**XIAOMI REDMI 1A**

with an IPS panel for brilliant colours, HDMI and VGA inputs, as well as 16.7 million colours to choose from. For most people, a refresh rate of 60Hz is sufficient. It is ideal for games where a fast response rate is not required, as 6ms can put players at a disadvantage.

a 75Hz refresh rate panel, which is not significantly faster than 60Hz but feels slightly smoother when seen closely. Response time is 5ms which gives you an extra edge if you are a gamer on a budget. It has an IPS panel that produces vibrant colours with AMD Freesync included.

Good for gaming, workplace and colour-accurate jobs like Photoshop, Illustrator, Lightroom and Premiere Pro, among others.

Expanded Vision with a 178° IPS wide viewing angle panel gives consistent accurate colour at any angle to minimise the colour shift and give you a better viewer experience. It is safe to say that it is highly favoured for gaming and work purposes.
