

## Worker dies as wall collapses on him

A worker died after an old boundary wall collapsed on him while he was digging soil at a construction site in Dhaka's Bhatara area yesterday morning.

The deceased was identified as Azharul Islam Sabuj (45) of Sunamganj.

The incident happened around 11:30am at a Dwelling Real Estate site.

The six-foot boundary wall of an under-construction building collapsed on Sabuj, leaving him critically injured, said Abu Bakkar, the company's site manager.

He was rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital, where doctors declared him dead.

Inspector Bachchu Mia, in-charge of DMCH Police Outpost, said the body was sent for autopsy.

can still send messages in either English or Bangla. However, if any foreign or local customer wants to get their SMS in English exclusively, there will be an option for them.

According to Brig Gen (retd) SM Farhad, secretary general of Association of Mobile Telecom Operators of Bangladesh, mobile operators were finalising the initiative.

According to industry insiders, most operators worldwide send out messages in the native language of the country they operate in.

Khairul Basher -- head of communications at Grameenphone, which has over 8,34 crore customers -- said, "Grameenphone

believes that this step is a remarkable milestone, considering the significance of International Mother Language Day."

"Now, a wider base of customers who are dependent on Bangla will be able to get a better understanding of service offerings and other communications," he said.

"We have taken all measures to launch system-generated Bangla SMS, according to regulatory guidelines," said Shahed Alam, chief corporate and regulatory officer of Robi Axiata.

With so many members of one family acquainted with the movement, it became a natural meeting place. During March 7's secret meeting, Oli Ahad, Mohammad Toaha, Kazi Golam Mahbub and more were present. But somehow, the police got tipped off. They soon encircled the house before the meeting had ended and arrested a few members of the Sangram Parishad.

Kazi Golam Mahbub, convenor of the parishad, wrote in a memoir, "The strike and programmes of United Rashtra Bhasha Parishad on March 5 did not bring much success.

In the evening of March 7, we sat at 82 Shantinagar. But before we could finish, police surrounded the building."

To escape arrest, Oli Ahad wore a house help's uniform, Mozibul Haq pretended to be a chef, while Mirza Golam Hafiz

hid underneath a bed. I hid by climbing a shelf of the old store room.

Late at night, I got down from there and went straight to a relative's house at Wari, where I took shelter for the next couple of days."

Ex-DU and Buet professor Sufia Khatun was a witness of that meeting by virtue of being a member of the family. "I was a teenager during the Language Movement. My uncle Monsur Uddin Ahmad and elder brother Dr Abdul Mutualib were involved with the movement. Our house was a safe haven for the protesters; they'd often arrange meetings here. The meeting of March 7 was one in particular that helped reinvigorate the movement," she told The Daily Star.

The under-construction building that stands there today goes by the holding numbers 135 and 136. Sufia Khatun said they will discuss whether they want to install any signs or memorial plaques there. "But since the developers haven't completed its handover, we cannot come to a decision just yet."


