

Driver never had a licence: Rab

in Chakaria.
Saiful was driving the pickup at speed of 65-70 km on the Cox's Bazar-Chattoogram highway to deliver vegetables in the district town, despite the fog.
Rab said Mahamudul Karim, owner of the pickup, bought it in 2016 and used it for vegetable transportation. It's fitness clearance, route permit and tax token had expired in 2018.
Mahamudul's son Tarek and nephew Robiul were

also in the vehicle during the accident.
Saiful admitted that he was behind the wheel during the accident and stopped the vehicle around 100 feet far from spot.
He walked to the spot and noticed the bodies in a pool of blood, but Tarek insisted to leave immediately, the Rab official said.
Saiful contacted Mahamudul and informed him about the accident. He then parked in Malumghat area and met the owner in Chakaria, where

Mahamudul advised him to go into hiding for a year.
Mahamudul, his son and nephew went into hiding too and Rab is trying to trace them.
Saiful, previously a rubber plantation worker, began driving, without a licence, over two years ago. He started driving the pickup a week before the accident on a daily wage of Tk 500.
After the accident, he fled to Bandarban's Lama and started working in rubber plantation again. He came to Dhaka again after

noticing the stir caused by the accident.
The investigation officer of the case will look into the allegations of 'previous enmity' made by the victim family, he said, adding that the Rab found no previous ties between the driver or the owner with the family.
Speaking to this paper, Munni Sushil, sister of the victims, said "On January 29, 40-50 miscreants attacked our house. They threatened to kill my father. The next day, January 30, my father died of a heart attack."

office, they started hurling abuse and asked us about the report, titled 'Ja Chhilo Khasra Charge Sheet-e' [What was in the draft charge sheet] on February 11," said Arif.
"They threatened us saying 'You've gone against Ajmeri Osman. If you don't seek apology by tomorrow [Sunday], we will set fire to this office and shoot your editor dead," he claimed.
A staffer of the office videoed the incident with his mobile phone. Locals identified the miscreants as supporters of Ajmeri.
Editor and publisher Zabed Ahmed Juel said the news' content was based on the murder case's draft charge sheet, submitted by Rab in 2014. "Ajmeri's name was mentioned in that news as it was found in the charge sheet. It's clear

that Ajmeri's supporters launched the attack."
Ajmeri could not be contacted over phone, despite repeated attempts.
Narayanganj SP Muhammad Zaidul Alam said, "On information, police visited the spot. We will take legal action, if any complaint is filed."
On March 6, 2013, 17-year-old Taqi went missing. His body was found floating in the Shitalakkhya river on the morning of March 8.
On the same day, Taqi's father Rafiur Rabbi filed a murder case with Narayanganj Kotwali police.
A complaint submitted to the Narayanganj SP 10 days later accused seven people, including Shamim Osman and his son Ayon Osman, of murdering Taqi.
On August 7, 2013, Rab raided Ajmeri's "Winner

Fashion" office at Allama Iqbal Road and seized a pair of blood-stained jeans and a pistol butt. Officials also found numerous bullet marks on the walls, almirah and sofa.
In March 2014, then Rab additional director general Col Ziaul Ahsan told the media that they found Ajmeri's involvement with the murder.

Meetings go on, nothing changes

in October 2019 to implement a III-point recommendation, placed by a committee led by former shipping minister Shajahan Khan, to curb accidents and bring discipline on roads.
NO APPOINTMENT LETTERS
Instead of giving appointment letters and setting a salary structure, transport owners appoint drivers on a daily basis, paying them based on the number of trips. As a result, drivers, especially ones in the capital, engage in unhealthy competition among themselves to get more passengers to get more fare. This is considered as one of the

major reasons behind road crashes.
For example, a bus of Meghla Paribahan hit and killed two pedestrians in Gulistan on January 8. During Rab's interrogation, bus driver Rakib Sharif (25) confessed that he was appointed on a daily basis, which is why he used to drive recklessly to complete as many trips as possible.
Workers often say financial needs, lack of recognition and dignity, and uncertainty over their jobs make them reckless, which ultimately increases the risk of accidents.
Osman Ali, general secretary of Bangladesh Road Transport Workers Federation, said almost all the authorities' decisions

remain unimplemented.
"What is the meaning of holding such meetings? I'll ask this in tomorrow's meeting," he told this correspondent yesterday.
WHAT ABOUT OTHER DECISIONS?
Just like in previous meetings, the third one saw the taskforce decide to ban operation of battery-run auto-rickshaws on roads and highways. But that too remains unimplemented.
It had also asked Local Government Division to prepare recommendations to control illegal easy-bikes and send them to RTHD. Although LGD has formed a committee in this regard, it did not send recommendations yet, an RTHD official said.

In the second meeting, authorities had decided to carry out surveys to determine how many vehicles city's roads can handle. It has not started even after 13 months.
The taskforce also planned to take effective measures to tackle reckless motorcyclists and bring all bikes under registration. But the situation has not changed, as a police report shows that bikes were involved in 1,358 accidents last year, which is 41.46 percent higher than in 2020. It decided to appoint a focal person from four ministries concerned to oversee the implementation. This is the only decision that was fully implemented.

department lecturer Abul Kashem, popularly known as Principal Abul Kashem. Speaking at the meeting was Prof Munier Chowdhury, Farid Ahmed, DU Prof AKM Ahsan --who later became CSP secretary -- student leader Abdur Rahman Chowdhury (later became a judge), Kalyan Das Gupta and S Ahmed.
The historic event played host to another general meeting on March 16, 1948. As students marched towards the Parishad Bhaban, shouting anti-state and pro-Bangla slogans, police obstructed them with gunfire, teargas and baton charge, which injured some of the student protesters.
Denouncing the attack, every educational institute in Dhaka announced a strike on March 17. On the same afternoon, a programme took place at Beltala. Presided over by Naimuddin Ahmed, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, Shamsul Haque, Kazi Golam Mahbub, Oli Ahad and more spoke at the seminar.
After Khwaja Nazimuddin declared Urdu as state language from Paltan Maidan on January 27, 1952, the movement started heating up even more. In protest, a strike and gathering took place at Beltala on February 4.
Language veteran Ahmed Rafiq told The Daily Star, "Dhaka University's arts building -- now known as Kala Bhaban -- premises was buzzing with students. From Amtala to Beltala, they made noise everywhere. Although the state had put up obstacles, it was yet to attack us."
"From 10-11 in the morning, thousands of students joined us at Beltala in waves," he said. "From here, we called for the strike on February 21." He also expressed grief over Beltala's condition today. "There's no sign of any of this illustrious history at Beltala today. In the passage of time, we have lost all the memories that made it so significant for the Language Movement."
