If a student applies to a UK university through them, no matter from which centre or agency they register for their IELTS exam, Education Hub will give them a full refund of their IELTS registration cost. For this to occur, the student must successfully be accepted into a UK university and receive a CAS letter from them. Education Hub is also an IELTS registration centre.
