Pressure gets to booters again

Bangladesh once again fell apart in a high-pressure match and in the process squandered an opportunity to reach the final of Prime Minister Mahinda Rajapaksa Trophy as they lost 2-1 to 10-man Sri Lanka in a dramatic final group match at the Race Course International Stadium in Colombo yesterday.

Ahmed Waseem Razeek's stoppage-time penalty saw the hosts edge Bangladesh to the final of the four-nation tournament by virtue of their head-to-head record after both teams finished with four points.

Bangladesh needed only a draw to ensure a berth in the final but fell behind in the 25th minute as Germany-based forward Razeek netted with a fortunate strike. However, the men in red and green found an advantage when the hosts reduced to 10 men after 32

minutes.

Bangladesh finally capitalised in the 71st minute, equalising with a strike from substitute Jewel Rana, but held on for only 19 minutes before Sri Lanka retained the lead after Qatari referee Mohammed Alshammari spotted a handball and whistled for a penalty in the 90th minute.

The result served as a reminder of Bangladesh's tendency to break down in crucial matches as they did in the must-win encounter against the Lankans in the SAFF Championship. In that game, Bangladesh conceded an 88th-minute penalty as the game ended 1-1 and they exited from the group stages.

Mario Lemos pinned his hopes on the same eleven that beat Maldives 2-1 last time out, but the visitors were put on the back foot on a rain-soaked pitch as Sri Lanka pressed for a goal from the onset.

That pressure forced Bangladesh to defend deep and the hosts used the long ball effectively to create attacks from

the left flank, which led to three good chances before Razeek gave Sri Lanka the lead after a rebound came his way.

After conceding, Bangladesh looked a bit better and began to search for an equaliser but squandered a chance to level proceedings in the 33rd minute after Sri Lanka defender Duckson Pulas was sent off for stopping a goal-bound header from Tapu Barman. However, Tapu missed the target with the ensuing penalty.

Bangladesh continued to press home their advantage and took full control of the match and created two good chances in the rest of the half.

After resumption, Bangladesh created a lot of chances before substitute Jewel Rana levelled in the 71st minute by tapping in a lob from Yeasin Ararat. Bangladesh created some more chances but failed to hit the target before Sri Lanka punished them by converting from the spot in stoppage time to set up a final with Seychelles.

Mancini still confident of WC chances; Southgate hails Kane

Italy coach Roberto Mancini was upbeat about his side's chances of

playing at the 2022 World Cup despite the European champions missing out on an automatic qualification spot on Monday.

Four months on from their Euro 2020 success, Italy's 0-0 draw in Northern Ireland meant Switzerland finished top of World Cup qualifying Group C following their 4-0 win over Bulgaria in Lucerne, condemning Mancini's men to the playoffs.

It is the second successive World Cup qualification campaign that Italy have only made the playoffs, with three teams from the 12 involved this time around progressing to Qatar.

The Azzurri failed to qualify for a World Cup finals tournament for the first time since 1958 four years ago after defeat by Sweden in the playoffs over two legs.

"I am very confident for the playoffs," Mancini told RAI Sport. "Maybe we will even win the World Cup finals.

"We can't do anything about it now, we have these (playoff) games

in March and will try to give our best.

"It's a pity, because we should have sealed the group long before it came to this. We just need to rediscover what we were all about up until today."

Switzerland's four-goal winning margin meant Italy would have had to win by three goals in Belfast, but the injury-hit visitors offered little in attack all match, with Northern



Ireland having the best chances to claim victory.

"We knew that it was difficult coming here. We gave our all and were unable to score," Italy forward Domenico Berardi said.

"It is disappointing we didn't already seal the group earlier. We have to roll our sleeves up, prepare for March and book our spot at the World Cup."

Meanwhile, England coach Gareth Southgate has backed Harry Kane to overtake Wayne Rooney as the country's all-time leading scorer after the Tottenham Hotspur striker netted four goals in Monday's 10-0 demolition of San Marino in the World Cup qualifiers.

England booked their place in a seventh successive World Cup finals with their win over San Marino as Kane took his international tally to 48 goals and moved joint-third on the all-time list with Gary Lineker.

The 28-year-old, who scored a hat-trick against Albania last week, is five goals behind record scorer Rooney.

"I think that will definitely be one of his goals," Southgate told reporters on Monday.

"And the remarkable thing is we haven't given him the opportunities of nights like tonight (against lower-ranked teams) too often... He understood that, but he has huge personal ambitions as well as the team ones."

Kane took his calendar-year haul for England to a new record of 16, became the first England player to score back-to-back hat-tricks since Tommy Taylor in 1957 and the first to score four in a match since Ian Wright against San Marino in 1993.

Reza and Pinak Ghosh scored centuries in the match between Rajshahi Division and Chattogram Division at the Sylhet International Cricket Stadium yesterday.

against Rangpur Division. In reply, Rangpur put on 68 runs for one. In the other match in BKSP, Khulna Division were bundled out for 183 despite a half-century from Soumya Sarkar scored a
