NEW MILITARY HIRING PLAN One killed as protests rage in India

REUTERS, New Delhi

Indian police fired at an angry mob who set trains on fire yesterday during protests against a new short-term military recruitment scheme that has flared around the country.

The system aims to bring in more people to the military on short, fouryear contracts to lower the average age of India's 1.38 million-strong armed forces and cut down on burgeoning pension costs.

The new process will bring in men and women between the ages of 17-and-a-half and 21 for a four-year tenure at nonofficer ranks, with only a quarter retained for longer.

But many potential recruits object, concerned about employment opportunities after serving their four-year terms and disappointed to miss out on a pension.

Thousands of young men took to the streets vesterday, with protests turning violent in at least three states

One protester was killed in a clash with police in the southern city of Secunderabad, in the southern state of Telangana, a government official said.

In Uttar Pradesh, protests erupted in 14 districts. In Bihar, protesters torched train coaches in at least two stations and disrupted rail services, police said.
