22 univs go for integrated admission tests

Twenty-two public universities, including two new ones, have decided to hold integrated admission

tests for 2021-22 academic session. Students of science will sit for admission tests on

July 30, humanities on August 13 and business on August 20. Prof Sadequl Arefin,

vice-chancellor of University of Barishal, confirmed it to The Daily Star yesterday afternoon. The decision of

integrated admission tests came at a meeting of the university authorities on Monday night, he said.

Besides, the students will be allowed to migrate to their desired universities, he added.

At the meeting, the authorities also decided to increase the admission fees from Tk 1,200 to Tk 1,500. Asked, Prof Sadequl

said the decision was made as the price of paper and other materials increased.

The universities that agreed to hold integrated admission tests are Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman University, Kishoreganj; Chandpur Science and Technology University; Jagannath University; Islamic University, Kushtia; Khulna University; Comilla University; Jatiya Kabi Kazi Nazrul Islam University; Begum Rokeya University, Rangpur; University of Barisal; Rabindra University, Shahzadpur; Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Digital University; Sheikh Hasina University, Netrakona; Shahjalal University of Science and Technology, SEE PAGE 6 COL 5

Bangladesh can't buy **Russian crude oil**

State minister for power says refinery configured for only Middle Eastern oil

Bangladesh would not be buying crude oil from Western-sanctioned Russia as its refinery is configured to process only oil from the Arab countries, said Nasrul Hamid, the state minister for power, energy and mineral resources.

That was why Bangladesh had to regretfully decline, he told reporters at the capital's Bidyut Bhaban at an event to mark the golden jubilee of the Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB). Forum for Energy Reporters Bangladesh and BPDB jointly organised the event.

Russian crude oil is heavier than the Arabian crude oil and the country's lone state-run refinery -- Eastern Refinery -- is designed to process fuel from the Middle East, according to an energy ministry official.

The country is buying oil as usual under long-term government-to-government

agreements with Middle Eastern countries including Saudi Arabia and the UAE, Hamid said.

"Although the price of oil in the international market is fluctuating, there is no shortage of oil reserves at our end." The electricity tariff may be hiked to a reasonable level, he said.

"You should not expect to get electricity at the same rate as 13 years ago. In that times, people's income has increased." Hamid also touched upon the

Federation of Bangladesh Chambers of Commerce and Industry's advice to shut down the quick rental power plants as those were raising the production cost of electricity.

"If fabric merchants get a say on which power plants we should get electricity from, it is not right. You should not advise us on what to do and what not to do." SEE PAGE 6 COL 5

Covid booster dose campaign starts on June 4

A week-long special campaign for administering Covid-19 booster jabs will start countrywide on June 4, said the Directorate General of Health Services.

In a circular released vesterday, the DGHS said any second dose vaccine recipient, aged 18 and above, can get a booster jab with an interval of at least four months.


The campaign will begin at 9:00am each day and the vaccines will be administered following WHO guidelines, read the DGHS circular.

A total of 11.76 crore people received their second jabs as of yesterday. Around 1.5 crore of them have already received their booster shots, as per the DGHS data.

Israel signs first Arab free trade deal with UAE

Israel signed a free trade deal with the United Arab Emirates yesterday, its first with an Arab country, building on their US-brokered normalisation of diplomatic relations in 2020.

Israel's ambassador to the oil-rich UAE, Amir Hayek, tweeted "mabruk" -- congratulations in Arabic -- with a photo of Emirati and Israeli officials holding documents at a signing ceremony in Dubai.

The Emirati envoy to Israel, Mohamed Al Khaja, hailed as an

unprecedented achievement" the deal that, according to the Israeli side, scraps customs duties on 96 percent of all products traded.

"Businesses in both countries will benefit from faster access to markets and lower tariffs as our nations work together to increase trade, create jobs, promote new skills and deepen cooperation," Khaja tweeted.

The 2020 deal was part of the US-brokered Abraham Accords that also saw Israel establish diplomatic ties with Bahrain and Morocco. Two-way trade between Israel
