

US MASS SHOOTING
Gunman kills
4 at Tulsa
hospital

A gunman has killed at least four people at a hospital building in Tulsa, Oklahoma, police said – the latest in a string of mass shootings across the United States in recent weeks.

The killings come as Texas families bury their dead after a school shooting left 19 young children dead just eight days earlier.

The Tulsa shooting suspect, who was armed with a rifle and a handgun during his attack on the Saint Francis hospital campus, died by suicide, police said Wednesday.

Tulsa Police Department Deputy Chief Eric Dalglish said officers responded immediately after emergency calls came in reporting that a gunman had stormed into the second floor of the Natalie Building, which houses a clinic on the Saint Francis campus.

It was not clear how many other people might have been wounded.

Dalglish said the entire assault – from the moment emergency calls came in, to the time officers engaged the shooter – lasted about four minutes.

He also noted that the suspect had yet to be identified.

According to the Gun Violence Archive, there have been 233 mass shootings this year in the United States – more than one such incident per day in 2022 so far.

The United States generally counts mass shootings as involving four or more deaths.

UK QUEEN'S 70 YEARS ON THE THRONE
Celebrations begin

A beaming Queen Elizabeth waved to cheering crowds massed outside Buckingham Palace yesterday as Britain kicked off four days of pomp, parties and parades to celebrate her record-breaking 70 years on the British throne.

Tens of thousands of royal supporters waving flags lined the streets of London for a military parade that marked the start of Platinum Jubilee events. Millions of people across Britain and the world were expected to join street parties, watch the festivities and light beacons in honour of the 96-year-old queen.

Elizabeth, holding a walking stick and wearing a dusky dove



blue outfit that she also wore for an official Jubilee photograph released yesterday, was joined by her son and heir Prince Charles, 73, and other senior royals on the balcony of Buckingham Palace.

Elizabeth has been on the throne for longer than any of her predecessors, and is the third-longest reigning monarch ever of a sovereign state.

"Thank you to everyone who has been involved in convening communities, families, neighbours and friends to mark my Platinum Jubilee, in the United Kingdom and across the Commonwealth," she said in a statement as the festivities got under way.

French President Emmanuel Macron, Pope Francis and former British prime ministers were among those sending messages of goodwill.

Opinion polls show Elizabeth remains hugely popular and respected among British people, with one survey this week showing eight in 10 people held a positive view of her, and another found three-quarters thought she had done a good job as queen.

Yesterday marks not only the start of the Jubilee, but also the 69th anniversary of the coronation of Elizabeth, who became queen on the death of her father George VI in February 1952.

The celebrations began with the Trooping the Colour, a military parade in central London held annually to mark the queen's official birthday.

Indian bank
employee
shot dead in
Kashmir

Suspected rebels yesterday shot dead a bank manager in Indian-administered Kashmir, police said, the seventh in a spate of targeted killings in the disputed territory.

An attacker shot the Hindu bank employee, who moved from Rajasthan a week earlier, in his office with a pistol in the Kulgam area, police said.

"#Injured bank employee namely Vijay Kumar #succumbed to his injuries at hospital," police said on Twitter.

The Resistance Front (TRF) rebel group claimed responsibility for Kumar's death on its Telegram channel.

Four Palestinians
killed by Israel
army in 2 days

Israeli troops shot dead a teen in the West Bank yesterday, the Palestinian health ministry said, the fourth Palestinian killed in the occupied territory in two days. The ministry identified the slain Palestinian as 17-year-old Odeh Odeh, who was hit in the chest by what it said was an Israeli bullet near the village of Al-Madiya, west of Ramallah. It came hours after a Palestinian man was killed during a clash with Israeli forces conducting an arrest operation in the Dheisheh refugee camp near Bethlehem. On Wednesday, a woman approaching soldiers with a knife was shot, and later that day a man was killed in an Israeli raid in the northern West Bank. Nineteen people, mostly Israeli civilians – including 18 inside Israel and a Jewish settler – have been killed in attacks by Palestinians and Israeli Arabs since late March. Thirty-nine Palestinians have been killed in the West Bank during that period.

