Traffic on the bridge will start from tomorrow." "The days of waiting for hours at the ferry are over. The people of South Bengal have to suffer no longer," she said. Awlad Hossain, a visitor at the bridge, said, "It will now take six minutes to cross the Padma river, where it used to take more than an hour to cross it by boat." "For the people of the

south, Padma Bridge's construction is an emotional event," he said. Al Bardi, a resident of Dhaka's Mirpur, whose home district is Barguna, visited the bridge after painting his whole body with the image of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and the span of Padma Bridge. After getting this artwork done (which took around six hours) from Mohammadpur's Bosila, he set off for Padma Bridge. Al Bardi said, "Padma bridge is a source of pride for us." Meanwhile, after the bridge's inauguration, people across the country continued to thronged the

bridge. This correspondent saw people taking pictures with their family on the bridge. Besides, a three-day cultural programme was organised at Shimuliaghat. Many visitors from Dhaka and surrounding districts came to see Padma Bridge in private cars. Jamal Hossain, a businessman from Dhaka's Malibagh area, said, "I came to see Padma Bridge with my wife and two children." Jibon Hossain, a resident of Louhajong Medinimondal village in Munshiganj, said, "It's like a fair has ensued under the bridge. The crowds will keep increasing as days go by.

The alarming thing is that smugglers are using the dark web and applications that encrypt information to place orders for narcotics from abroad and communicate with suppliers. On November 23, 2021, DNC arrested two suspects -- Asif Ahmed Shuvo and his friend Arnab Kumar Sharma -- with a drug known as DOB. During the investigation, the arrestees informed that they placed an order for the drug through the dark web using cryptocurrency, said officials. Md Mehedi Hasan, assistant director (north) of Department of Narcotics Control, told The Daily Star, "These new types of drugs are mainly sold through encrypted applications, and we have no capacity to monitor them. They are even placing orders from foreign countries using the

CONSUMPTION HIGHER IN ADOLESCENTS According to Department of Narcotics Control's annual report, people aged 16 to 40 comprise 84.27 percent of the total drug abusers in Bangladesh, and drug abuse is most severe among those aged 21 to 25. FROM PAGE 5 opening of country's longest bridge," says the corruption charges went to a Superior Court in Ontario, Canada, which acquitted three former top executives of SNC-Lavalin, the Canadian firm, in an international bribery case linked to the bridge's construction in 2017. Sheikh Hasina also defied bitter criticism by political opposition led by former prime minister Khaleda Zia during the construction of the bridge, says the report carried by various newspapers

including Fox44news.com and Fox13memphis.com. AFP, Bloomberg, PTI, ANI, Khaleej Times and many other newspapers across the globe covered the event of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina inaugurating the 6.51-km bridge, which is projected to increase the country's GDP by 1.3 percent. New York-based Bloomberg in its report titled "Bangladesh Unveils Bridge Shunned by World Bank a Decade Ago" said the project is seen as a personal victory for Sheikh Hasina.

It reports 50 years ago, newly independent Bangladesh was synonymous with poverty, but today the tiny South Asian nation is being feted for beating its bigger and richer regional peers on key economic and social indicators such as gross domestic product per capita and gender equity. "The government-funded bridge shows its appetite for infrastructure spending amid a need to create jobs for its 67 million labor force and reduce pandemic-fueled inequalities," Bloomberg says. It also quoted Hasina as saying, "When I announced a plan to build the bridge with our own funds, many in Bangladesh doubted me. I proved them wrong." "The common

perception that Bangladesh cannot do anything without financial assistance by lenders is gone." Khaleej Times carried AFP story that quoted the experts saying the construction of the bridge, which involved more than 4,000 engineers, was a major technical challenge. "The bridge's underwater pilings extend 122 meters (400 feet) deep, a world record, and it requires 41 total pillars. At some points in the river, the water flow volume ranks second globally only after the Amazon River," it says. The Indian Express wrote that by joining the southwest -- home to 30 million people -- with the capital across the Padma River, the bridge is expected

to give an unprecedented boost to communications, trade, and the economy of Bangladesh as a whole. India's news18.com highlighted PM Hasina's quote, "This bridge is not just bricks, cement, iron, and concrete. This bridge is our pride, a symbol of our capacity, our strength and our dignity. This bridge belongs to the people of Bangladesh." India's Siasat Daily said the Padma Bridge would not only help improve intra-Bangladesh connectivity, but it will also provide much-needed impetus to logistics and businesses connecting India and our shared subregion. The bridge will play an important role in fostering greater bilateral and subregional connectivity, it added.

While visiting the area, this correspondent saw huge bricks are being burnt at Mehedi Bricks, set up close to Khalapara Government Primary School. Parul Begum, headteacher of the school, said the brick kiln has been causing serious physical and mental health hazards for them. Bishwajit Karmaker, acting headteacher of Kalishima Dakhin Government Primary School, echoed the same. Contacted, Md Nurul Amin, deputy director of Brahmanbaria DoE, said there are 181 brickfields in the district, of which 99 are operating illegally. "Our department is conducting mobile court drives against all illegal brick kilns, including the brickfields near educational institutions."
