

Decides to go for fresh committees for front, associate bodies ahead of 'movement'



The BNP has decided in principle to dissolve all its front and associate bodies and form new ones with fresh blood, keeping the next parliamentary elections in mind.

The party, which has been stumbling in politics, moves to re-organise its different tiers as part of its plan to wage movement for an electiontime neutral government and neutral Election Commission ahead of the national polls to be held in 2023, said party insiders.


The decision was made following a series of recent meetings at the party chairperson's Gulshan office.
