The earth was dumped there indiscriminately around a year and a half ago by a contractor firm assigned with the excavation work.

# Road blocked for over a year

About four thousand people -inhabitants of Patna and Bagerkona villages in Moulvibazar's Barlekha upazila -- have been cut off from the closest market and upazila headquarters for the past 18 months, as their lone road lies unusable following excavation of the Dhamai river.

Shahid Brothers, a contractor firm, based in Motijheel of Dhaka, excavated six kilometres of the river under a Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) project titled 'small river, canal and water reservoir project (phase-1)', according to BWDB data.

Beginning in April 2019 and completing in May 2020, the project cost BWDB Tk 3,23,99,792.

The contractor firm pocketed the entire money, but it carelessly nearly one kilometre stretch of river are showing signs of erosion

northern bank of the Dhamai river, alleged the villagers and local public representatives.

As a result, people in the two villages, especially schoolgoing children and the elderly, are suffering immensely, they also

Sujanagar Union Parishad (UP) Chairman Nasib Ali filed a written complaint in this regard with the upazila nirbahi officer (UNO) of Barlekha in October this year.

Rather than fortifying the river's banks with the excavated earth, the another resident of the same contractor firm caused obstruction in people's movement by dumping the earth haphazardly on their road and front yards along the northern bank of the river.

There have been many instances when the firm sold the earth illegally, the complainant said, left heaps of excavated earth on adding that both banks of the

Finding no other solution in one and a half years' time, many of the villagers -- whose houses are left inaccessible with piles of earth -- are now removing the earth at their own expense, Nasib Ali told this correspondent.

Sadek Mia, a resident of Patna village, said the road is now unfit for all sorts of vehicles, even for rickshaws and autorickshaws.

The excavation of the Dhamai river is causing sufferings only; no benefit, lamented Babul Mia, village.

Rebutting all allegations, Shahid Brothers' Director Abdus Shahid said upon completion last year, the BWDB acknowledged their work without raising any objection.

The work on the Dhamai river firms and a particular contractor should not be made liable for

errors made by others, he also claimed.

Confirming that the local UP chairman has lodged a complaint against the quality of the work, Khorshed Alam, deputy assistant engineer of BWDB in Barlekha, said villagers are not supposed to spend their own money to solve a problem that is caused by any of their contractors.

According to the contract, the contractors have to level the river banks or the road along the river with excavated earth. Otherwise, they would be made liable of breaching the contract, he added.

Barlekha UNO Khandaker Mudassir bin Ali said after receiving the complaint, he visited the site and found some anomalies.

He also said that he already sent was done by different contractor his report to the higher authorities and was awaiting directives in this

# Now they know nothing! S DILIP ROY

Ruling Awami League (AL) men have allegedly raised Tk 69 lakh from the grassroots of Kurigram's Roumari upazila with fake promises of giving them houses in government-funded housing projects. The allegation of swindling poor people's money has surfaced in Dantbhanga union of the upazila.

According to what could be learnt, AL activist Mokshed Ali of Char Gaytapara village in collusion with Roumari upazila AL's Deputy Publicity Secretary Md Ahsan alias Babu Mandal collected the money from the poor people of the village one and a half years ago promising to enlist their names in the housing project meant for the shelterless. Now Mokshed has gone into hiding while Babu Mandal is in a state of denial.

Akbar Ali, son of late Mofiz Uddin of Char Gaytapara area, said that AL man Mokshed Ali took Tk 36,000 from him using the name of Babu Mandal, who is a cousin of a state minister, promising to give him a house under special allocation. He gave the money a year and a half ago and now Mokshed Ali has fled his home. "I borrowed the money at a high interest hoping to get a house," he said. Haidar Ali, son of the late Abdus Salam

of the same village, said that he paid Tk 39,000 to Mokshed Ali to get enlisted in the housing project.

While taking the money, Mokshed told him that 200 houses would be built for poor families under the special allocation of the government. "I took a loan from an NGO and gave the money. Now there is no house, no money and Mokshed Ali has gone into hiding whereas we can't get close to Babu Mandal as well," he said.

Contacted, Mokshed Ali, on his mobile phone, said that he took around Tk 69 lakh from 200 families and handed it over to Babu Mandal.

He trusted Babu Mandal as he gave a few houses taking money in the village earlier. Babu Mandal has taken the money from 200 families through me with the assurance that 200 houses will be built with the government's special allocation. I complied with him as he assured me that he would give me the contract of supplying materials for building houses," he said. "Now, I am homeless under the pressure of the deprived families. Babu Mandal and his men are also threatening me in various ways," he said.

Md Ahsan alias Babu Mandal, over the phone, said that he had heard about the allegations but did not know Mokshed Ali.

"It's a conspiracy against me. Attempts are being made to tarnish the reputation of my family," he said.

When asked about the multiple phone call records of Mokshed Ali and Babu Mandal, the latter said that he did not know Mokshed Ali and had never talked to him.

"Maybe someone else had such a conversation using my name. We are also looking for Mokshed Ali," he added.



# Awful bridge at risk of collapse

immediately, they added.

An iron-structured concrete bridge on busy Hulerhat-Sreerumkathi road in Pirojpur Sadar upazila remains in an awful condition for long, posing serious risk of collapse

Roads and Highway Department (RHD) constructed the bridge on a canal at Mulgram village around 25 years back.

The condition of the bridge started getting worse to worsen in the last few years and finally its one side subsided in the canal recently, causing untold sufferings to thousands of people of different villages under Kalakhali union in Sadar upazila and a number of villages of nearby Nesarabad upazila.

"The bridge is very important for thousands of locals as there is no other alternative way to reach the Pirojpur town easily," said Rabiul Islam, a battery-run threewheeler driver.

Locals said although light vehicles like motorbike and three-wheelers can ply over the bridge till now, it poses serious risk when large vehicles cross it.

They also alleged that sand-carrying vessels ply underneath the bridge frequently and sometimes hit the girder of bridge. The girder of the bridge needs to be reconstructed

While talking to this correspondent, Pirojpur RHD Sub Assistant Engineer Mohammad Asaduzzaman said they have sent a development project proposal (DPP) for renovation and construction of four roads, stretching over 76 kilometres, under Pirojpur Sadar, Nazirpur, Nesarabad, Kawkhali and Bhandaria upazilas at an estimated cost of

Tk 949 crore. Twenty nine bridges, including the damaged one at Mulgram village on Hulerhat-Sreerumkathi road, are also included in the project proposal, the engineer further said, adding that they will be able to construct a new bridge at the same location after getting approval of the DPP.
