

SWELLING PADMA, JAMUNA

Two major rivers devour more fresh areas in Manikganj, Tangail

Erosion has taken a serious turn in Manikganj and Tangail as flood water continues increasing in the Padma and Jamuna rivers, devouring more fresh areas.

Water level in the Jamuna, Dhaleshwari and Jhenai rivers was flowing above the danger level in Tangail.

Meanwhile, a government primary school and Azimnagar Union Health Centre in Harirampur upazila of Manikganj devoured in the river Padma.

Despite repeated reminder, Water Development Board (WDB) authorities said they could not stop the erosion due to strong current in the Padma, our Manikganj correspondent reports.

Azimnagar Union Parishad (UP) Chairman Billal Hossain said more than 70 percent of the health centre building was washed away by the strong current of the river around 11:00pm on Saturday and the remaining rest part went into the river womb yesterday morning.

The health centre was established in 2014 at a cost of Tk 81 lakh, the chairman said.

He said last year, when it was only 150 yards away from the river he wrote a letter to the higher authorities and also informed the Harirampur Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) about the erosion.

"The UNO told me that he had informed the WDB authorities. But WDB authorities did not take any immediate initiative to protect the health centre from erosion," the UP chairman further said.

In the second week of this month, the Padma river washed away Sutlari Ramchandrapur Government Primary School in the upazila.

Moreover, over a hundred houses and vast croplands have already been devoured in the river, while many other institutions in the upazila are still facing serious erosion threat, locals said.

Manikganj WDB Executive Engineer Md Main Uddin said, "Due to strong currents in the river nothing can be done at present to prevent the erosion. Attempts have been made by dumping sand-filled geo-bags in some areas in the past, but we did not succeed."

A government primary school was devoured in the mighty river this month,

he added.

Our Tangail correspondent reported that water level continued increasing in the Jamuna and its branches in Tangail yesterday due to onrush of water from the upstream.

As a result, serious erosion hit the riverbanks and fresh areas along the river.

With the increasing water level erosion intensified at different places in the district.

Around 100 dwelling houses, roads, mosque, embankments and other important structures in five upazilas of

the district have already been devoured by the rivers, sources said.

Rafiqul Islam of Bhalkutia village in Bhuapur upazila said a concrete road was damaged by huge pressure of the flood water yesterday morning, disrupting communication.

A mosque is also on the verge of collapse and villagers were trying to save it by dumping soil bags, he said.

Ramjan Ali of Alipur village in Kalihati upazila said he is taking preparation to shift his dwelling house at other place once again.

"Due to erosion by the Jamuna I have

shifted my house three times before," he said.

Gohaliabari UP Chairman Hazrat Ali Talukder said around 100 dwelling houses at Alipur and other adjacent villages under his union were devoured by the river during the flood while nearly 100 more houses are facing erosion threat.

Tangail WDB Executive Engineer Sirajul Islam said due to increasing water level they cannot stop the erosion.

According to WDB water was flowing 34 centimetre above the danger mark in the Jamuna river yesterday.

Fodder crisis deepens in flood-hit Sirajganj

Two lakh animals affected in floodwater, 154 acres of grazing land submerged

Fodder crisis has become a double blow for the flood affected people of Sirajganj, one of the major dairy hubs in the country. The people who have become stranded due to the flood are worried over feeding their domestic animals as 154 acres of grazing land have submerged in the flood in the district.

Sural Jowadar, a poor farmer of village Bonni Dorota in Sadar upazila, has two cows, but flood waters entered his homestead couple of weeks ago, causing food crisis for his family and the animals.

"We can live without food or minimum food a day but we must feed our domestic animals. All the grazing land in the shoal has become submerged, and we have no money to buy fodder. So, I have shifted the cows to Berabari, another point of the shoal," Sural said.

"The water is increasing very fast and it is just a matter of time until Berabari point gets submerged as well, so I am worried to feed my animals," he added.

Visiting Berabari area last week, this correspondent found that many people were cutting grass in the shoal and a number of cows were grazing. People were coming from long distance in the part of the shoal to collect cattle feed.

"Due to river erosion, we have lost our house and we have taken shelter in the flood protection embankment along with three cows. I have been coming here every morning on my boat for collecting grass over the last couple of weeks." Sujon Miah of Berabari area said.

Sujon will have nowhere else to go another if it (Berabari shoal) gets submerged in flood water.

Like them, most of the flood-hit people can hardly manage fodder for their animals.

According to Sirajganj District Livestock Officer (DLO) Dr Gourango Kumar Talukdar, Sirajganj is one of the major dairy hubs in the country having over 8.78 lakh cows, 3.5 lakh goats and over 1 lakh lambs.

Fodder crisis and crises of shelter are making animal farming costlier and immensely difficult due to the flood, he said.

According to the DLO, around 1.08 lakh cows, 79 thousand goats and 20 thousand lambs have been affected by the flood in the last couple of weeks in Sadar, Chowhdi, Kazipur and Shahzadpur upazila.

Around 154 acres of grazing land have also submerged in the four upazilas deepening fodder crisis, the DLO said, adding that the flood situation is worsening and more animals are likely to be affected in the district.

Flood-hit cattle farmers, however, said in addition to the fodder crisis, various animal diseases have also broken out. "We have already started vaccination to the cattle in the flood-hit areas for preventing diseases. We will take initiative to give fodder support to the affected farmers," The DLO added
