

Google to release first inhouse smartwatch next year: reports

Google is reportedly planning to release its first in-house smartwatch next year, reveals a report by Insider.

Even though the company has released wearable companion platforms for Android devices since 2014, this will be the first official smartwatch made by Google, should the project see daylight.

While no official name has been confirmed yet, Insider reports that the watch currently goes by the codename 'Rohan' and is being made by Google's Pixel group, famous for making Google Pixel smartphones and earbuds.

The watch will contain features such



as a heart monitor and step counter; the basics of fitness tracking apps. Reports also state that Google will introduce Fitbit integration with the new smartwatch once it is officially released.

Google completed its Fitbit acquisition at the beginning of this year for \$2.1 billion and reports suggest that the Google smartwatch will cost more than Fitbit devices. With this new smartwatch, Google plans on reintegrating the Wear OS 3 platform.

Foundation to initially tackle critical bottlenecks in the global financial services industry. By using Fantom's powerful network, SELISE aims to implement digital solutions in mobile payment, securities exchange, insurance, and banking.

Infobip acquires Peerless Network; raises additional \$500m

Infobip Group, a global cloud communications platform company for customer engagement announced that it has entered into a definitive agreement with global VoIP provider Peerless Network, marking Infobip's fourth acquisition in under a year. The transaction is expected to complete upon receipt of regulatory approvals in 2022 and will be financed with a combination of Infobip shares and cash. Peerless Network management will roll parts of its holdings into Infobip.


Launched in 2008, the Peerless Network portfolio delivers a robust suite of cutting-edge voice, UCaaS, SIP Trunking, Messaging, APIs, MS Teams

integration, and other collaboration products and services. With its own nationwide voice network, Peerless Network is trusted by enterprises, Fortune 500 companies, world-leading MNOs, MVNOs and IXCs, and the nation's largest CLECs and VOIP Service Providers.

The acquisition builds on Infobip's ongoing investments and earlier acquisition of US messaging heavyweight OpenMarket, which closed in December 2020. Q1 2021 Revenue grew 55% y/y, a function of continued usage growth in its core business plus contributions from the \$300m acquisition of OpenMarket. Other acquisitions include the developer Shift

Conference franchise, purchased in April, and the world's number one SMS firewall provider, Anam, in May 2021.

In September 2021, Infobip also secured, through direct loan placement, additional funding in the amount of \$500m, advised by Morgan Stanley, and led by funds managed by the Credit Group of Ares Management Corporation, and funds and accounts managed by BlackRock. The direct loan placement puts Infobip alongside an exclusive group of high growth, high-value technology companies, which utilised the same structure. This is Infobip's second funding round, following One Equity Partner's EUR 300m investment in H2 2020.

The art of **RESTO-MODDING**

The beautiful art of resto-modding is when classic cars are restored with modern parts and technology working together in a symphony just like Lewis Hamilton and his Mercedes F1 car. The word "restomod" is a combination of the words 'restoration' and 'modified'.

Resto-mods began back in the 1980s and it all started with classic muscle cars that became too slow at one point for people, enthusiasts began integrating new engines, tuning and mods, improving



factory production cars to be faster, better and more efficient. These days, the world of classic cars is made of an unimaginable number of makes and models, thousands of upgrades and unlimited options.

Even in the modern-day, there are electric restomods; yes it's a sacrilege to some Petrolheads and ultimate automotive luxury for some. The Charge 'Eleanor' Ford Mustang is the best example of an electric resto-mod. The Charge Ford Mustang has four motors (for a total of 536bhp and 885lb-ft of torque), four-wheel drive, a 64kWh battery capacity for a range of 200 miles, 0-60mph under 4 sec and 50kW DC charging. It shows the spirit of a Mustang even though it's full of new technology and proves how capable classic cars can be made with modern technology.

Not only do resto-mods bring classic cars up to date in the 21st century with modern-day technology, safety features and overhauled performance, but it also makes what was once a classic, much easier and more reliable to drive. It is all

classic car with all the luxuries of a modern vehicle. a perfect mix of both worlds. Restomods have been

turning heads in the car scenery for quite a while now.

of what a classic car can be with a modern touch. One thing that Petrolheads can't get enough of is the different looks and history of the classic cars which makes them stand out in the modern era. The classic cars' spirits being alive to this day have been respected by the Petrolheads from both the old times and newer eras. Turning a legacy machine into an amazing daily driver personalised to the owners' satisfaction is often fascinating to classic car enthusiasts.

One of the most popular cars to get a modern treatment is the legendary Lancia Delta Integrale, which won a lot of the main events in the notorious Group B rally race which was banned in 1986 and became world champion in 1987. It won 6 world rally championships, far more than any other car. This is a car that not everyone lived to see and people want to see in the modern world how capable it can be creating the desire in Petrolheads hearts to drive it one day or even watch someone shred it up on the streets.

