## Complaint filed against Prof Serajul Islam Choudhury

A complaint has been filed with a Chattogram court accusing Professor Emeritus Seraiul Islam Choudhury of Dhaka University and two others of defaming Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman in an article.

The other accused are Rashed Rouf, associate editor of Chattogram-based daily Dainik Azadi, and one Nesar Ahmed, according to the complaint.

Rashed is the advisory editor of the book and Nesar its editor.

Nazim Uddin Sujon, 50, a resident of Anwara upazila, complained to Court of Metropolitan Magistrate Hossain Mohammad Reza on Tuesday and the court set a date for hearing on the complaint, said court sources.

But the exact date of the hearing could not be known immediately as Nazim's lawyer Shahida Nur could not confirm it.

According to the complaint, Nazim claimed himself as a "pro-liberation and progressive politician".

He alleged that Bangabandhu was defamed in an article titled "Sheikh Mujiber Gopon Shatru" (the Secret Enemies of Sheikh Mujib) by DU Professor Emeritus Serajul Islam Choudhury in a book titled "Jatir Pita", published by Chattogram Academy on March 17 last year, marking the birth centenary of the Father of the Nation.

Lawyer Shahida told The Daily star, "A complaint was lodged with a court but the court did not pass any order."

Meanwhile, the left-leaning parties of Chattogram condemned the filing of the complaint against Prof Choudhury, an acclaimed educationalist and writer.

# Initiatives not implemented even in years

The country witnessed a steep increase in road accidents and deaths this year, even though the operation of public transport remained suspended for a long time to contain the spread of Covid-19.

Speaking at an event marking the National Road Safety Day last year, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina directed the authorities to bring drivers under the dope testing system.

To implement the decision, a committee, led by a BRTA director, was formed in November last year, which gave five recommendations, including issuing or updating licence of professional drivers upon dope test.

Following the directives of the Road Transport and Highways Division, the BRTA, as preliminary step, wanted to start dope testing at its three circle offices

to work on how to implement the in Dhaka. The BRTA on September 9 this year wrote to the Directorate General of Health Services to provide names of its listed labs for conducting the test. Asked whether they got any response

DGHS, Maĥbub-É-Rabbani, director (road safety) of BRTA, yesterday replied positively. "Talk to me over the issue [dope test]

after October 22," he said when this correspondent wanted to know details. Secretary Nazrul said they could not

make expected progress regarding dope test due to the Covid-19 situation as transport owners and workers faced a lot of challenges during this time. Currently, there is no fixed economic service life for commercial vehicles in

the country. Taking advantage of this, owners of decades-old buses and trucks are running their rickety vehicles, which is considered as one of the major reasons behind road crashes. Though the transport authority in 2010 banned over 20-year-old buses

and over 25-year-old goods-carrying vehicles in the capital, many such rundown vehicles operating on district and inter-district highways are still posing a serious risk of road crashes and causing environmental pollution.

In April 2019, a high-powered committee, led by Awami League lawmaker and transport leader Shajahan Khan, suggested setting an economic lifeline of commercial vehicles to reduce road crashes. After more than two years, the BRTA

Strategic Transport Plan-2005 for Dhaka recommended introducing bus route franchising system where all buses operated in Dhaka city would run under some particular companies, instead of

several hundred companies. Annisul Huq, former mayor of Dhaka North City Corporation, started implementing the idea, but it did not move further after his death in 2017.

Now a committee, led Dhaka South City Corporation Mayor Sheikh Fazle Noor Taposh, is working on it. After missing several deadlines, December 1 is set to start operating 120 buses on Ghatarchar to Kanchpur road under a

company on a pilot basis. Asked about the delay, Dhaka Transport Coordination Authority's Executive Director Khandakar Rakibur Rahman, also the member secretary of Taposh-led committee, told this correspondent last month, "Background work is taking time."
