Why do we

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cause snoring too.

Anatomy may also contribute to snoring. If you have a long soft palate, enlarged adenoids, displaced cartilage in the nose, tonsils or a large tongue, it can be harder for air to flow through your nose and mouth, causing you to snore.

Snoring may run in families. Nasal stuffiness due to allergies or common cold may block airflow causing snoring.

Pregnant women may be more likely to snore due to hormonal changes or weight gain.

Snoring may also be a symptom of obstructive sleep apnea. If you are a heavy snorer, you should check with your physician.

Treatments for snoring include changes in habit like quitting smoking or drinking. Your physician may also ask you to lose weight. Doctors might also suggest minor surgeries to open up your nasal or oral passage enough to prevent snoring.

You may also try remedies like sleeping on your side instead of your back and sticking to a sleep schedule to avoid snoring.

Jet crashes

Hafizuddin Khan, another former adviser to caretaker government and former bureaucrat, said he will not join talks as it will be difficult for him to give his opinion due to time constraints, as so many people were invited.

“I heard 40 eminent citizens were invited. If they each talk for five minutes, even that will take a long time. It [talks] doesn’t work this way. It would have been better if they had invited four or five people. We could have given our opinions properly. Besides, I also have health issues for

which I cannot join.”

Rasheda K Choudhury, former caretaker government adviser and executive director for Campaign for Popular Education, is currently in the USA and will return Dhaka later this month.

Badiul Alam Majumdar, secretary of Shushashoner Jonno Nagorik (Shujan), said he will not be able to join talks as he will be in Khulna to attend pre-scheduled programme.

Tofail Ahmed, local governance expert, said, “It won’t be possible for me to join as I am in my home in Chattogram since March 18 and will return to Dhaka on March 24.”

Gonoshasthaya Kendra trustee Zafrullah Chowdhury, former cabinet secretary Ali Imam Majumdar, former University Grants Commission chairman Prof Nazrul Islam and Nijera Kori Coordinator Khushi Kabir, all said that they would be joining the dialogue today, while economist Prof MM Akash yesterday said he was yet to decide as he as programme at the same time of the talks.

The EC’s initiative to hold dialogue received an underwhelming response on the first day – March 13 – as just 13 out of 30 invitees joined.

BLAST gives pointers to stop character

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150(A) of the act and to repeal section 155(4) of the act.

Mahbuba Akhter, deputy director (advocacy and communications) at BLAST, told The Daily Star yesterday that the organisation will again request the parliamentary committee to place a bill on the amendments suggested by BLAST.

Contacted, Shahiduzzaman Sarker, chairman of the parliamentary standing committee on law ministry, said the committee was yet to analyse the suggestions.

“The cabinet has already approved in principle the Evidence (Amendment) Act 2022. We will study and discuss the suggestions made by BLAST when we have an official meeting.

If the suggestions are relevant, we will include them in the amendment bill,” he said.

The committee will hold a meeting on this issue before the next parliament session.

Law Minister Anisul Huq earlier told The Daily Star that the government will amend sections 155(4) and 146(3) of the Evidence Act, 1872 to prevent questioning of the characters of rape victims in court.

BLAST’s March 10 proposal reads, “53 (A). Evidence of character and past sexual history when not relevant: The evidence about the character of the complainant and their past sexual experiences with any person other than the accused during trial of offences under sections 9 and 10 of the Nari o

Sections 9 and 10 of the Nari o Shishu Nirjatan Daman Ain 2000 and Sections 354, 375, 376, 493 and 509 of the Penal Code, 1860, and complainants of attempts to commit these offences, are not subjected to questions about their character and past sexual history with any person other than the accused.

“If the Court is of the opinion that any Advocate has raised questions to any witness in contravention of Section 53A and Section 146(3)(A) of this Act then it shall report such contravention to the High Court Division or any other competent authority to which such Advocate is subject in the exercise of his profession, and recommend that appropriate disciplinary be taken against him.”
