'Withdraw case against Afroza Sarkar'

Bangladesh Nari Sangbadik Kendra, an organisation for the country's women journalists, yesterday demanded immediate withdrawal of all the cases, including the one filed under Digital Security Act against journalist Afroza

The members of the Nari Sangbadik Kendra formed a human chain in front of Jatiya Press Club in this regard. Rangpur-based journalist Afroza was attacked and

harassed in September last year, along with some other journalists in a clash on the issue of Rangpur Reporters' Club's election.

'Later the attackers filed the cases against the victims," said Nasimun Ara Haque, president of Bangladesh Nari Sangbadik Kendra.

Some journalists who failed in the election, along with some outsiders, filed the cases, she added.

Nasimun said a case against Afroza was filed under DSA as she gave an interview to a YouTube-based channel about the attack.

Rain-fed Surma overflows again

Just 10 days after flowing below the danger level, the waters of Surma engorged to the danger level again yesterday morning. The river flowed above the danger level for 13 days till May 26, drowning most upazilas in Sylhet and Sunamganj districts.

A summary report by the Flood Forecasting and Warning Centre mentioned that the water level of all the major rivers of the northeast region, including Surma, Kushiyara, Someshwari and Sari Gowain, will continue to rise in the next 48 hours.

Asif Ahmed, executive engineer of BWDB in Sylhet, said, "We were expecting the river to cross the danger level a few days later, but it crossed due to heavy rainfall. But the situation is not expected to be similar to the flash flood we experienced recently."

The prosecution yesterday claimed that Abul Kalam Azad, former director general of Directorate General of Health Service (DGHS), and four of his officials made an agreement with Mohammad Shahed, Regent Group's chairperson, for conducting Covid-19 tests.

The four others are former DGHS director (hospitals and clinics) Dr Aminul Hasan, deputy director (hospital-1) Dr Md Younus Ali, assistant director (hospital-1) Dr Md Shafiur Rahman and research officer Dr Md Didarul

The defence for others, including Shahed, submitted separate petitions for discharging them. Judge Al Asad Md Asifuzzaman fixed June 12 for passing an order on whether to frame charges against them.

'It's our son in the video'

Following the devastating blast in the Sitakunda BM Depot, 22-year-old depot worker Al Amin went missing. His parents, living in Habiganj's Bagerkhal village under Putizuri union, made repeated attempts to reach him over the phone, but failed.

They were keeping an eye on social media for a minute-tominute update of the situation. Then they came across a video of Al Amin being carried on a

stretcher with burn injuries and identified him.

However, they couldn't verify which hospital he was being taken to. They are also financially restrained to make a trip to Chattogram and look for their

Al Amin's family is now passing days in extreme anxiety and helplessness.

Al Amin is the second of five brothers. He joined the depot as a worker recently, along with his friends Fahim and Rajib

However, on the dreadful night of the explosion, only Al Amin was on duty among the three. The other two went home after finishing their shift.

"On Sunday night, a local youth saw the video where Al Amin could be seen with burn injuries. He showed us the video. It was indeed our son, with all the burn marks" said a devastated Sujena Begum, Al Amin's mother.

Concerted effort need of the hour

UN, ILO on Sitakunda blast

The devastating fire at the BM Container Depot is a reminder of the need to work together towards effective industrial and enterprise safety frameworks and their enforcement, said the UN Resident Coordinator's office in Bangladesh in a statement yesterday.

"The UN in Bangladesh calls upon all parties involved to apply renewed vigour in addressing the safety deficits in workplaces across the country and we extend our assistance to continue to build a safer Bangladesh for all," read the

The fire and the subsequent blast in the private depot in Sitakunda killed at least 41 and injured over 200 people.

The UN Resident Coordinator's office and the International Labour Organization (ILO), another UN body, expressed deep shock at the tragic event and loss of lives.

ILO said this incident illustrates the urgent need to ensure proper handling and storage of chemicals, proper training for storage facility staff at awareness and operational levels, and effective crowd control during emergencies.

ILO, in its statement, laid out some suggestions for tackling these crises, that include "adequate compensation and income support to the injured and disabled workers and families of workers who lost lives in work-related accidents.'

"Proper monitoring of industries by the government to ensure that industrial and accidental risks are properly understood, addressed and prevented is essential to improving safe working conditions in Bangladesh," said ILO in the statement.




