The tale of a missing pond

What looks like a garbage dumping ground near the Savar Bazar Bus Stand actually used to be a pond, though this might be hard to believe now.

On another 40 decimal land of the pond's embankment, an aesthetic "model mosque" has been constructed.

What's more, the upazila administration has also sent a proposal to the ministry concerned for constructing the Upazila Muktijoddha Complex on the pond's land.

Due to this sustained onslaught on the water body, the few trees that surrounded it have died.

Since 1972, the 2.52-acre pond was leased out to the Horticulture Center, but the lease expired and was not renewed in the last two years. The authorities of the centre constructed brick boundary walls on three sides of the pond except the eastern side.

Contacted, MMA Salam, deputy director of the Horticulture wing of the Department of Agricultural Extension, told The Daily Star that the pond was being used by the Horticulture Center on lease from the district administration. But since that stopped in 2019, the pond has turned into a garbage dump.

Resident of the neighbourhood Karim Mia told this correspondent, "There's no way to tell this is a pond, with the sheer volume of garbage dumped in it. Its stench has spread across the area.

However, despite allegations, the municipal authorities and Roads and Highways Department (RHD) denied their involvement in ruining of the positively. "As the road development

Asked about the soil piled up beside the pond to facilitate road development work, Maruf Hasan, sub-divisional engineer of the RHD (Dhaka), said the department had no choice but to do it, but will soon remove it.

Some have raised fingers at the Savar municipality for continued garbage dumping into the pond.

Contacted, Mayor Haji Abdul Gani,

said, "None of our employees have been asked to dump garbage there. We have a separate spot for that.' However, a notice has been issued

by the municipality to stop dumping garbage in the pond, he claimed.

Meanwhile, Savar UNO Mazharul Islam said when the municipality was asked to stop the dumping it assured

work is going on, the RHD has piled some soil on the pond's land, but they too have assured us of its removal soon," he said.

Asked about future plans for the pond, Mazharul Islam said, "As the pond is not in its previous state and has already been filled up, we have taken up plans on using its land

'Since we couldn't find a place for the Muktijoddha Complex, we have decided to build it here. We also have plans to beautify the area by renovating the pond."

According to sources, there once used be a total of 58 government ponds in Savar.

But due to poor monitoring, most of these ponds have been filled up, with only 25 remaining, all of whom were leased out by the administration.

| HC questions ACC action

Asks why Tangail AL leader's name was dropped from probe

The High Court yesterday questioned the legality of the Anti-Corruption Commission's action over dropping Tangail Awami League leader M Shibly Sadik's name from an inquiry into the Tk 27 lakh corruption allegation against him.

The HC bench of Justice Md Nazrul Islam Talukder and Justice KM Zahid Sarwar Kajol issued a rule asking the ACC and Shibly to explain in three weeks why the ACC action should not be declared illegal.

The rule was issued following a petition filed by Supreme Court lawyer M Ashraful Islam challenging the ACC's action.

Shibly, general secretary of Tangail's Delduar upazila unit of AL, allegedly embezzled Tk 27 lakh from relief programmes and reports of it were published in the newspapers in 2017, said the petitioner.

ACC deleted Shibly's name from the inquiry and closed it on January 25, 2018, for a mysterious reason, which is illegal and unconstitutional, the lawyer mentioned in the

Overnight downpour submerges Rangpur city

Residents of Rangpur city had to wade through knee to waist-deep water yesterday, as the roads and alleys of most areas were inundated, following a deluge of rainfall overnight. City dwellers blamed the poor drainage system for the situation.

According to the Meteorological Department in Rangpur, the office recorded at least 265 millimetres of rainfall in 24 hours in the district since Sunday 9pm; 222 mm was recorded in just seven hours from

During a visit to different places including Jummapara, Kamarpara, Babukha, Kamalkasna, Mahiganj, Botla, Mulatol, Munsipara, Gomostapara, Khalifapara, Nagar Mirganj, Hosenbazar, Sardarpara, Adarshapara and Masterpara -this correspondent found that locals were struggling to keep water out of their houses and shop.

Water at many areas started receding from yesterday noon.

Mezbahul Islam, a resident of Senpara, said the ground floor of all houses there

were submerged after seven hours of rainfall. Such a situation could have been avoided, if the Shyamasundari and KD canals were kept clean.

Both canals have been choked due to uncontrolled encroachment, he said.

Tuhin Wadud -- head of Begum Rokeya University's Bangla department and founder director of Riverine People, an organisation that works to protect rivers -said the two canals are Rangpur's lifeline. The 16-kilometre long Shyamasundari canal already lost its water-flow, as Rangpur City Corporation (RCC) failed to protect it by removing illegal structures.

Rangpur city is surrounded by multiple rivers. "Such waterlogging in the city area is due to river grabbing," he said. RCC Mayor Mostafizar Rahman,

however, said steps had been taken to end waterlogging in the city. He claimed that after the downpour, rainwater drained out within a short time.

Rangpur city dwellers witnessed a similar scenario on September 27 last year, when the entire city was submerged due to record 349 mm of rainfall.

A Dhaka court yesterday fixed October 12 to deliver the judgment of the graft case filed against former state minister for home affairs Lutfozzaman Babar.

Judge Md Shahidul Islam of the Special Judge's Court-7 of Dhaka set the date upon the completion of the closing arguments.

A total of seven prosecution witnesses gave statements before the court earlier. The ACC filed the case against Babar with Ramna Model Police Station on January

13, 2008, accusing him of amassing illegal wealth worth Tk 7.591 crore. ACC submitted the charge sheet to the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court of Dhaka on July

16, 2008. The trial court framed

charges on August 12, 2008. On October 30 of 2007, Babar was sentenced to 17 years' rigorous imprisonment for possessing illegal firearms at his Gulshan residence in the capital.

Previously, Babar was also sentenced to death in the 10-truck arms haul and August 21 grenade attack cases.