Then one day Automobili Amos, founded by driver Eugenio Amos, took one of the 1980's Lancia Integrales and brought it into the 21st century. They created the ultimate Delta Integrale resto-mod, where the Automobili Amos Lancia Delta Futurista was born. This resto-mod weighs 1300kg thanks to the crazy amount of Carbon Fiber that was used and has over 330 horsepower from a turbocharged 4-cylinder engine, Brembo brakes, a 5-speed manual transmission, upgraded suspension now with a double-wishbone, a new cooling system and some extra nice touches such as the high beam button on




the steering is labelled "LEVATI" which translates to "move from my way". Automobili Amos' team created 21 of them with a whopping price tag of \$350,000.

Resto-modding can be very expensive due to the restoration of the rare classic cars and the ridiculous rarity of parts. The original parts are hard to come by so companies have to improvise by repurposing old parts to add to the car. Another major factor that causes this price hike is the amount of rust on a classic vehicle which requires a lot of labour-intensive work. Though a restomodded project won't hold the same value as a restored classic vehicle, the performance improvement may compensate for the deficit in value. at least for some people. The popularity of a classic car and the high demand and desirability for it increase the value by an unimaginable amount.

One of the best examples would be the Singer 911 DLS which fetched a hefty price tag of \$1.8 million. This Porsche restomod was developed by the F1 Williams team, making a nick under 500hp and the exhaust sounds like a group of an orchestra making the most euphonious music, where the car weighs just about 1000kg. The Singer DLS is on par with Koenigsegg when it comes to technical engineering, Pagani in terms of art and 458 Speciale regarding the driving experience.

There are countless amazing restomods across the world and many new ones that are being built every day; each one of them having its own special story. There are many legendary Restomods that every Petrolhead appreciates like the Legacy Overland Toyota Land Cruiser, Twisted Landrover Defender, AC Cobra, Cyan Racing's Volvo P1800, RWB's electric MGB, Totem Automobili's electric Alfa Romeo Giulia GT, RUF RCT and many more innumerable cars. These cars will always find a way to steal petrolheads' hearts.

When it comes down to it, completing a restomod will become a passion project which takes time and effort to achieve. However, something is gratifying about combining a piece of automotive history with modern-day innovations. At the end of the day, there will be a unique vehicle. It's all about the dream cars, emotional bond, combining exclusivity, freedom, and adrenaline. That is the beauty and art of restomodding and ultimately driving, which will forever continue to change lives.



5G: Paving the way for a digitally enabled society

5G is probably one of the most anticipated leap-forwards that the country has been waiting for many years now. Putting an end to all the speculation, on December 12, Teletalk is officially launching 5G network services on a trial basis in Bangladesh, and Huawei as the technology partner has played a key role in making it all happen. To debug the hype around 5G, we sat to have a conversation with Kevin Xu, Chief Technology Officer of Huawei Bangladesh. Here's the exert of the discussion

What is 5G and how do you think 5G will affect our daily lives?

The 5th generation wireless network technology 5G, compared to 4G, can provide much higher speed, better connectivity and lower latency which opens so many doors of possibilities including massive machine-type communications, responsiveness and fast data transfer over 1GBPS. This is beneficial for individuals, families and companies. In addition to speed, Individuals will have AR



VR which will bring a new experience in entertainment, gaming etc. Families will have better connectivity with ICT devices. Fixed Wireless Access will take an important role to bring higher speed omitting the hassle of wires. For companies, 5G means industries like ports, manufacturers and traffic can utilise smart technology. As we know, 4G changed lives, but 5G will change society.

5G will be launched in Bangladesh on 12 December. What are your thoughts regarding that?

There are about 700 active telecom operators worldwide, among which about 180 have already launched 5G services. Huawei has been working with mobile operators in Bangladesh for more than twenty years. We cherish the transformation of 3G to 4G in Bangladesh, and now we enter the 5G era. We are happy to cooperate with Teletalk in launching 5G in Bangladesh. Bangladesh will be counted as one of the first few countries which are launching 5G.

Why is the deployment of 5G a big deal in Bangladesh? Which industries will benefit the most from 5G?

As we know, carbon emission has been a hot topic for a long time. ICT holds around 1.4% of the total carbon footprint. And since ICT is fundamental to the digital economy of Bangladesh, 5G can address the challenge of improving the ICT sector as a whole. With the introduction of 5G, we can decrease carbon footprints by making remote jobs much easier to do.

The factories, especially readymade garments factories, which hold the second position in earning remittance in Bangladesh, 5G can find new ways of ensuring better product accuracy and efficient operational management.

5G can support industries in reducing carbon emissions, like banking, where the improved connectivity can be integrated into smart banking. People won't need to go to the banks as they will have access to much faster and safer banking from home. Having better internet at home means more emphasis on working from home. Motor vehicles will be used less, which will amount to a decrease in carbon emissions and a smaller footprint. With 5G technology, we can also optimise the traffic light control system to transmit fast and accurate information to the control centre, thus improving traffic conditions on major roads. Traffic has always been a big issue in Dhaka and 5G will help tackle that problem

Furthermore, 5G will enable smart ports, where the machines can be controlled via AI. We already have Chinese smart ports that are completely controlled by machines. There, people only stay in the offices to run the machines, which are always working with 100% accuracy. 5G will enable Bangladesh to replicate a similar efficient manufacturing system. Fast and reliable wireless connections will also improve sectors such as healthcare and general public services and will make worldwide communication even smoother. Overall, we think 5G has the power to reform society in a very positive manner

How can telecom brands deploy 5G with their current infrastructure?

