AN EQUALITY in question

JU allocates same amount of research funds for all teachers without judging merit

Bizarre as it may sound, Jahangirnagar University treats all teachers equally when it's about releasing funds for research.

From a lecturer to a professor, the university hands the equal amount of money to all teachers, irrespective of their research proposals and faculties.

Such a fund disbursement has long been drawing criticism from JU teachers who termed it lop-sided. They pointed out that research fields and topics differ from department to department. It is also frustrating because a teacher with a solid research background receives the same fund as a junior researcher.

Talking to The Daily Star, several teachers said the university tasked a high-powered committee, led by the vice-chancellor, to

"There is no scope for giving funds for research this way. There has to be competition and funds should be given on the basis of a proposal's merit."

disburse the funds, but the body hardly evaluates any research proposal before releasing the money.

There is no example of any research proposal getting rejected in recent times, they said.

"It's a sort of discrimination when a senior

Murad returns

4 DSA cases filed against former state minister

Disgraced state minister for information and broadcasting Murad Hassan was forced to return to the country yesterday.

He arrived at the Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport (HSIA) at 4:56pm in an Emirates flight from Dubai, an aviation security officer told The Daily Star.

Being denied entry to Canada and having no visa to enter the UAE, Murad had little choice but to return to Bangladesh, said sources close to the ruling party lawmaker from Jamalpur-4.

Meanwhile, four pro-BNP lawyers yesterday filed four separate cases against

METRO RAIL

Roll-out on Victory Day next year

The country's first ever metro rail will go on its commercial operation in the Uttara-Agargaon section on December 16 -- the Victory Day -- next year.

The metro rail authorities will start the partial operation of the new mode of public transport in the country with 10 sets of metro trains, an official said.

The Agargaon-Motijheel section will be operational for the second phase by December 2023, said MAN Siddique, managing director of Dhaka Mass Transit Company Limited (DMTCL),

which is implementing the fast-track project.

He was speaking to reporters at the under-construction Agargaon station after a metro train reached there from the depot in Uttara's Dia Bari for the first time during a performance test yesterday.

As per the prior announcement, the train reached the Agargaon station at 11:00am. It started from the depot at 9:39am and after completing necessary tests, it reached the station, a DMTCL official said.

Earlier on November 29, a metro train travelled to Mirpur-10 for the first time.

Formally known as the Mass Rapid Transit Line

PANDEMIC FALLOUT

Three in 4 homes faced hardship

Finds CPD survey on 1,600 households

At least 75 percent of the 1,600 surveyed households of marginalised communities had experienced additional financial hardship caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, according to a research presented by the Centre for Policy Dialogue.

Most of those households have yet to recover from the hardships, Afra Tahsin Chowdhury, research associate at the CPD, told a session at a two-day conference at the Brac Centre Inn in the capital.
