
Govt plans to gradually inoculate 80pc population

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday in parliament said efforts were underway to vaccinate students aged 12 and above as she spoke about a government plan to gradually inoculate 80 percent of the country's population against Covid-19

The government wants to jab 50 percent of the population by December and it is taking measures in this regard following the World Health Organization guidelines, she said.

The population of Bangladesh is estimated to be over 16.5 crore. Hasina, also the leader of the House, detailed the vaccination target while replying to a question from Rustum Ali Faraji, Jatiya Party lawmaker SEE PAGE 2 COL 1

Pori Moni Remand HC expresses discontent at explanation of 2 judges

The High Court yesterday expressed discontent at the explanations of two lower court judges, who placed actor Pori Moni on remand for the second and third time in a narcotics case. saying that the judges had "undermined" the HC.

"The metropolitan magistrates [lower court judges] in their explanations said they granted the prayers for remands [of Pori Moni], considering the whole situation. They requested for pardon if they have made any unintended mistake or fault in passing the remand orders," the HC said.

The HC said it seems, from their explanations, that they don't believe that they have done any wrong. "They have undermined us by giving such

A month after seizing Kabul, the Taliban face daunting problems, economic infightings, as they seek to convert their lightning military victory into a durable peacetime government.

After four decades of war and the deaths of tens of thousands of people, security has largely improved, but Afghanistan's economy is in ruins despite hundreds of billions of dollars in development spending over the past 20 years.
