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He urged migrant workers to learn foreign languages, especially those required in receiving countries, and receive skills training properly.

The minister added that they are expecting that the number of overseas jobs will cross 10 lakh in the ongoing fiscal year.

State Minister for Planning Shamsul Alam stressed the need for upscaling skills training for migrant workers to cope with modern technologies.

Besides, he stressed on bringing recruiting agencies under a monitoring mechanism.

Syed Saiful Haque, chairperson of Warbe Development Foundation, said there are sufficient laws and policies related to labour migration in place, while the government also has its commitment for migrant workers' well-being.

Pointing to exorbitant migration costs migrant workers have to pay in Bangladesh, Shakirul Islam,

chairperson of Ovbashi Karmi Unnayan Program, said such situations often lead migrant workers into forced labour.

Moderating the programme, Samakal advisory editor Abu Sayeed Khan said Bangladesh's economy is making progress largely due to remittance sent by migrant workers.

However, migrant workers often have to face exploitation and harassment, he said, adding that the government's 8th Five-Year Plan puts importance on sending migrants abroad at zero cost.

Sawsan Al Hababeh, executive director of Jordan Garments, Accessories and Textiles Exporter's Association, joined the meeting virtually.

Billal Hossain, managing director of Bangladesh Overseas Employment and Services Ltd, and Mizanur Rahman, former joint secretary general of Baira, also addressed the programme.

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Awal Kabir said on August 17, 2020, PUST acting registrar Bijon Kumar Brammah issued a notice, informing him that the regent board meeting took a decision that he could not discharge any administrative duty.

According to Bangladesh High Commission, Ottawa, bilateral trade between Bangladesh and Canada was US\$ 2.42 billion in 2019. In the year 2020, between January to April, Bangladesh has exported goods worth US\$440 million to Canada. On the other hand, Bangladesh imported goods worth US\$ 231.28 million in the same duration.

Around 10 lakh Bangladeshis are currently living in Canada, while around 8,000 student are studying in different universities there.

finalising the amendment." He said the state will soon take steps so the Appellate Division holds hearings on appeals in connection with war-crime cases.

The Awami League government formed the first ICT-1 on March 25, 2010. The second tribunal (ICT-2) was formed on March 22, 2012, to expedite the trials. ICT-1 delivered 32 judgments on war-crime related cases from February 28, 2013 to November 24 last year, while ICT-2 has delivered 11 verdicts from January 21, 2013 to July 16, 2015, according to the information available on their websites.

ACC summons

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Intelligence Unit last March directed banks to provide information on the accounts of Sur and Shah Alam, and their spouses.

NBR issued similar directive on February 23. In their confessional statements to lower courts, Rashedul Haque, a former MD of ILFSI, and Uzzal Kumar Nandi, chairman of People's Leasing and Financial Services, said Sur assisted PK Halder in embezzling money.

In July 2021, NBR directed banks to freeze bank accounts of Sur and his spouse Suparna Sur Chowdhury on suspicion of tax evasion. Last March, the HC asked why Sur and Shah Alam were not arrested for helping PK Halder. ACC has so far frozen properties worth Tk 1,000 crore.

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their husband or, if single, with their son.

"Their agricultural works are mostly considered as non-paid household chores. Again, 80 percent of the household chores are done by women and they do not get any payment for it," added Moni.

Dr Rowshan Ara, a professor at Dhaka University, said, "According to Muslim law, daughter, mother and wife under all circumstances must be given their share of inherited property and cannot be excluded from inheritance under any circumstance."

"However, women get less amount of property than their male counterparts," Dr Rowshan Ara added.

"On the other hand, Hindu law says that women cannot have any share in inherited property," she said.

"We should take initiatives to implement a gender-equitable uniform family code, which will be followed by all regardless of their religious or ethnic background," Dr Rowshan added.

The speakers at the event also placed some demands in this regard.

Their demands include unconditional allotment of khas land to landless women, recognition of female farmers, equal share in inheritance and prioritising women from minority and indigenous communities in social safety net.
