kg and the price is BDT 450 per kg. So each animal can cost between BDT 72,000 and BDT 85,500.

If you are looking for a local and naturally raised cow, it can be a good option for you. You need to order at least 5 days before Eid and you'll get the delivery of it 2-3 days before Eid. Delivery charge is completely free within Dhaka city. Customers can pay through card payment or cash at their convenience. Slaughtering service is still not available in Haat Bazaar.

## Sadeeq AGRO

Sadeeq AGRO, another online platform, provides options for people in Dhaka to buy live cattle and goats or have 'Full Qurbani Service' where they can get the delivery of processed meat after slaughtering.

You can buy any live cow or goat ranging from BDT 80,000 to BDT 300,000

even the day before Eid. There's no last date for it. But if you want the slaughtering service too, you need to confirm your order 6-7 days before Eid. You can get a discount on slaughtering service in case you pay through some particular bank cards.

For example, there is a 10% discount on such service if you pay the full amount through City Bank, One Bank, Dhaka

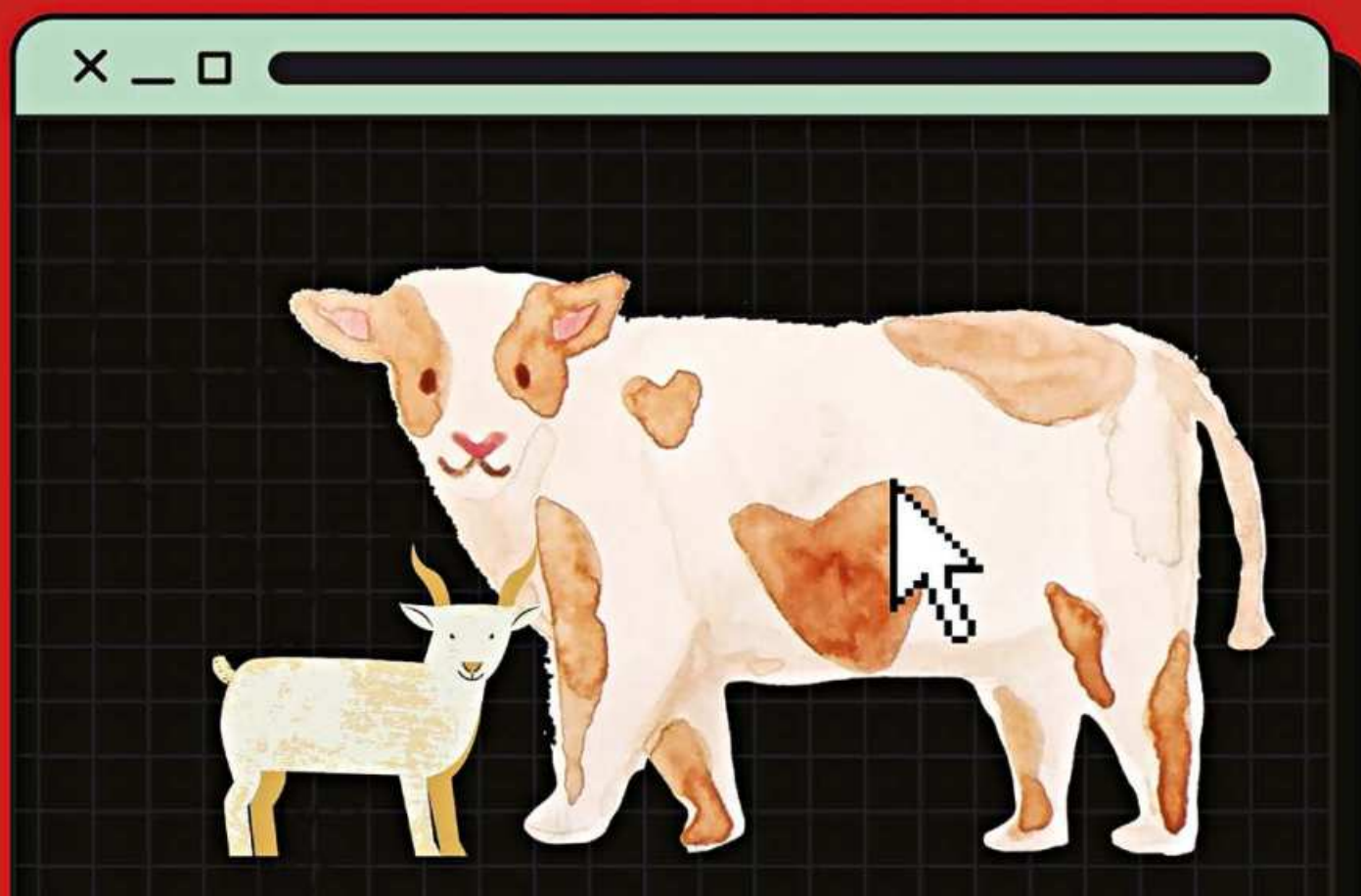
## Other e-commerce sites as the online cattle market

Due to the huge demand for sacrificial animals amid this pandemic, many e-commerce sites have come forward with an online cattle market initiative. This type of online market helps both buyers and sellers.

Daraz has been selling sacrificial animals since 2016 targeting Eid-ul-Azha. Cattle are divided into groups according to their price such as above BDT 40,000, above BDT 80,000, and above BDT 100,000 at their site. Goats are also available for purchase. Your purchased cow or goat will be delivered within 6-14 days. This service is accessible in Dhaka, Chattogram, Sylhet and all over the country. You can see each animal's age, breed, feed, etc. at Daraz's website.

