Sons beat up mother, physically challenged sister over occupying land

Case statement says three sons of the septuagenarian woman stabbed her during the incident

An ill-fated septuagenarian mother and her physically and mentally challenged daughter were beaten up and driven out of home by her three land-hungry sons allegedly for occupying 1.33 acres of land.

Elderly mother Jamela Bewa with her daughter Sabina Khatun has taken shelter at the house of her another daughter Rahima Khatun.

The incident took place at Dakshin

At this, the trio got enraged and stabbed their mother Jamela Bewa on July 30.

The eldest son Iman Ali was arrested in a case filed at the police station in connection with the incident. After being released on bail, Iman Ali and others started torturing their mother and the disabled sister again.

Jamela Bewa said that when she went on her land on September 2, they got angry and beat her up and drove her and

Gobdha Bhitarkuti village of Durgapur Sabina out of the home. 'I have lodged union under Aditmari upazila in Lalmonirhat.

After the incident on September 2, Jamela Bewa with her challenged daughter went the house on Monday (September 6) morning, they were barred from entering the house again, alleged Jamela Bewa.

Jamela Bewa said that while her husband Jasim Uddin was alive, he divided the land among his six sons and five daughters.

At that time, he gave 54 decimals land to Sabina Khatun and 79 decimals land

After the death of her husband, her three sons-- Iman Ali, Saiful Islam and Saidul Islam--used to cultivate their lands and gave them share of the crops. With this crop, Jamela Bewa lived separately with her challenged daughter. As her three investigating the incidents before and sons suddenly stopped giving the share of after the case, the police will prepare a crops, she wanted the land back in her possession.

a written complaint with the police. My disabled daughter and I are now suffering from insecurity, 'she said.

Shafiqul Islam, the youngest son of Jamela Bewa, said that the land of their elderly mother and disabled sister was in the possession of their three elder brothers. As they are anti-social and quarrelsome in nature, nothing can be said against them. The police are investigating and they will take legal action, he said.

Contacted the eldest son Iman Ali over his mobile said that he would give reply through the legal means. He expressed unwillingness to reply to the queries from

Aditmari Police Station Officer-in-Charge (OC) Saiful Islam said a case was lodged earlier in the same incident. After charge sheet and submit it to the court soon.



'Laal Shaplar Beel' drawing huge crowd

A huge crowd is thronging every day to see thousands of blossomed bright red water lilies blanketing a swamp that spreads out in Ujirpur and Agailjhara upazilas.

Located about sixty kilometres away from Barisal city, the thousandacre swamp is popularly known as 'Laal Shaplar Beel'. Most part of the beel lies in Satla union of Ujirpur while the rest in Agailjhara.

Locals said the red water lilies grow naturally the low-lying area when it is filled with water in the monsoon and the blossoming of the flower can been seen from August to October. Later on, when the swamp dries up, the land is used for cultivation of Boro rice.

Kajal Ghosh, a manager at a pharmaceutical company, brought his wife and children from Barishal to 'Laal Shaplar Beel'. He said his mood was a bit dampened while

the thousand-acre swamp is popularly known as 'Laal Shaplar Beel'. Most part of the beel lies in Satla union of Ujirpur while the rest in Agailjhara.

Located about 60 kilometres away from Barisal city,

traveling on dilapidated road on increased number of visitors, many way to the site and due to absence of tourist facilities in the area.

However, he and his family forgot all that at the amazing sight of so many red water lilies, he said, adding that the place has the prospect to be a tourist hotspot for the whole country if suitable infrastructure and services for tourists are properly developed there.

Another visitor, Sharmin Haq, said she was awestruck to see the 'Laal Shaplar Beel' and its beauty

could not be expressed in words. Catering to the demand of an locals found a seasonal source of income by providing boat rides in the beel.

Boatman Moti said tourists have been pouring in since August, but most of them complained about poor road condition and lack of essential services and facilities for tourists at the site.

Satla Union Parishad Chairman Shahin Hawladar said the beel was deserted for about two years due to the coronavirus situation. But thanks to thousands of visiting the place every day -- from Barishal and

other parts of the country -- many locals are now making a living by operating tour boats.

Now at least two hundred tour boats are being operated from ten different points of the beel, but business in the area will flourish further when the road repair work and the restrooms are completed, he added.

Ujirpur Upazila Nirbahi Officer Praniti Biswas said the Ministry of Tourism and Civil Aviation last year has undertaken a project to develop infrastructure and other facilities including restrooms for people visiting the 'Laal Shaplar Beel'.

As part of the project, construction work on a boat jetty, at a cost of Tk 40 lakh, will start by the end of this

Besides, six kilometres of road will be repaired in the area by Local Government Engineering Department, he also said.

44 fishermen detained
