standing passengers in many trains despite a ban in this regard, it is better to re-introduce the system on some scale.

The meeting, however, did not give any concrete decision in this regard, a participant said.

BR’s Director General Dharendra Nath Mazumder could not be reached for

comments over phone, even after sending messages.

Contacted, Maliha M Quadir, managing director of Shohoz, said in absence of a proper handover of previous software, they had no choice but to deploy their own solution within 21 business days.

“With this software, we gave a mobile responsive website, and railway has

been using this software successfully since then,” she said.

The website is also being used by millions of people to purchase tickets using both phones and desktop, she added. “We had been working on an app in parallel and will be launching it before next Eid,” she told The Daily Star last night.

scrutinising the object, gold bars were found inside the battery chamber, he said. During interrogation, Shafiqul claimed that he was unaware about the gold and his uncle requested him to take it to Bangladesh. He was supposed to hand the fan over to his uncle’s family.

Sometimes, expatriates knowingly smuggled gold just to earn some easy money, claimed investigators.

On April 30, customs officials seized gold from three passengers’ bodies at HSLA. They had come to Bangladesh from Dubai. The estimated market value of the gold is Tk 2.54 crore. Officials claimed that sometimes, passengers handed over gold to airport officials to carry the consignment out.

On March 24, customs officials detained a Qatar Airways employee and seized 56 gold bars, weighing a total of 6.5 kg, at HSLA. The detainee was identified as Tajul Islam, an airport service agent of the airline.

Tajul was detained in the boarding bridge area of the airport with the bars, wrapped with scotch tape.

A passenger handed the gold bars over to Tajul, said customs officials.

Earlier on February 25, Customs detained a cleaner of Civil Aviation Authority of Bangladesh (CAAB) with 36 gold bars weighing over 4 kg at HSLA.

Md Suruzzaman was detained, as he was trying to take the bars out of the airport inside his pocket. An inbound passenger might have smuggled gold to the country and handed it to the cleaner, suspected officials. The Daily Star tried to contact the CAAB chairperson, but he did not pick up the phone.

Contacted yesterday, a high official of CAAB said the organisation cannot be held responsible for the misdeeds of its staff.

“In case of involvement of any CAAB staffer in such wrongdoings, we urge law enforcers to take action,” said the official, requesting anonymity.

Customs House DC Riazul said they have increased vigilance regarding gold smuggling and are taking action.

“Steps have also been taken to increase our workforce in the airport to watch the smuggling activities more effectively,” he added.

Market police stations, along with three other old cases.

Officials said they are now looking for his close associate Jahangir, who used to get him clients.

They also mentioned that Mahbub used to change his office locations whenever any victim filed complaints against him in this regard.

In 2015, two trafficking cases were filed against him with Mohammadpur and Dhanmondi police stations after he embezzled money by promising some individuals of sending them to Canada under his old agency name “Planet Oversee”, according to the law enforcers.

In the last seven years, Mahbub took different offices in Lalmatia, Karwan Bazar, Elephant Road and Bashundhara in the capital, where he set up his last office.

revolutionary change in health care. “We can easily engage medical students for this,” he said, in addition to focusing on ensuring medicine at a cheaper cost.
