

# Barishal city corporation announces budget with focus on infrastructure

Without increasing existing rates or imposing any new tax, Barishal City Corporation has announced a budget of around Tk 416 crore for the year 2021-22.

Mayor Serbiabat Sadik Abdullah announced the budget from a virtual session yesterday afternoon.

BCC CEO Syed Faruk Ahmed said around 33 percent of the budget will come from the annual development Programme; 11 percent from government allocations -- bulk and special; while 21 percent will come from government and foreign aid projects. The city corporation plans to raise the other 35 percent on its own.

Among others, the budget has allocated Tk 264.21 crore for developing infrastructure -- including roads, bridges, and other constructions -- Tk 36 crore for waste management, Tk 41 crore for administrative and office management, and Tk 9.79 crore for health services.

Notable among these are the Tk 43 crore plan to construct and renovate city roads, Tk 10 crore to update the waste management system, and constructing children's parks for 30 wards.

Syed Faruk said though Tk 280 crore was allocated through government and foreign aid projects in last year's budget, only Tk 17.91 crore was received, which is six per cent of the total proposal. This made it difficult to complete planned development activities of the city.

He told The Daily Star that though no new taxes have been imposed this time, it is possible to raise enough revenues through a cutting-edge and corruption-free system.

He mentioned that the city corporation raised Tk 77 crore last year and plans to raise Tk 113 crore this year.

"The government is pushing the city corporation to become self-sufficient, and we have successfully completed 17 percent of our development work from our own coffers," Faruk said. "I think we'll be able to do most of our development activities this way in the near future."

Mayor Serbiabat said if the city corporation gets enough fund from the government, they can achieve the calendar year's targets.

"We have planned to increase revenue income by maximising tax realisation from a variety of existing sources," he said.

# HC tells Viqarunnisa to admit 19 twins

The High Court yesterday directed the authorities of Viqarunnisa Noon School and College to immediately admit 19 twins to first grade, as their 19 fellow siblings have already been admitted to the institution through lottery.

The HC bench of Justice M Enayetur Rahim and Justice Md Mostafizur Rahman gave the directive following a petition filed by the twins' fathers.

Petitioners' counsel Tasmia Prodhan told The Daily Star that 19 pairs of twins (38 students) had applied for admission to first grade at the school in January.

Among them, single student from each of the 19 pairs were admitted to the institution through lottery, but the rest 19 were not admitted.

As a result, their guardians have been facing troubles, she said.

The lawyer also said the guardians of the twin candidates have also applied to the education ministry in this regard.

During the hearing, Barrister Tasmia told the HC that twins need to stay and study at the same place and institution for their mental development.

"I'm also a mother of twins. I have noticed that if such babies are kept detached or stay in separate environments, it has an adverse impact on them," the counsel further said.

Deputy Attorney General Bipul Bagmar told The Daily Star that the High Court had earlier passed a similar order for admitting twin students to the same institution.

# ELECTRICAL, SOLAR TRADES UCEP, Schneider to train 15,000 youths

Underprivileged Children's Educational Programmes (UCEP) Bangladesh and Schneider Electric Foundation will train over 15,000 underprivileged youths in electrical and solar trades across Bangladesh over the next five years.

The UCEP Bangladesh has recently signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the France-based development organisation, whereby they will be establishing modern labs for vocational training for underprivileged youths in Bangladesh.

Schneider will help set up 19 labs on those trades in UCEP Bangladesh's 19 technical schools to train unemployed youths in the electrical and renewable energy field and assist them in upgrading their skills level.

The foundation will also develop the capacity of the UCEP Bangladesh trainers to provide vocational training through.

"We have launched this initiative with the aim of contributing to bridging the skill gap and enable underprivileged youth to gain access to the job market, further contributing to the country's socio-economic development in Bangladesh," said, Manisha Singh, Sr GM and Head CSR, South Asia, Schneider Electric.

Bangladesh Tea Workers' Union General Secretary Ram Bhajan Koiri said tea garden owners publicised that tea workers don't have coronavirus. It was included in the category of food sector, workers had to continue work without ensuring any health rules.

There is little effort to conduct Covid-19 test among the tea workers and there is no data on the infection in tea gardens, he said.

Writer and researcher Philip Gain said tea workers live in highly-congested housing facilities and there is a very high risk of infection, especially as Delta variant is highly contagious.

Bangladesh Trade Union Sangha Central Committee Joint General Secretary Prakash Dutta said workers have never been in good position because neither the employers nor the government truly cares for them, although they are at the heart of the country's economic wheel.

Most workers, whether in hotel, transport or shoes sectors, have no job contracts or guarantee. They hardly come under the government incentives. Anomalies were even found in incentives meant for the poorer section of the people, he said.

Speakers called for a stronger movement for ensuring rights of the workers of the country.

Dhaka University International Relations Prof CR Abrar presided over the discussion. Cultural activist Bithi Ghosh moderated it.

Bangladesh United Communist League General Secretary Mosharrif Hossain Nannu, Bangladesh Samajtantrik Dal Barishal Branch Member Secretary Manisha Chakraborty, Bangladesh Tourism and Hotels Workers Employees Federation Joint Convener Farhana Yasmin, researcher Priscila Raj, and labour leaders Amina Akter and Taslima Akter also spoke.