# Podcasts worth checking out on Spotify

Spotify has gone beyond streaming music and entered the podcast scenario, being the first runners up in the podcast race. In just a couple of years, Spotify podcasts have garnered a substantial audience. Podcasts are now in the limelight more than ever considering people's lives have come to a standstill as a casualty of the pandemic thus confiding in apps like Spotify. Here are our picks for some Spotify podcast recommendations.

## The Joe Rogan Experience

Commencing with probably the most famous podcast, the JRE podcast is one of the most heard podcasts on any platform, with episode ratings ranging from 9.7 to 9.8 on a scale of 10 and an overall rating of 8.8/10 on IMDb.

The program is presented by American comedian and UFC commentator Joe Rogan with Brian Redban as co-host and producer before he was replaced by Jamie Vernon in 2013.

Joe Rogan is among the oldest podcasters, starting in 2019 and hosts conversations with his array of guests, listening from fellow comedians, like Russell Peters, authors, various forms of artists, and public figures like Elon Musk and Mike Tyson.

As of December 2020, the podcast is listed exclusively on Spotify. The

tip of the iceberg is that the podcast is powered by advertisements, alluring unsubscribed Spotify users, and podcast admirers.

## Stuff You Should Know

Conceived in 2008 by Josh Clark and Chuck Bryant, the podcast is among the most recommended on Spotify and other platforms. With over 1400 episodes, the podcast hosts elaborate conversations on a plethora of themes, some of which are narcolepsy, drugs and hallucinogens, inflation and its roots, global issues like global warming, chaos theory, and controversial, debated topics like Satanism and cannibalism.

The hosts also dive deep into behavioural subjects and explore how psychopaths work. The best part about starting this podcast, given that it has 1400+ episodes, is the independent nature of the episodes that allows listeners to start from any episode

without a requisite.

## Naval Ravikant Podcast

Naval Ravikant is an entrepreneur of Indian descent and the co-founder and former CEO of AngelList. Growing up in an unsafe neighbourhood with first-hand gun violence, Naval had to seek sanctuary in local public libraries where he had a fundamental relationship with books of all sorts that helped him achieve exceptional clarity on multiple topics. His podcast is directed towards like-minded young entrepreneurs.

He offers suggestions on career, cryptocurrencies, managing finances and business, pursuing wealth, simultaneously addressing important mental health issues like reducing anxiety, and talks about life and happiness in his audio show.

Naval's tweet-storm on "How to Get Rich (without getting lucky)" brought him to the public eye making his show

one of the most heard podcasts with a staggering fanbase.

## Simple Ken

Simple Ken is hosted by Kenny Sebastian. Kenny is an Indian stand-up comedian who has been in the limelight for playing a pivotal role in bringing the revolution to the Indian stand-up scene. His podcast is only a year old with 28 episodes.

Kenny welcomes other contemporary comedians as guests and covers some invigorating, out-of-the-ordinary matters that are novel like toxic positivity, converse about the new normal, motivation, and friendship, and sheds light on how to navigate negativity.

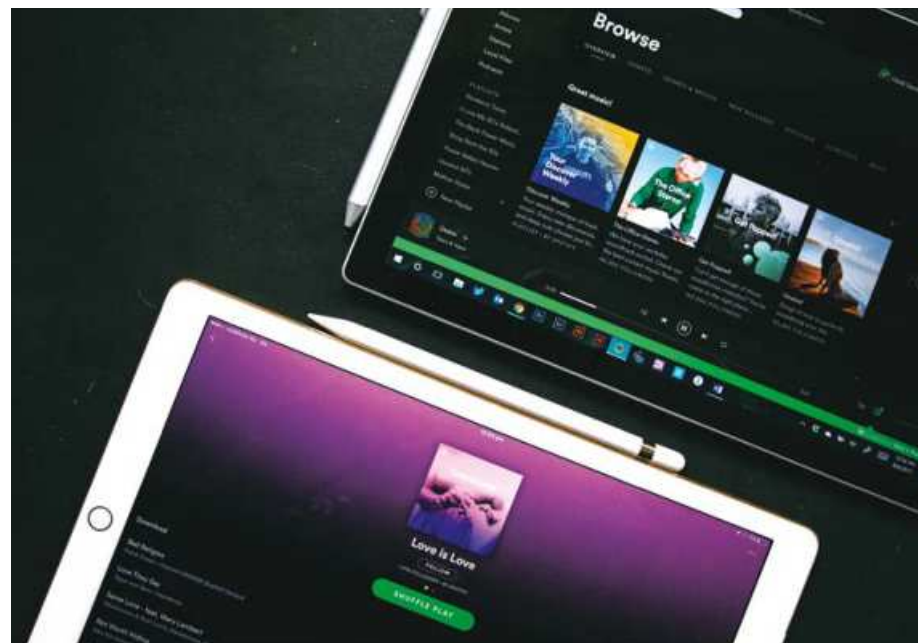
The podcast reflects the comedian's unique sense of humour and is refreshing and amiable for the newer podcast audiences. Simple Ken is available on YouTube and Spotify.

## In the Dark

If crime-related mysteries have you spellbound then this podcast is for you. Narrated by Madeleine Baran, the show's genre is Investigative journalism and Crime. The show is structured to investigate real stories and scrutinise the law enforcement system.

In the Dark is a weekly show consisting of two seasons; the first season of 10 episodes analyses the infamous case of kidnapping and murder of the 11-year old Jacob Wetterling that went on for 27 years, and the second season explores the case of Mississippi hailing Curtis Flowers who was tried six times for the same quadruple homicide in 1996 and spent more than 20 years trying to win the case.

It is worth mentioning that the series is a two-time Peabody Award winner.
