

Welcome back to ‘old Pakistan’
Politicians, journos react to Imran Khan’s ouster

Over a month after the no-confidence motion was tabled against Prime Minister Imran Khan on March 8, members of the National Assembly finally cast their votes to make Imran Khan the first prime minister in the country’s history to be ousted through a vote of no confidence.
As had been the case over the last several months, the result of the vote received a mixed response.



PML-N leader Khawaja Saad Rafique welcomed the nation back to “Purana [old] Pakistan”, while PTI leader and Senator Faisal Javed Khan said the premier “walked out gracefully and didn’t bow down”.
Activist Ammar Ali Jan said that “a clumsy attempt to sabotage the constitution has been defeated,” adding, however, that “the struggle for people’s rights continues”.
Journalist Cyril Almeida simply tweeted: “The hybrid regime is dead”.
“Imran Khan sets yet another new Pak record! Becomes the first PM to be ousted through a vote of no confidence,” quipped another journalist Hasan Zaidi.

Sri Lanka nearly out of medicine

Doctors warn as crisis bites; anti-govt protests continue

Sri Lanka’s doctors warned yesterday they were nearly out of life-saving medicines and said the island nation’s economic crisis threatened a worse death toll than the coronavirus pandemic.
Weeks of power blackouts and severe shortages of food, fuel and pharmaceuticals have brought widespread misery to Sri Lanka, which is suffering its worst downturn since independence in 1948.
The Sri Lanka Medical Association (SLMA) said that all hospitals in the country no longer had access to imported medical tools and vital drugs.
Several facilities have already suspended routine surgeries since last month because they were dangerously low on anaesthetics,



but the SLMA said that even emergency procedures may not be possible very soon.
“We are made to make very difficult choices. We have to decide who gets treatment and who will not,” the group said yesterday, after releasing a letter they had sent President Gotabaya Rajapaksa days earlier to warn him of the situation.

“If supplies are not restored within days, the casualties will be far worse than from the pandemic.”
Mounting public anger over the crisis has seen large protests calling for Rajapaksa’s resignation.
Thousands of people braved heavy rains to keep up a demonstration outside the leader’s seafont office in the capital Colombo for a second day.
Business leaders joined calls for the president to step down on Saturday and said the island’s chronic fuel shortages had seen their operations haemorrhage cash.
Rajapaksa’s government is seeking an IMF bailout to help extricate Sri Lanka from the crisis, which has seen skyrocketing food prices and the local currency collapse in value by a third in the past month.

Palestinian woman shot dead by Israeli forces

Israeli forces shot dead a Palestinian woman yesterday near the southern West Bank city of Bethlehem, the Palestinian health ministry said, the latest in a surge of violence. The ministry said the woman, aged in her 40s, died in a hospital in the West Bank city of Beit Jala after suffering massive blood loss from a torn artery. She was identified as Ghada Ibrahim Sabatien, a widowed mother of six, the Palestinian news agency Wafa reported. The Israeli army said troops fired warning shots into the air when the woman approached them near the town of Husan, before they “fired towards the suspect’s lower body”. The woman was transferred to the Red Crescent for treatment, the army said, adding it was investigating the incident, which comes amid heightened tensions in Israel and the West Bank.

Macron faces far-right challenge as France votes

French President Emmanuel Macron yesterday faced a tough test seeking re-election in a vote projected to produce a tight run-off with far-right leader Marine Le Pen. Polls opened in mainland France at 0600 GMT after an unusual campaign overshadowed by Russia’s invasion of Ukraine that analysts warned could lead to unpredictable outcomes with turnout a major factor. Early indications showed that turnout was around three percentage points lower than at the same stage in 2017, although above 2002 when record numbers of French stayed away. Polls predict that Macron will lead Le Pen by a handful of percentage points in round one, with the top two going through to a second-round vote on April 24.
Far-left candidate Jean-Luc Melançon is snapping at their heels in third place and still fancies his chances of reaching the second round at the expense of Le Pen or even – in what would be an extraordinary upset – President Macron himself. Macron cast his ballot in Le Touquet on the northern French coast, accompanied by his wife Brigitte, around lunchtime.
