People suffer for want of approach roads

A year after completion connecting road of 3 newly built culverts not constructed

Thousands of people of several villages in Nagarpur upazila have been suffering immensely as approach roads to three newly built culverts on Doptior-Kodim Takna road are not constructed even after a year of completion of the culverts construction work.

Due to lack of approach roads to the culverts, several thousand inhabitants of Doptior union and two other adjacent unions are facing troubles to go to their destinations.

During a recent visit to the area this correspondent saw villagers put bamboos pole on both ends of the newly built culverts to cross it risking their lives.

Locals, however, blamed negligence of both the constructor and authorities concerned for

not completing the development project properly and within stipulated time.

According to the Local Government and Engineering Department (LGED), private firm Friends Construction got the work order to build three box culverts along with 1,500 metres approach roads.

The Tk 2.16 crore project was scheduled to be completed in August, 2020.

Nagarpur LGED Sub-Assistant Engineer Mainul Haque said the local lawmaker inaugurated the newly built culverts, although the contractor concern yet to construct the approach roads.

Nituzzaman Tunir, organizing secretary of Doptior union unit Jubo League, said local people had to suffer for long due to poor

condition of the road.

They also faced troubles during the culvert construction work and now they are suffering for lack of approach roads to the newly built culverts.

He also alleged that the image of the government is tarnishing due to negligence of the contractor and authorities concerned.

Doptior Union Parishad (UP) Chairman Firoz Siddique said several thousand people of different villages under Doptior, Dhuburia and Solimabad unions use the road every day.

Local inhabitants have been suffering a lot for long due to the incomplete construction works of the important road, the UP chairman added.

"I have requested both the contractor and the engineers at

upazila LGED office to complete the unfinished work, considering owes of the villagers, but nothing has been done in this regard," he said.

Contacted, Mahbubur Rahman, upazila engineer at Nagarpur LGED, said they had given several reminders to the contractor concern to complete the unfinished work, but he did not pay any heed.

They also sent a letter to the executive engineer of Tangail LGED to cancel the contract agreement with the contractor, he added.

Contractor Anisur Rahman said he constructed the three culverts in time, but could not complete the road construction work due to several unavoidable circumstances like flood, spread of coronavirus, and lockdown.

Salary of Gram Police member remains suspended for 2yrs

Freedom fighter father writes to PM, Ministry of Liberation War Affairs requesting not to give him guard of honour after his death if justice is not meted out

The salary of a Gram Police has remained suspended for the last 22 months 'without any reason' forcing him to lead an inhuman life with his family.

Bipul Chandra Roy, son of freedom fighter Amullo Chandra Roy, has been serving as a Gram Police at Gaddimari Union Parishad under Lalmonirhat's Hatibandha upazila. The chairman of the union parishad has stopped his salary for the last 22 months bringing allegation of

for no reason. When I wanted to inquire about it, I was also insulted,' said Amullo Chandra Roy. 'It's an injustice to my son and our family. It is a conspiracy against us,' he said.

'If my son and my family don't get justice, I should not be given a guard of honour after my death,' he added.

However, Gaddimari Union Parishad Chairman Abu Bakkar Siddique Shyamal said that Gram Police member Bipul Chandra Roy's salary has been stopped

drug dealing and moral turpitude against him.

Aggrieved father freedom fighter Amullo Chandra Roy has said that he should not to be given the guard of honour after his death if he does not get a fair solution and justice to the injustice being done to his son.

In this regard, he has submitted written application to the Prime Minister, Ministry of Liberation War Affairs, Member of the Parliament for Lalmonirhat-1 constituency, Bangladesh Muktiyoddha Sangsad Central Command Council, Lalmonirhat District Muktiyoddha Sangsad Command, Lalmonirhat Deputy Commissioner, Hatibandha Upazila Nirbahi Officer and Hatibandha Muktiyoddha Sangsad.

