Another CWasa
water plant goes
into operation

A water treatment plant of Chatogram Water Supply & Sewerage Authority (CWasa) officially goes into operation today, raising the total production to 500 million litres per day.

The prime minister will inaugurate the plant virtually, said Maksud Alam, chief engineer of CWasa.

Sheikh Hasina Water Treatment Plant-2 (SHWTP-2), under the Karnaphuli Water Supply Project Phase 2, can supply 140 million litres of water every day.

CWasa currently supplies 391 million litres of water a day against the demand for 500 million litres, said officials.

According to the documents of CWasa, the organisation currently supplies water to 80,000 households, while the rest get their water from deep tube wells.

Once the project is launched, there will be no more water crisis in the port city, at least until 2030," said AKM Fazlullah, managing director of CWasa.

The Karnaphuli Water Supply Project-2 began in June 2016.

The total project cost of Tk 4,489.15 crore, Japan International Cooperation Agency is providing Tk 2,800.92 crore, while the government is providing Tk 1,665.16 crore and CWasa Tk 23.7 crore.

The project has been implemented through three packages. Intake and

This is what Abdur Razzaq, father of Hadisur Rahman – the naval engineer who was killed in a missile strike on Bangladeshi ship "Banglar Samriddhi" in Ukraine on March 2 – had to say, after Hadisur was laid to rest next to his grandparents' graves in Barguna yesterday morning.

He was buried at the family graveyard of his village home in Betagi upazila's Hosenabad around 11:00am.

About 5,000 people attended his namaz-e-janaza.

Hadisur was the second of four children and the only earner in the family. Among the two younger

brothers, Md Tareq is a fourth-year student of Patuakhali Government College and Golam Mawla Prince a first-year student of Kabi Nazrul Government College, Dhaka.

To avoid the sentence, he has been in hiding for 18 years, disguising himself as an online journalist. All this came to the fore when Munshiganj police arrested him yesterday. Iqbal is the son of late Abul Hossain, former UP chair of Dulihata village in Tongibari, said police.


The government's goal to transform villages into cities can only be achieved by ensuring security, and police have ensured that through beat policing, IGP Benazir Ahmed said yesterday.