3G or 4G, we needed specific radio transmitter in mobile phones, which can provide a satisfactory output but not to the level of 5G. 5G has increased speed and higher bandwidth, so the transmission fibre bandwidth capacity needs to be expanded. There is also a requirement for more spectrum. An addition of 2.6 or 3.5 GHz to existing frequencies will be very fitting for the next steps. Huawei has been supplying almost 60% of the total 5G

components worldwide and soon enough Bangladesh will be capable of running highspeed 5G as well. With time Bangladesh can adapt the existing cases and discover new localized applications. But in between, the industry also needs to work for a better 4G

There are several network infrastructure providers right now with 5G solutions. What gives Huawei an edge compared to other competitors?

As we can see, many companies have launched their 5G networks in 2020. But our story was started long ago. You know, Huawei invests more than 10% of its revenue in research and innovation. We have been researching this technology since 2009 and until 2013, we spent nearly \$600 million on 5G research alone. And Huawei started developing 5G equipment in 2012. More than 60% of 5G patents are currently owned by Huawei.

We continue to invest in creative technologies to make our products more efficient and more green in terms of powersaving. A recent analysis stated that Huawei is at least two years ahead of other 5G vendors.

Huawei wants to work with operators to find out how we can solve your problems and improve the efficiency of a digital society. Societal improvement will take time, so we need to launch 5G as soon as possible. We can borrow and learn from other countries. but we still need time to customize them. Many operators might want to launch 5G services as soon as possible, but not to the scale of our project.

As we have learned, to use 5G we need

5G-enabled devices. Unfortunately, the number of compatible devices is still quite low in Bangladesh. Do you think this is a red flag for 5G adoption in the country? I don't think that is a problem. When 4G was introduced, only high-end phones supported the technology. 4G only began to spread when mid and low range phones started to adopt it, quickly becoming an industry standard. As 5G technology has just been introduced to the world, we are still working on small scale coverage such as metropolitan cities. Presently, higher-end phones have been adopting the technology. The good part is 5G devices are already in the Market and even some companies have already launched 5G handsets in the Bangladesh market. Soon, when 5G infrastructure will be available enough, handheld device companies will start to implement 5G support on affordable

China's life changed for the better after the launch of 4G. The Chinese market was booming, and the same happened in Bangladesh. Now, with the launch of 5G, once companies start manufacturing low-end smartphones that enable 5G connectivity, the industry will change once again. With 5G, every sector, especially ICT, will contribute to making a smarter and greener society. 5G will help Bangladesh's economy prosper as well.


should be able to sell that solution to your customers, your investors, your teammates and even your future cofounder," she says.

Technology is here to stay, especially in the modern times of Covid-19. Mastering technology doesn't mean you need to be an expert in coding and programming to find success. It means you learn to leverage the power of technology.

Machine learning, data science & analytics can be useful tools to help make data-driven decisions about your business. Alongside, digital marketing (especially Facebook and Instagram marketing) can bring resounding results for your business.

CONFRONTING CHALLENGES

Challenges are aplenty. Ensuring a constant supply, finding reliable suppliers, receiving payments, finding a good delivery service, dealing with various kinds of people (including some rude ones), marketing, never giving up, innovating to come up with new products and making hard decisions.

FEMALE FOUNDERS

AND THEIR EXTRA **CHALLENGES**

There is no doubt that in our country, it can be extremely difficult to thrive as an independent woman. The system isn't supportive. According to Samiha, as a female entrepreneur, you will probably face discrimination at times. She cautions that this is not something she says to discourage any female from pursuing entrepreneurship. "But the best way you can overcome this is to have enough supporters around you who know your capabilities and not let you doubt yourself," she says.

TAKE CARE OF YOURSELF

Being an entrepreneur is challenging. Sayem Faruk says, "Countless nights of sleep and outings with family and friends are a given cost of being an entrepreneur. Sacrificing my health and peace of mind are perhaps the most expensive sacrifices I made. Not knowing how you'll pay everyone's salaries next month is a scary place to be in."

"Being self-aware comes first. But to achieve that, one needs to educate himself on it. Once that foundation is laid, then comes fixing the basics - waking up and eating on time, exercising, having support systems can go a long way in taking care of our mental health," he says.

FINAL WORDS

It's important to understand where your motivation for entrepreneurship originates from. If it's for glamour, this field is not for you. Being an entrepreneur is probably one of the hardest jobs out there, and it is sometimes more than a job because sometimes you go to sleep thinking about how to keep your customers happy or how to pay your employees next month, so if you are not really passionate about what you are doing, you will constantly be demotivated.

HOGWARTS LEGACY