The Gaddimari Union Parishad chairman has stopped my son's salary

due to allegations of moral turpitude, drug use and sale and snatching. The Gram Police member was not attending the union council as well, he alleged.

Contacted, Officer-in-Charge (OC) of Hatibandha Police Station Ershadul Alam said there was no complaint against the Gram Police member Bipul Chandra Roy in the police station. He has been coming to ensure his attendance to the police station regularly and assisting the police's activities at Gaddimari union.

Gram Police member Bipul Chandra Roy said that there were no charges against him. He is not involved in any anti-social activities. The UP chairman is trying to repress him with baseless allegations.

'When I went to the union parishad, I was pushed out,' he said.

Freedom fighter Abdul Jabbar, deputy commander of Hatibandha Muktiyoddha Sangsad Command, said that injustice was being done to the Muktiyoddha (freedom fighter's) family.

He demanded that the local administration take effective steps in this regard to ensure justice to the family.

Hatibandha Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Samiul Amin said that he has received the application. He will investigate the matter quickly and take necessary steps, he added.

Youth lands in jail for rape

A Thakurgaon court yesterday sent a youth to jail in connection with a case for raping a four-and-a-half-year-old girl at Kharibari Kalabagan village in Sadar upazila.

Earlier, a rape case was filed with Ruhea Police Station on Wednesday night.

After recording the statement under Section 164, Thakurgaon Senior Judicial Magistrate Anifur Rahman passed the order, rejecting the bail prayer, after police produced the accused—Mamun, son of Mohammad Hasan—before the court in the afternoon.

According to the case statement, the victim girl went to the Tangon river bank with her mother on Wednesday noon. When her mother was grazing her cattle on the river bank the girl was taking a bath.

At one stage, Mamun took the girl to a field and raped her. Hearing screams, one of the day labourers Suresh Chandra and his wife rushed to the spot and rescued the girl.

Meanwhile, other labourers caught the culprit while he was fleeing the spot and handed him over to the police.

Exotic fruit brings extraordinary success

A father-son duo in Indurkani upazila have become inspiration for others as their commercial dragon fruit farm, a first in the entire district of Pirojpur, has proven to be successful in only six months.

After spending 19 years in Saudi Arabia for work, Babul Howlader returned in 2017 to his home village of Togra in Indurkani upazila. Since then, he had been looking for a way to make a decent living.

The following year, when his son Mirazul Islam also came home permanently from the same country, Babul discussed with him the possibility of making a profitable dragon fruit farm in their village.

Babul said, "After returning home from abroad, I was thinking about what to do. Then I decided to cultivate fruits." While searching for information on YouTube about farming techniques of different fruits, he came to learn about the prospect of dragon fruit farming, he also said.

He and his son then decided to grow dragon fruit commercially as the exotic fruit has great commercial prospect if it is grown in the area.

They collected saplings of dragon fruit from different parts of the country and planted those on one bigha of land in the village -- on the bank of the Baleshwar river near Sheikh Fazlul Haque Moni Bridge -- in January this year.

The plants -- totalling around 2,500 -- started flowering within six months and they so far sold nearly

two maunds of the fruit to locals.

Though the locals initially discouraged them in spending their hard-earned money on cultivating an unfamiliar fruit, they now appreciate it after seeing the fruit-bearing plants in the orchard, Babul added.


His son Miraz said they first considered growing Saudi Arabian variety of date palm fruit in their farm, but they later set their minds on dragon fruit for its better prospect. "My father is the main inspiration in cultivating dragon fruit."

Usually, upto four of the fruits


weigh around one kilogram, he said, adding that they were selling the fruit straight from the orchard to locals for Tk 350 per kg.

SK Tayebur Rahman, agricultural extension officer in Indurkani upazila, said Babul Howlader and his son Mirazul Islam are the first to start commercial farming of dragon fruit in the upazila.

They were encouraging commercial farming of dragon fruit in the upazila and they would provide necessary support to those interested, he also said.


