Indigenous People's Forum, said, "It has been proven that protection of land rights of indigenous peoples is not possible with the existing land laws of the country. The government should empower and mobilise the CHT land commission, and establish the commission for indigenous groups of the plains, which authorities promised 13 years ago."

The discussants also criticised the government's role in not recognising the country's indigenous peoples as "indigenous". Instead, it still uses the term "ethnic minorities" or "small ethnic groups".

Syeda Rizwana Hasan, chief executive of Bangladesh Environmental Lawyers' Association, said, "There is a political goal behind such land grabbing and eviction. The government does not recognise them as indigenous communities and even ordered NGOs not to use the word 'indigenous'."

"We need to focus on this political motive and build a political discourse of our own to protect land rights of these groups," she added.

Fazle Hossain Badsha, lawmaker and secretary general of Bangladesh Workers' Party, said, "It is really alarming that oppression of indigenous people is continuing even in this pandemic. National Human Rights Commission is supposed to submit a report on the protection of their land rights this month."

"We shall then take this report to the parliament and emphasise mobilising and empowering the CHT land commission, which is currently non-functional. We should also form a separate ministry for indigenous peoples of the plains, otherwise they will always remain excluded from the national budget," he said.

Man, son held for beating up relatives

Police yesterday detained a man and his son over beating up two of their relatives after tying them up to a pipe at their house in Shadapur area of Savar.

The victims are Abdul Mannan (55), grandfather-in-law of Kalam; and Shahid Mollah (53).

Abdul Mannan's son Faridur Rahman Joy told The Daily Star that the incident occurred due to family altercation.

Contacted, Kamal Hossen, inspector (investigation) of Savar Model Police Station, said filing of a case over the matter was underway.

Foreign Minister AK Abdul Momen recently said the government had rejected the WB proposal in which it called for giving refugees all kinds of legal rights, including birth and death registration, working, buying land, education, employment and engaging in business.

Meanwhile, a report issued by the foreign ministry said improving the living standards of Rohingyas would encourage them to settle in the country permanently.

The report, which was also placed in the parliamentary committee, said bypassing the issue of Rohingya repatriation, western countries and relevant UN agencies have long been interested in taking up long-term projects to improve the living standards of Rohingyas in the camps.

The international community is becoming more active in increasing the quality of life and facilities for the camps, providing Rohingyas with formal education, technical training, job creation through social business and various development projects.

Such activities, especially the continuous improvement of the quality of life in the camps, could encourage the Rohingyas to settle permanently in Bangladesh and severely hamper the repatriation process, the foreign ministry said in its report.

In this regard, the prime minister has approved the proposal of the foreign ministry to take a policy decision to keep the living standards and facilities of the Rohingya camps at a reasonable and limited level in the interest of repatriation.

Among others, committee members Foreign Minister AK Abdul Momen; State Minister for Foreign Affairs Shahrir Alam; and lawmakers Nurul Islam Nahid, Golam Farooq Khandaker Prince, Abdul Majid Khan and Habibe Millat took part.

Meanwhile, the World Bank has clarified that the proposals made in its Refugee Policy Review Framework is a global document, not Bangladesh-specific, meant to assess the effectiveness of the refugee-related projects funded by the global lender. It also said it was not in a position to negotiate the policy issues.



Enamul, Rupon refused bail

The High Court on Wednesday refused to grant bail to "Casino Brothers" -- Enamul Haque Enu and Rupon Bhuiyan -- in two money laundering cases involving Tk 2.17 crore.

The court, however, kept the appeal petitions for bail, stand over (waiting for hearing), in the cases for next three months.

The HC bench of Justice M Enayetur Rahim and Justice Md Mostafizur Rahman came up with the order after hearing the appeal petitions filed by Enamul and Rupon challenging the lower court orders that rejected their bail petitions.

Enamul and Rupon cannot get released from jail following the HC orders, Anti-Corruption Commission lawyer Khurshid Alam Khan told The Daily Star.

The senior special metropolitan judge's court of Dhaka on October 10 last year rejected the bail petitions in the cases.

The Criminal Investigation Department of police filed the cases with Sutrapur Police Station against the two accused on September 24, 2019.

Lawyer Shaharia Kabir Biplab appeared for Enamul and Rupon during virtual hearing of the appeals.

Two remanded over receiving Covid vaccine at home in Ctg

A Chattogram court yesterday placed two persons on one-day remand each in a case filed in connection with getting Covid-19 vaccine at home in Chattogram city.

Metropolitan Magistrate Hossain Md Reza passed the order after Khulshi police sought five-day remand for each, said Md Kazi Shahabuddin Ahmad, additional deputy commissioner (prosecution) of Chattogram Metropolitan Police.

On Monday, police arrested Md Hasan (35) and Mobarak Ali (33) after a photo of Hasan being administered Covid-19 vaccine at his home went viral on Facebook.

Chattogram City Corporation medical officer Tapan Kumar Chakraborty filed the case with Khulshi Police Station accusing Hasan, Mobarak, one Md Sazzad and CCC health department lab technician Bishu Dey.

According to the case statement, Bishu took the vaccines from the Mostafa Hakim Degree College vaccination centre and administered those to the three charging Tk 1,000 each.

Sazzad and Bishu are currently absconding.
