# Malaysia hunts for new PM

King meets party leaders, urges unity after Muhyiddin quits

#### REUTERS, Kuala Lumpur

Malaysia's king asked leaders from different parties to work together to address the economic and health woes facing the country, as he yesterday began a search to replace Muhyiddin Yassin as prime minister.

Muhyiddin resigned on Monday with no obvious successor, deepening a long-running political crisis as the Southeast Asian nation battles a Covid-19 surge and an economic slump. He cited lack of parliamentary support but will stay on as caretaker until a new government is formed.

The constitutional monarch, King Al-Sultan Abdullah, who met leaders of political parties yesterday, had previously ruled out elections because of the pandemic, saying he would appoint a prime minister he believed likely to command a majority.

In line with the king's decree, the speaker of Malaysia's parliament asked lawmakers yesterday to each submit a letter to the palace stating their choice of the next prime minister.

"The issue was not just about appointing a new prime minister, but what's more important that was



stressed by the King is to come up with a form of politics that is more peaceful for the people," Anwar told reporters

Malaysia has been in a state of political flux since widespread graft accusations led to the 2018 election defeat of the United Malays National Organisation (UMNO), which had governed for more than 60 years since independence.

But that alliance was also fragile, and a constant tussle with UMNO, which balked at playing second fiddle, prompted Muhyiddin's resignation after just 17 months in office. CHOICE OF PM

At present, no lawmaker has a clear majority in parliament. The opposition bloc and UMNO, Malaysia's biggest party, are split on support for their prime ministerial candidates.

No single political party has a majority in parliament, so a successful prime ministerial candidate will have to forge a coalition.

Malaysia's lawmakers must submit their choice of prime minister by 4 pm (0800 GMT) today in letters to the palace, parliament speaker Azhar Azizan Harun said in a notice to lawmakers.

Last year, when then premier Mahathir quit, the king met all 222 members of parliament to seek their choices for the next leader. After a week of discussions, he picked Muhyiddin.

China holds assault drills near Taiwan REUTERS, Beijing/Taipei

China carried out assault

drills near Taiwan yesterday, with warships and fighter jets exercising off the southwest and southeast of the island in what the country's armed forces said was a response to "external interference" and "provocations".

Taiwan, which Beijing claims as Chinese territory, has complained of repeated People's Liberation Army (PLA) drills in its vicinity in the past two years or so, part of a pressure campaign to force the island to accept

China's sovereignty. In a brief statement, the PLA's Eastern Theatre Command said warships,

anti-submarine aircraft and fighter jets had been dispatched close to Taiwan to carry out "joint fire assault and other drills

using actual troops". It did not give details.

A senior official familiar with Taiwan's security planning told Reuters that China's air force had carried out a "capturing air supremacy" drill, using their advanced J-16 fighters. Taiwan's Defence

aircraft entered its air defence zone, including two nuclear-capable H-6K bombers and six J-16 fighters, and that it had scrambled jets to warn

The PLA statement noted that "this exercise is a necessary action" considering recent 'provocations' by the US and Taiwan.

## Death toll tops 1400

Rescuers race against time and bad weather

Rescuers in Haiti Monday used heavy equipment and their bare hands to hunt for survivors under buildings flattened three days ago by a massive earthquake that killed more than 1,400 people, while an approaching storm threatened more suffering.

Flash floods and mudslides were possible as the front bore down on the Caribbean southwestern nation's

peninsula, which was hardhit by a 7.2-magnitude quake that toppled thousands of buildings early Saturday.

Hospitals have been overwhelmed with the influx of injured patients, and workers were at a loss with how they might cope with Tropical Depression Grace.

Haiti's civil protection agency gave a preliminary toll Monday of 1,419 dead and 6,900 injured in the powerful quake that struck about 100 miles (160 kilometers) to the west of the capital Port-au-Prince.

The earthquake also destroyed more than 37,000 homes, officials said.

According to the US National Hurricane Center, Haiti and the Dominican Republic -- which share the Caribbean island of

Hispaniola -- could expect five to 10 inches of rain from Grace, "with isolated maximum totals of 15 inches" across southern areas through Tuesday.

"This heavy rainfall may lead to flash and urban flooding, and possible mudslides," the NHC warned. Residents faced a dilemma of staying

outside to protect themselves from aftershocks, or returning to damaged

buildings to shelter from Grace's heavy rain, which was soaking Haiti by Monday afternoon

Some aid has come in from abroad, including specialized search crews from the United States as well as 15.4 tons of food, medicine and water from Mexico.

A 7.0-magnitude quake in January 2010 left much of Port-au-Prince and nearby cities in ruins, killing more than 200,000. More than 1.5 million Haitians were

made homeless in that disaster.

The latest earthquake comes just over a month after President Jovenel Moise was assassinated in his home by a team of gunmen, shaking a country already battling poverty, spiraling gang violence and Covid-19.

## Stay out of politics

HK leader tells legal bodies

#### AFP, Hong Kong Hong Kong's leader

yesterday warned one of the city's top legal bodies against getting involved in politics, in the latest sign of the government telling professional bodies to toe Beijing's line.

Chief executive Carrie Lam's comments towards the Law Society come as China remoulds Hong Kong in its own image.

Lam told reporters that actions might be taken against them, without spelling out what measures the government might take.

The warning comes as the Law Society will next week it will elect five of its 20 council members and pro-establishment figures are concerned more liberal, prodemocracy minded lawyers might win.

On Sunday the People's Daily, the mouthpiece of China's ruling Communist Party, published a commentary described Hong Kong's Bar Association -- which represents barristers -- as a "street rat".

## Bob Dylan sued for allegedly sexually abusing girl in 1965 AFP, New York Bob Dylan has been sued in a New York

court by a woman who says the US rock and folk legend sexually abused her almost 60 years ago when she was 12. The lawsuit filed Friday alleges that Dylan abused the plaintiff, referred to in

court documents as J.C., over a six-week period between April and May 1965. It says Dylan "exploited his status as

a musician to provide J.C. with alcohol and drugs and sexually abuse her multiple times."

The suit also accused Dylan, who turned 80 in May, of physically threatening the girl.

The alleged abuse took place at the apartment Dylan owned in New York's famous Chelsea Hotel, according to the lawsuit.

A spokesperson for Dylan, whose real name is Robert Zimmerman, said "the 56-year-old claim is untrue and will be vigorously defended."

The accuser, who now lives in Greenwich, Connecticut, says Dylan caused her "severe psychological damage and emotional trauma." She is seeking unspecified damages.

The lawsuit was filed a day before the window for filing claims under New York State's Child Victims Act closed.

The act allowed victims of abuse to sue their alleged attackers irrespective years after the release of his first.

In 2016, Dylan won the Nobel Prize for Literature "for having created new poetic expressions within the great American song tradition."