Nepal tightens
flight rules after
deadly crash

Flights in Nepal will be cleared to fly only if there is favourable weather forecast throughout their route, according to new regulations announced in the wake of a recent crash that killed 22 people, officials said yesterday. A full investigation into the crash of the Twin Otter aircraft in western Nepal on Sunday is underway, but a preliminary inquiry suggested that bad weather caused the accident. Air traffic control lost contact with the twin-prop plane shortly after it took off from Pokhara and headed for Jomsom, a popular Himalayan trekking destination. The wreckage was found a day later, with all 16 Nepalis, four Indians and two Germans who were on board killed. Aviation companies have raised concerns about how to implement the new regulations, citing the country's limited weather forecasting infrastructure.

IBA Admission Test

BBA 30th BATCH (SESSION 2021-2022)

BBA Admission Test (2021-22) of Institute of Business Administration (IBA), University of Dhaka (DU) will be held on **Friday, June 24, 2022 from 10:00 am to 12:00 noon.**

ELIGIBILITY

1. For Applicants Who Have Passed SSC/HSC:

Students who have fulfilled the stipulated requirements for applying in different units of DU, and have passed their SSC or equivalent exam during 2016-2019 and HSC or equivalent exam in 2021 are only eligible to apply for 2021-2022 academic session. They must have a minimum 7.5 as total of SSC & HSC GPA (including the 4th subject). Candidates must secure at least 3.5 GPA in both the exams to be eligible to apply.

2. For Applicants Who Have Passed IGCSE/ O-Level and IAL/GCE A-Level or Equivalent Exam:

Students who have passed IGCSE/O-level exam with at least 5 subjects (including mathematics) during 2016-2019 and IAL/GCE A-Level exam with at least 2 subjects (final result of at least one subject must have been published in 2021) are eligible to apply. Out of the 7 subjects in IGCSE/O-Level and IAL/GCE A-level, candidates should get minimum 4 B grades and 3 C grades. Among the best five grades of O-level and best two grades of A-level, **no 'D' grade will be accepted.**

3. No candidate is eligible to sit for this year's admission test, if he/she had appeared in any admission test of DU, including IBA in 2021 or before.

Candidates from O-level, A-level or from all other boards outside the country have to obtain "Equivalence Certificate" from IBA before applying. For equivalence certificate visit the DU admission website: <https://admission.eis.du.ac.bd> Those who have already received their equivalence certificate while applying in different units of DU, need not apply for the equivalence certificate again.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

All **Bangladeshi** applicants must take the Admission Test. The test has two components: Written Assessment and Communication Test. The Written Assessment component evaluates applicant's aptitude in: Language, Mathematics, and Analytical ability. To pass the Written Test, an applicant must obtain a minimum qualifying score in each of the stated areas. For the Communication Test, applicants will be selected on the basis of their performance in the Written Assessment.

Foreign nationals with a score of at least 1265 out of 1600 in SAT Reasoning Test (with at least 600 in Math and 575 in reading and writing) may be exempted from the Written Assessment, but must appear in the Communication Test.

HOW TO APPLY

The application is to be made **online (at <https://admission.eis.du.ac.bd>) starting from 9:00 am Saturday, May 21, 2022 to 12:00 am Saturday, June 11, 2022. The payment of application fees of Tk. 1250 (including online processing fees and bank service charge) **needs to be done by 5:00 pm Sunday, June 12, 2022. Admit Card can be downloaded from 12 pm Thursday, June 16, 2022 to 12 pm Thursday, June 23, 2022.** For detailed application procedure, visit the IBA website at <https://www.iba-du.edu> or the DU admission website: <https://admission.eis.du.ac.bd>.**
